WHEREAS by section 28A of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1961, it is provided that where the Commissioner is of opinion that a controlled access road should be provided and should be entered and departed from at specified places only, he shall make a recommendation to the Governor accordingly and that if of opinion that the recommendation should be given effect the Governor may, by Proclamation, proclaim the controlled access road and the places only at which the controlled access road may be entered or departed from; and whereas the Commissioner is of opinion that a controlled access road should be provided as herein-after described and has made a recommendation to the Governor accordingly; and whereas I, the Governor of the said State, am of opinion that such recommendation should be given effect: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby proclaim that the parcels of land coloured green in Plan P.W.D., W.A. No. 38693 and L.T.O. Plan 7840, and which together are more particularly described in schedule hereunder shall be a Controlled Access Road.

Traffic Act, 1919-1961.

Police T.O. 59/580.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 71 of the Traffic Act, 1919-1961, that the Act applies, *inter alia*, to persons and vehicles in the public service of the Crown, or of any local authority, but does not apply to any vehicle or class of vehicle or person or class of person to the extent of such exemption as may from time to time be declared by the Governor by Order in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 71 of the Act, doth hereby declare that the class of vehicle specified in the schedule hereto is exempt from the operation of all regulations in force and made from time to time under the provisions of the Act relating to brakes, lamps and lighting equipment except those regulations relating to any reflector or reflectors with which a vehicle is required to be equipped when used on a road.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 574/61, L. and S. 543/45.
