WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subsections (2) and (3) of section 172 of the Companies Act, 1961-1962, that the Governor may, by Proclamation, declare that a company or foreign company is a company to which Division 4 of Part VI of the Act applies and that a declaration shall not be made in respect of a company or foreign company unless the Governor is satisfied that a *prima facie* case has been established that, for the protection of the public, it is desirable that the affairs of the company or foreign company should be investigated under that Division: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 172 of the Act, being satisfied that a *prima facie* case has been established that it is desirable that the affairs of the companies and foreign companies set forth in the schedule to this Proclamation should be investigated under Division 4 of Part VI of the Act, do hereby declare that those companies and foreign companies are companies to which that Division applies.
