WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1962, that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board, from time to time, and at any time, by Proclamation, declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that the land described in the schedule hereunder be declared a totalisator agency region for those purposes: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that as from and including the 20th day of May, 1963, the land described in the schedule hereunder shall be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1962.

The whole of the land contained in the municipal district of the Shire of Narrogin.

RESOLVED that the Canning Shire Council, in pursuance of section 7 of the Town Planning and Development Act, 1928-1959, prepare the above Town Planning Scheme with reference to an area situated wholly within the Canning Shire and enclosed within the inner edge of a blue border on the plan now produced to the Canning Shire Council and marked and certified by the President and the Shire Clerk of the Council under their hands dated the 27th day of August, 1962, as Plan No. 1 and Plan No. 2.

Details of Beatrice Place Scheme.

1. Responsible Authority: The authority responsible for enforcing the observance of this Scheme is the Shire of Canning (hereinafter referred to as "the Council").

2. Area: The Scheme shall apply to the land contained within a blue border on Plan No. 1 and on Plan No. 2. The said land is hereinafter referred to as "the Area."

3. General Objects: The general objects of the Scheme are—

(a) to improve and develop the Area to the best possible advantage;

(b) to make provision for the better use of the land within the Area for building purposes.

4. Works to be Carried Out: The following works shall be carried out within the area:—

(a) The Area shall be resurveyed in conformity with the design shown on Plan No. 2.

(b) The roads coloured yellow on Plan No. 2 shall be constructed and drained.

5. Acquisition of Land: The land within the Area or so much thereof as is necessary to implement the Scheme shall be resumed or otherwise acquired by the Council.

6. Offer of Replacement Lots: Each of the owners of each of lots 616-619 and 623-626, both inclusive, on Plan No. 1 shall be offered a new lot shown on Plan No. 2 and bearing the same number of the lot portion of which has been resumed from such owner.

7. The offer shall be made on the condition that if accepted the owner shall—

No acceptance of the offer shall be deemed a valid acceptance unless all rates and taxes due by the owner in respect of the land owned by him within the Area have been paid. An offer not accepted in manner aforesaid within the time specified in the offer shall subject to clause 17 hereof be deemed to have been rejected.

11. Costs of Scheme: The Scheme shall be debited with—

- (a) the administration costs of the Scheme;
- (b) the costs of the works to be carried out;
- (c) all compensation payable and all costs and expenses of determining and settling compensation;
- (d) the cost of acquisition of any land within the Area in the event of such land being acquired other than by resumption.

12. Estimate of Costs of Scheme: It is estimated that the total net cost of the Scheme will amount to £1,456. This sum is to be payable to the Council by the owners of the lots and by the respective amounts shown in the schedule hereto. If the total net costs should exceed the said sum the Council shall pay the excess. 15. Time Limit for Claims for Compensation: Claims for compensation by reason of the operation of this Scheme shall be made within six (6) months of the coming into operation of this Scheme or the date of the issue of a notice of resumption whichever is the later.

16. Encumbrances on Title: In the event of any land in the Area being subject to a registered mortgage, charge or lease or to a caveat to protect the interest of the purchaser, mortgagee, chargee or lessee the Council shall not transfer a new lot to the owner unless subject to similar encumbrances or with the consent of all persons entitled to the benefit of the encumbrances.

17. Powers of Council: The Council in the conduct and management of this Scheme shall have the following powers:—

- (a) To enter and inspect the land within the Area.
- (b) To enter into agreements or arrangements with the owners of any land within the Area.
- (c) To extend the time within which any offer of replacement lots may be accepted.
- (d) To acquire by purchase or otherwise any land within the Area.
- (e) To transfer any land acquired by it in pursuance of this Scheme as compensation or part compensation and to enter into agreements relative to the determination and settling of compensation.

(f) To demolish wholly or partly any buildings which are in the Area of or within the building lines of any new streets on Plan No. 2.
