ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 75045/61.

WHEREAS the enactment contained in section 74 of the Constitution Act, 1899, whereby the appointment of all public officers under the Government of the State is vested in the Governor in Council does not apply to minor appointments which, by Order in Council, are vested in the Heads of Departments or other officers or persons within the State; and whereas it is desirable that the appointment of foremen and all other persons employed

at a daily wage on water supply, sewerage and drainage works under the control of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Department should be vested in various officers: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby further amends schedule appended to the Order in Council gazetted on the 14th July, 1961, by the addition of the name of A. B. Tenger, and of any person appointed temporarily to act in the place of such officer.
