ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1962, it is, *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure the land is used for the

Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1961.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1961, that it shall be obligatory for every employer to obtain from an incorporated insurance office approved by the Minister a policy of insurance for the full amount of the liability to pay compensation under the Act to all workers employed by him, but that if an employer proves to the satisfaction of the Minister that such employer has established a fund for insurance against such liability and has deposited at the Treasury securities charged with all payments to become due under such liability, the Governor may, by Order in Council, exempt such employer from the operation of that section; and whereas Western Aluminium No Liability, a company incorporated in the State of Victoria having its registered office in the State of Western Australia at Hope Valley Road, Kwinana, being an employer within the meaning of the section has, duly, in accordance with the Act and the regulations made thereunder, made application for exemption from the operation of the section, and has satisfied the Minister that it has established a fund for insurance against the said liability, and has deposited at the Treasury a security, to wit, a bond for £5,000 charged with all payments to become due under the said liability: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth hereby exempt Western Aluminium No Liability from the operation of section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1961, for a period terminating on the 30th day of April, 1965.
