WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (2) of section 4 of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963, that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister and the Board, from time to time, and at any time, by Proclamation declare any portion or portions of the State to be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of that Act; and whereas the Minister and the Board have recommended that the land described in the schedule hereunder be declared a totalisator agency region for those purposes: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that as from and including the 13th day of December, 1963, the land described in the schedule hereunder shall be a totalisator agency region for the purposes of the Totalisator Agency Board Betting Act, 1960-1963.

NAVIGABLE WATERS REGULATIONS.

Harbour and Light Department,

ACTING pursuant to the powers confirmed by regulation 48A of the Navigable Waters Regulations, the Harbour and Light Department doth, by this notice—

- (1) define and set aside the following area of navigable waters, for the purpose of water ski-ing, namely—

(a) Dumbleyung Lake—Shire of Dumbleyung.—All that area of water from a point on the foreshore of the lake within lines extending in a northerly direction for one and a half miles, thence in an easterly direction for three and a half miles; thence in a southerly direction for two and one-quarter miles to the foreshore, and thence along the foreshore to the starting point, as defined by markers with the exception of an area commencing 30 feet south-east of the launching ramp and extending 150 feet south-east by 110 feet north which is set aside as a swimming area and defined by markers.

- (5) An authorised bush fire control officer, at the direction of the local authority, shall specify in the permit to burn stubble, grass or pasture a stated time between 12 noon and midnight of the same day before which stated time burning shall not be commenced.
- (6) The local authority or duly authorised bush fire control officer may refuse to issue a permit or may grant a permit subject to such conditions or requisitions as he considers necessary and specifies in the permit. Where a permit subject to specified conditions or requisitions is issued a person shall not carry out the burning authorised by the permit unless he complies with the conditions and requisitions specified.
- (7) The area to be burned on any one day under any one permit shall not exceed the area specified by the issuing officer of the permit to burn contained in accordance with paragraph (3).

- (8) A person shall not carry out the burning of an area of stubble, grass or pasture under the authority of a permit to burn on a Sunday or on any day on which that burning is not authorised by the permit.
- (9) The owner or occupier of the land on which an area is to be burnt shall himself arrange for and provide at least four men to be constantly in attendance at the fire from the time it is lit until it is completely extinguished to assist in keeping the fire under control and to prevent it from spreading beyond the area proposed to be burnt.
