MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVERS INSTRUCTORS ACT, 1963.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting under the provisions of the Interpretation Act, 1918-1962, and of the Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Act, 1963, has been pleased to make the regulations set out in the schedule hereunder.

Schedule. Regulations.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Regulations, 1964.
2. In these regulations, "the Act" means the Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Act, 1963, and, unless the context otherwise requires, words and expressions used in these regulations have the same respective meanings as are given them in, and for the purposes of, the Act.
3. Every application for a licence shall be made in the form of Form 1 in the schedule to these regulations.
4. A licence and a permit shall be respectively in the form of Form 2 and Form 3 in the schedule to these regulations.
5. (1) In any case where the Commissioner requires an applicant for, or the holder of, a licence to undergo a medical test, the licence shall not issue or, as the case may require, the licence is inoperative, until the applicant or holder produces the certificate of a legally qualified medical practitioner, nominated by the Commissioner certifying that, in the opinion of the medical practitioner, the applicant or holder is physically fit to act as a motor vehicle driving instructor.
2. Every medical certificate obtained pursuant to this regulation shall—
 - (a) be in a form required or supplied by the Commissioner; and
 - (b) speak as to the visual acuity of the applicant for, or holder of, the licence.
6. The holder of a licence or permit shall, within three days after its expiration, suspension or cancellation, deliver up the licence or permit to the Commissioner.
7. Where, subsequent to the issue of the licence or permit, the holder changes his address, he shall notify the Commissioner of that fact, within seven days after the change.
8. The holder of a licence or permit shall produce it for inspection, at the request of a member of the Police Force, Traffic Inspector or a person wishing to receive, or who has received, driving instructions from the holder.
9. Where the Commissioner is satisfied that a licence or permit has been lost, mutilated, or destroyed, he may, on payment of the fee prescribed by these regulations, cause a replacement licence or permit to be issued; and the original licence or permit is, thereupon, of no force or effect.

10. Except where a person is receiving driving instruction in his own motor car or in any other case approved by the Commissioner, every motor car used for the purpose of driving instruction shall be fitted with such duplicate pedals, directly in front of the seat beside the driver, as will enable the person occupying that seat readily and effectually to operate the footbrake, and disengage the transmission, of the motor car.

11. An appeal against a decision of the Commissioner, under section 10 of the Act, shall be made by way of complaint, under the Justices Act, 1902, and the grounds of appeal shall be annexed to the summons issued thereunder.

12. (1) A certificate issued by The National Safety Council of Western Australia Incorporated or other prescribed body, for the purposes of section 6 of the Act, may be in the form of the certificate of competency ordinarily given by that body; but every certificate shall set out the class of vehicle in respect of which the certificate holder has been found competent to act as a driving instructor.

(2) For the purposes of the Act and of these regulations, the classes of motor vehicle in respect of which drivers instructors licences and permits are issued are—

- (1) any motor car, or any motor wagon weighing not more than two tons unladen;
- (2) any motor vehicle (except a motor cycle or an articulated vehicle);
- (3) any motor vehicle other than a motor cycle;
- (4) any motor cycle.

commits an offence and is liable to a penalty of fifty pounds.

BREAD ACT, 1903-1963.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the provisions of section 25 of the Bread Act, 1903-1963, and of section 11 of the Interpretation Act, 1918-1962, has been pleased to make the regulations set forth in the schedule hereunder, to have and take effect from and including the day on which the Bread Act Amendment Act, 1963, comes into operation.

Principal

1. In these regulations the Bread Act Regulations, 1939, published in the *Government Gazette* on the 6th April, 1939, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices published in the *Government Gazette*, are referred to as the principal regulations.

Regs. 28-33
added.

2. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 27 the following regulations:—

28. Bread that is made as dietetic bread for sale or is sold as dietetic bread, in accordance with section 4A of the Act, shall be bread made in such manner as to contain, when calculated on the water free substance, not less than 25 per centum of protein, and not more than 66 per centum of carbohydrates.

29. Each loaf of dietetic bread shall be enclosed in a wrapper upon which shall be written in bold faced sans-serif letters of not less than eight points measurement, the percentage proportions and nature of the carbohydrates, fats and proteins, and the calorific value per ounce of such food; and if any substitute for sugar is included, the presence and name of that substitute shall also be stated on the wrapper.

30. Milk bread shall conform in all respects with the general standard for bread, and shall contain not less than four per centum of non-fat milk solids, calculated on the water free substance.

31. The total dry matter content of a loaf of bread shall be as set out hereunder:—

- (a) In the case of a No. 1 loaf—not less than nine ounces and seven-tenths of an ounce.
- (b) In the case of a No. 2 loaf—not less than one pound three ounces and four-tenths of an ounce.
- (c) In the case of a No. 3 loaf—not less than two pounds six ounces and eight-tenths of an ounce.
- (d) In the case of a 1½ lb. loaf of milk bread—not less than fourteen ounces and five-tenths of an ounce.
- (e) In the case of a No. 1 loaf of Vienna bread—not less than four ounces and eight-tenths of an ounce.
- (f) In the case of a No. 2 loaf of Vienna bread—not less than nine ounces and six-tenths of an ounce.
- (g) In the case of a loaf of dietetic bread—not less than four ounces and eight-tenths of an ounce.

32. Where in pursuance of the provisions of the Act the dry matter content of bread baked for sale or sold or offered or exposed for sale is required to be ascertained, the following procedure shall be followed:—

The Inspector shall weigh not less than twenty loaves of bread purporting to be of the same denomination and description, or if twenty loaves of the same denomination and description are not available, then such lesser number as can be found, and shall select and seize three of those loaves that most nearly approximate the average weight of the loaves so weighed, and duly wrap, seal and mark each such loaf as required by regulation 33 of these regulations.

One of the loaves so selected and seized, being the loaf that most nearly approximates the average weight of the loaves so weighed, duly wrapped, sealed and marked, shall be delivered by the Inspector to an analyst employed in the Government Chemical Laboratories.

The Inspector shall offer another of the loaves so selected and seized, duly wrapped, sealed, and marked, to a person who is present at the weighing, or when the bread is weighed under the authority of this regulation in the absence of any person, the Inspector shall offer that loaf to some person employed or apparently employed at the place where the bread was made or sold, or in connection with the business carried on at that place.

The third loaf so selected and seized, duly wrapped, sealed and marked, shall be retained by the Inspector as an umpire sample in case of dispute.

33. (1) Where in pursuance of the provisions of the Act or these regulations an Inspector takes, obtains or seizes any loaf of bread, he shall wrap, seal and mark separately each such loaf.

(2) Delivery to an analyst of a loaf of bread pursuant to regulation 32 of these regulations may be effected personally or by sending the loaf so wrapped, sealed and marked by registered post addressed to the analyst at the Government Chemical Laboratories, or in a sealed package addressed to the analyst at the Government Chemical Laboratories by rail, aeroplane, motor vehicle, or other means of transit.

(3) A copy of any certificate of the result of any analysis of a loaf of bread may be made available by the Chief Inspector to the person from whom the bread so analysed was taken, obtained or seized.

(4) No copy of any such certificate of analysis shall be used in any writing for trade purposes or as an advertisement, and if any person so uses it, he shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds.

(5) A person shall not use for trade purposes or as an advertisement, any communication or correspondence from any Department of the State relating to any bread subject to the provisions of the Act, and any person who so uses such correspondence or communication commits an offence against these regulations and is liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds.

Fourth Schedule.

FUMIGATION OF FRUIT.

Fruit must be fumigated in a chamber constructed to approved standards.

The fumigant must have free access to the fruit in each container and containers shall be stacked in such a manner that adequate circulation of air is possible and not more than 45% of the total volume of the fumigation chamber is occupied.

The fumigant shall be ethylene dibromide of not less than 98% purity and shall be used at the rate of $\frac{3}{4}$ lb (5½ fluid ozs.) per 1,000 cubic feet of fumigation space except that in the case of oranges, mandarins or grapefruit the rate shall be 1 lb (7½ fluid ozs.) per 1,000 cubic feet. If the temperature of the fruit is below 70° F. an additional ½ lb of fumigant shall be added for each 10° F. the temperature is below 70° F.; but no fumigation shall be carried out when the fruit temperature is below 50° F.

The fumigant must be vaporised in an approved manner and provision made for mechanical air circulation. The fruit shall be exposed to the vapour for a period of 2 hours after the completion of vaporisation.
