AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber at Perth this 17th day of April, 1969, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Traffic Act, 1919-1968.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Police 64/1261.

WHEREAS it is enacted (*inter alia*) by section 49 of the Traffic Act, 1919-1968, that the Governor may by Order in Council, empower a local authority to exercise within its district any power of making regulations that the Governor could exercise under Division 4 of Part IV of that Act and that the word "by-law" may be substituted for "regulation"; and whereas, in the opinion of the Governor, it is necessary and convenient that a by-law be made providing that taxi-cars used within the district of the Town of Geraldton be equipped with taxi-meters and that a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars for a first offence and not exceeding two hundred dollars for any subsequent offence be provided for persons contravening those by-laws and that any power conferred by this Order be subject to the conditions and restrictions hereinafter appearing: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers aforesaid, doth hereby confer upon the Council of the Town of Geraldton, being a local authority within the meaning of the Act, the power to make a by-law for the purposes aforesaid conditional upon its being in, and restricted to, the form following, namely,—

1. This by-law may be cited as the Geraldton Taxi-cars By-law, 1969.

2. The owner of a taxi-car in respect of which a license is, pursuant to paragraph (a) or (b) of section eight of the Traffic Act, 1919-1968, effective and operative in the district of the Town of Geraldton, other than a private taxi-car, shall fit the taxi-car with a taxi-meter within the meaning of the word "taxi-meter" in the Traffic (Taxi-cars) Regulations, 1966.

Penalty: For a first offence, one hundred dollars; for any subsequent offence, two hundred dollars.


