AT a Meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 21st day of May, 1969, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Land Act, 1933-1968.

### ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1968, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Body Corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient, as follows:—

Corres. 4828/19.—That Reserve No. 17253 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Wagin in trust for the purpose of Recreation and Watering Place.

The Order in Council dated 3rd April, 1928, is hereby superseded.

Corres. 3016/68.—That Reserve No. 29634 should vest in and be held by the Minister for Water Supplies in trust for the purpose of Water Supply.

Corres. 3810/67.—That Reserve No. 29815 should vest in and be held by The Agriculture Protection Board of Western Australia in trust for the purpose of Use and Requirements of the Agriculture Protection Board.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned Reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies, in trust for the purposes aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 4828/19.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Body Corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the Order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such Order and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 29817 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Wagin, in trust for the purpose of Public Recreation: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Wagin in trust for Public Recreation with power to the said Shire of Wagin subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said Reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 2940/65.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1968, it is, *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the

## By-laws.

Principal by-laws. 1. In these by-laws the by-laws made pursuant to the Government Railways Act, 1904 and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 29th October, 1920 and amended from time to time thereafter, by notices so published, are referred to as the principal by-laws.

By-law No. 91 revoked and remade. 2. By-law No. 91 of the principal by-laws is revoked and remade as follows:—

## By-law No. 91.

## Sale and Consumption of Liquor.

1. In this by-law unless the contrary intention appears—  
 "liquor" has the same meaning as it has in and for the purposes of the Licensing Act, 1911.
2. A person shall not, except in a place set aside by the Commission for the consumption of liquor, consume liquor in or on any railway carriage, omnibus, land, building, or station or in or on any property held or used by the Commission in connection with or for the purposes of a railway.
3. A person shall not consume liquor on a train unless he is an authorised passenger on that train.
4. An authorised passenger on a train shall not consume liquor on the train other than liquor sold on that train pursuant to a license held under subsection (5) of section 46 of the Licensing Act, 1911.
5. A person shall not sell liquor on a train before it departs on its journey from the initial station.
6. A person shall not, on any day, sell liquor on a train after 11 o'clock at night.
7. Any person guilty of a breach of this by-law is liable to a penalty of forty dollars.
