1. In these regulations the Electricity Act Regulations, 1947 as Principal reprinted pursuant to the Reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, and regulations. published as so reprinted in the *Government Gazette* on the 21st August, 1968, are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. The Schedule to the principal regulations is amended:— Schedule

- (a) by adding after the item "Domestic Electric Sewing Machine . . . 54.00 Two" being the last item under the heading SCHEDULE OF TESTING FEES, the item "Portable Switching or Control Device . . . 30.00 Two"; and
- (b) by substituting for the item "Ballast Incorporated in electric headlamp or light fitting . . . 45.00" being the last item under the heading COMPONENTS INCORPORATED IN PRESCRIBED ARTICLES—ADDITIONAL FEES WHERE TESTING IS REQUIRED, the following items:—

PLANT DISEASES ACT, 1914-1969.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Plant Diseases (Verticillium Wilt and Bacterial Blight of Cotton) Regulations, 1969.

2. A person shall not bring cotton seed into the State from any other State or Territory of the Commonwealth unless the seed is accompanied by a certificate, issued by the Department of Agriculture of the State or Territory from which the seed originated, certifying that the seed was grown in an area in which the disease Bacterial Blight (*Xanthomonas malvacearum*) is known not to exist and that the seed has been acid delinted and treated with organic mercury dust.

3. Any cotton seed brought into the State contrary to regulation 2 of these regulations may be seized by an inspector and dealt with in accordance with the provisions of section 23 of the Plant Diseases Act, 1914.

4. A person acting in contravention of these regulations is liable to a penalty of fifty dollars.

- Second Schedule amended. 3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended—
- (a) as to Form No. 1, by substituting for the passage commencing with the words "Fees payable" and ending with the passage "part thereof 1 0" under the heading "Reverse", the passage, "Fee payable on application for registration or renewal of registration as a beekeeper \$1.00";
 - (b) as to Form No. 2, by adding after the passage "Registered Brand" a passage as follows:—
"Number of colonies of bees owned at time of registration" ; and
 - (c) as to Form No. 3, by substituting for the expression "7s. 6d." where occurring, the expression "\$1.00".

MINING ACT, 1904-1969.

- Principal regulations. 1. In these regulations the Regulations for the Guidance of Surveyors Performing Authorised Surveys for the Department of Mines made pursuant to the provisions of the Mining Act, 1904, and published in the *Government Gazette* of the 28th November, 1961, are referred to as the principal regulations.
- Interpretation added. 2. The Principal regulations are amended by adding after the interpretation, "general regulations", an interpretation as follows—
"Superintendent" means the person for the time being holding the office under the Public Service Act, 1904 of Superintendent, Surveys and Mapping Branch of the Department of Mines;
- Reg. 2 amended. 3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding after the passage, "(as amended)", where first occurring in line three, the passage, "the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act, 1967".
- Reg. 24 amended. 4. Regulation 24 of the principal regulations is amended by adding after the word "figures" in the last line, the passage, "and the surveyors shall take all such steps, as the circumstances may require and permit, to render the corner and boundary marks conspicuous".

- Reg. 30A added. 5. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 30, the following regulation:—
- 30A. (1) Where, in accordance with the provisions of the Mining Act, 1904 and the regulations made thereunder, possession has been taken of a dredging claim in a river and the land adjoining thereto or on the foreshore and the land under the ocean the claim shall be surveyed and marked by the surveyor in accordance with instructions given by or on behalf of the Superintendent.
- (2) Where, in terms of instructions given pursuant to sub-regulation (1) of this regulation, a side of a claim is unmarked the surveyor shall show in his field book the calculated distances and bearing of that side.
- Regs. 40, 46 and 47 revoked. Reg. 50 amended. 6. The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulations 40, 46 and 47.
- Reg. 56 amended. 7. Regulation 50 of the principal regulations is amended by adding after the word, "with" in line two, the words, "an accurate plan or diagram thereof and".
- Reg. 58 substituted. 8. Regulation 56 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words, "in duplicate" in lines one and two.
9. Regulation 58 of the principal regulations is revoked and the following regulation substituted:—
58. Subject to these regulations, the fees payable to surveyors for the survey of mining tenements carried out in accordance with these regulations shall be such of those fees prescribed by the Regulations for the Guidance of Surveyors in the Department of Lands and Surveys made under the Licensed Surveyors Act, 1909 as are appropriate, and be subject to those regulations and to such variations as may be arranged with the approval of the Superintendent.
- Reg. 58A added. 10. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 58 a regulation as follows:—
- 58A. Accounts for any service that is to be paid for at daily rates shall, when required by the Superintendent, be accompanied by diaries giving full particulars of the service performed, together with particulars of the time occupied in the field and occupied in the office.
- Reg. 59 substituted. 11. Regulation 59 of the principal regulations is revoked and the following regulation substituted:—
59. When a surveyor lodges his field notes as required by regulation 50 of these regulations and requests the Superintendent to prepare all necessary plans or diagrams in connection with the survey, the account submitted by the surveyor in respect of the cost of the survey and as examined and passed by the Superintendent, shall be reduced by an amount equal to 4% of that account or such greater or lesser amount as appears to the Superintendent reasonable, in view of the time involved in the preparation of the necessary plan or diagram.
- Reg. 61 amended. 12. Regulation 61 of the principal regulations is amended by substituting the word, "four" in line three, the word, "three".
- Reg. 73A added. 13. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 73 a regulation as follows:—
- 73A. Where a surveyor conducting a survey of a mining tenement utilises marks (corner or intermediate) from a previous survey and he has not located those marks or established them as missing, he shall show them on the diagram as a carmine circle on a black line with no notation.
- Reg. 100 amended. 14. Regulation 100 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words, "the face of" in line two.
- Principal regulations amended. 15. The principal regulations are amended by substituting for the words, "Chief Draftsman" the word, "Superintendent" where occurring in regulations 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 52, 56 and 60.
- Appendix 4 substituted. 16. The principal regulations are amended by substituting for Appendix 4 the following appendix.
