## Schedule.

## POLICE STANDING ORDERS.

- Principal orders. 1. In these standing orders the Police Standing Orders, 1969, as printed in the *Government Gazette* on the 22nd July, 1968, and also published in the special *Police Gazette* on the 7th August, 1968, and thereafter from time to time amended by notices so printed and published, are referred to as the principal orders.
- Amendment to O. 201. 2. Order 201 of the principal orders is amended by substituting for paragraph (c) a paragraph as follows:—  
 (c) Other Ranks, being—  
 (i) Senior Constables;  
 (ii) First Class Constables; and  
 (iii) Constables (including Detective Constables, Plain Clothes Constables and Women Police Constables).
- Amendment to O. 407. 3. Order 407 of the principal orders is amended by substituting for paragraph (c) a paragraph as follows:—  
 (c) show an example of neatness in his dress, appointments and quarters and of cleanliness in his person and have the hair of his head well cut and trimmed, have his face clean shaven with the exception of the upper lip and where a moustache is worn, have it neat and trimmed, and not have hair on the sides of the face below a line level with the centre of the ear; .
- Neatness and cleanliness. 3. Order 407 of the principal orders is amended by substituting for paragraph (c) a paragraph as follows:—  
 (c) show an example of neatness in his dress, appointments and quarters and of cleanliness in his person and have the hair of his head well cut and trimmed, have his face clean shaven with the exception of the upper lip and where a moustache is worn, have it neat and trimmed, and not have hair on the sides of the face below a line level with the centre of the ear; .
- Amendment to O. 408. 4. Order 408 of the principal orders is amended—  
 (a) by substituting for paragraph (i) a paragraph as follows:—  
 (i) be neat and clean in his appearance and person and have the hair of his head well cut and trimmed, have his face clean shaven with the exception of the upper lip and where a moustache is worn, have it neat and trimmed and not have hair on the sides of the face below a line level with the centre of the ear; ; and  
 (b) by substituting for the word “him”, being the last word in paragraph (j) a passage as follows:—  
 him;  
 (k) be neat in his clothing and responsible for the safe-keeping of his arms, appointments, and accoutrements.
- Cleanliness, etc. 4. Order 408 of the principal orders is amended—  
 (a) by substituting for paragraph (i) a paragraph as follows:—  
 (i) be neat and clean in his appearance and person and have the hair of his head well cut and trimmed, have his face clean shaven with the exception of the upper lip and where a moustache is worn, have it neat and trimmed and not have hair on the sides of the face below a line level with the centre of the ear; ; and  
 (b) by substituting for the word “him”, being the last word in paragraph (j) a passage as follows:—  
 him;  
 (k) be neat in his clothing and responsible for the safe-keeping of his arms, appointments, and accoutrements.
- Safe-keeping of arms, etc. 4. Order 408 of the principal orders is amended—  
 (a) by substituting for paragraph (i) a paragraph as follows:—  
 (i) be neat and clean in his appearance and person and have the hair of his head well cut and trimmed, have his face clean shaven with the exception of the upper lip and where a moustache is worn, have it neat and trimmed and not have hair on the sides of the face below a line level with the centre of the ear; ; and  
 (b) by substituting for the word “him”, being the last word in paragraph (j) a passage as follows:—  
 him;  
 (k) be neat in his clothing and responsible for the safe-keeping of his arms, appointments, and accoutrements.
- Substitution of O. 509. 5. The principal orders are amended by revoking order 509 and remaking it as follows:—  
 509. The Commissioner may discharge any constable, appointed pursuant to order 506, where that constable—  
 (a) fails to show efficiency and satisfactory conduct;  
 (b) fails to pass such examinations as prescribed by the Commissioner; or  
 (c) is found deficient in any respect after a reasonable time, indicating his unsuitability to be retained in the the Force. .
- Discharge of constable. 5. The principal orders are amended by revoking order 509 and remaking it as follows:—  
 509. The Commissioner may discharge any constable, appointed pursuant to order 506, where that constable—  
 (a) fails to show efficiency and satisfactory conduct;  
 (b) fails to pass such examinations as prescribed by the Commissioner; or  
 (c) is found deficient in any respect after a reasonable time, indicating his unsuitability to be retained in the the Force. .
- Deletion of O. 510. 6. The principal orders are amended by deleting order 510.
- Amendment to O. 1020. 7. Order 1020 of the principal orders is amended—  
 (a) by adding, after the word “course”, in line one, the words “applicable to police work”; and  
 (b) by adding, after the word “Technology”, in line three, the words “or a Technical School or College”.

8. Suborder (3) of order 1104 of the principal orders is amended by substituting for the word "peak", being the last word in paragraph (c), a passage as follows:—

- (d) senior constables—2 narrow chevrons on right arm;
- (e) first class constables—1 narrow chevron on right arm;
- (f) chevrons on the right coat sleeve or the right shirt sleeve of summer uniform above the elbow, pointing towards the hand and with the centre of the chevron seven inches from seam of the sleeve head .

9. The principal orders are amended by revoking order 1110 and remaking it as follows:—

1110. The Master Engineer of a police launch shall wear a double breasted reefer type tunic bearing an insignia comprised of crown and anchors and all other members to wear such tunic with an insignia comprised of anchors. These insignias shall be worn on the left sleeve midway between elbow and sleeve head .

10. Order 1117 of the principal orders is amended by adding after the word "with", in line two of paragraph (d), the word "black".

11. Order 1712 of the principal orders is amended—

- (b) by substituting for the word "Two" in line one of paragraph (b), the word "Three"; and
- (c) by deleting paragraph (c).

12. Order 1713 of the principal orders is amended by substituting for the passages "50 cents.", "\$1.00", "50 cents." and "50 cents" appearing, respectively, opposite paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d), in each case, the passage "\$4.00".

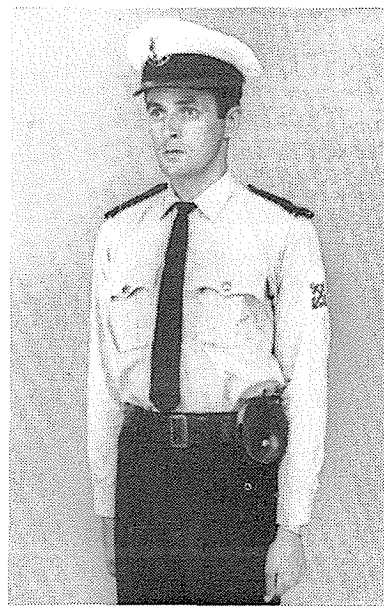

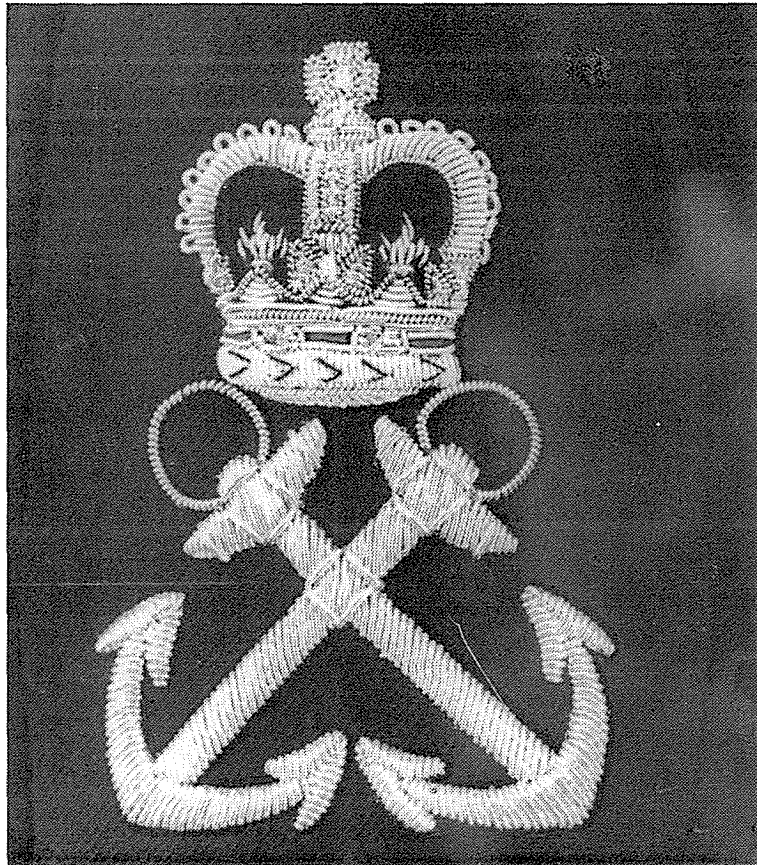

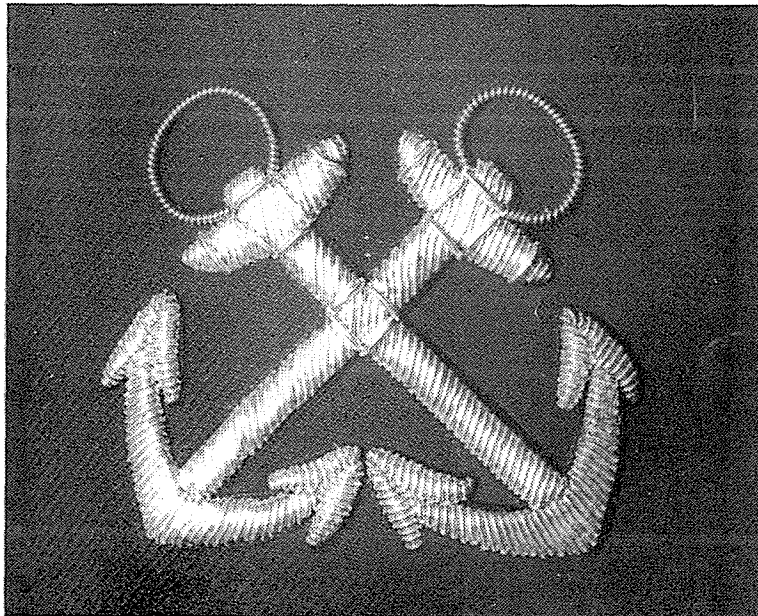

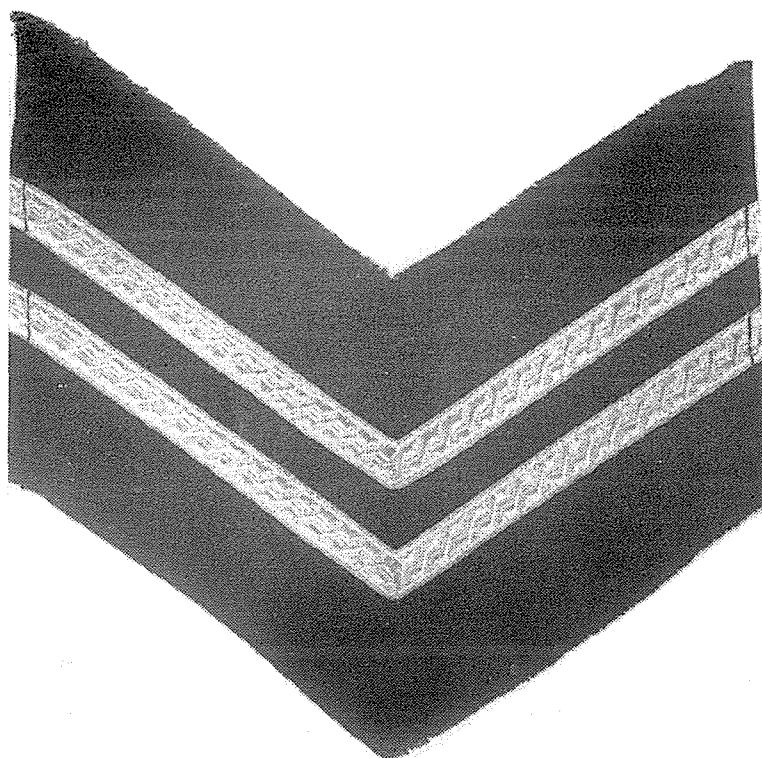
