Land Act, 1933-1972.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. 1007/74.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1972, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Body Corporate, or other person or persons to be named in the Order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such Order and with power of subleasing; and whereas, it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 33013 should vest in and be held by the Shire of Brookton in trust for the purpose of "Pre-School Centre": Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Brookton in trust for "Pre-School Centre" with power to the said Shire of Brookton subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said Reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Forests 1285/59; Lands 821/29.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918, it is provided that the Governor may by Order in Council dedicate any Crown lands as State Forests within the meaning and for the purpose of that Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby dedicate the area described in the schedule hereto as an addition to State Forest No. 43 within the meaning and for the purposes of the said Act.

Regulations.

Principal regulations. 1. In these regulations the Betting Control Regulations, 1955, published in the *Government Gazette* on the 6th May, 1955, as amended thereafter, from time to time, by notices so published, are referred to as the principal regulations.

Reg. 122 substituted. 2. The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulation 122 and substituting a regulation as follows:—

122. (1) A bookmaker who, with the permission of a racing club conducting a race meeting, bets in person as a bookmaker at the meeting shall cause to be delivered to the racing club within seven days of the meeting a return in Form T4 in the second appendix signed by the bookmaker and showing the amount of money paid or promised to the bookmaker as the consideration for bets made at the meeting by him in the capacity of bookmaker and the sum payable on the amount as bookmakers betting tax.

(2) The return in Form T4 shall, when it is delivered to the racing club, be accompanied by payment of the sum of bookmakers betting tax as shown on the return and payable under the Act.

Second Appendix amended. 3. The Second Appendix to the principal regulations is amended by deleting Form T5.

Scheme Text.

THE Perth City Council, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it in that behalf by the Town Planning and Development Act, 1928 (as amended), and the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act, 1959 (as amended), hereby makes the following Town Planning Scheme for the purpose of—

- (a) enabling the comprehensive redevelopment of the land within the Scheme area;
- (b) controlling the development of the land within the Scheme area;
- (c) other matters authorised by the enabling Act.

PART I.—PRELIMINARY.

1.1 This Town Planning Scheme may be cited as the City of Perth Town Planning Scheme No. 11 (hereinafter called "the Scheme").

1.2 The Scheme shall come into operation on the publication of notice of the Minister's final approval thereof in the *Government Gazette*, which date is hereinafter referred to as "the commencement date".

1.3 The Scheme shall apply to all those pieces of land being—

- (a) portion of each of Perth Town Lots G19 and G20 and being Lot 26 on Diagram 46363 and shown on Certificate of Title Volume 1375, Folio 037;
- (b) portion of each of Perth Town Lots G19 and G20 and being Lot 27 on Diagram 46363 and shown on Certificate of Title Volume 1375, Folio 038;
- (c) portion of each of Perth Town Lots G18, G19 and G20 together being Lot 28 on Diagram 46363 and shown on Certificate of Title Volume 1375; Folio 039;
- (d) portion of each of Perth Town Lots G19 and G20 and being Lot 21 on Diagram 41349 and shown on Certificate of Title Volume 1375, Folio 034;
- (e) portion of each of Perth Town Lots G18 and G19 and being Lot 24 on Diagram 41349 and shown on Certificate of Title Volume 1375, Folio 035;
- (f) portion of each of Perth Town Lots G19 and G20 and being Lot 25 on Diagram 41349 and shown on Certificate of Title Volume 1375, Folio 036
 (hereinafter called "the Wesley Trust Area");
- (g) portion of Perth Town Lot G18 on Diagram 3526 and shown on Certificate of Title Volume 1152, Folio 539
 (hereinafter called "the Travel Centre Area").

All the said land is hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme Area".

1.4 The Scheme is complementary to and is not a substitute for the Metropolitan Region Scheme and the provisions of the Metropolitan Region Scheme as amended from time to time shall continue to have effect.

1.5 The responsible authority for carrying out the Scheme is the Council of the City of Perth (hereinafter referred to as "the Council").

1.6 The Scheme Text is divided into the following parts:—

- Part I.—Preliminary.
- Part II.—Existing Use.
- Part III.—Development.

The Scheme Map consists of—

- (a) a map showing the Scheme Area and existing land uses;
- (b) a map showing the proposed subdivision of the Scheme Area;
- (c) a map showing the Wesley Trust Area and the Travel Centre Area;

- (d) a map showing the location of the church known as Wesley Church and the area to be retained as ground level open space.

PART II.—EXISTING USES.

2.1 Any land or building or part of a building within the Scheme Area may continue to be used for the purpose for which it was used prior to this Scheme coming into operation or may be used for any other purpose for which land within the Central Area the subject of the City of Perth By-law No. 65 may be used pursuant to that by-law or any scheme or by-law in substitution therefor, provided such building or part thereof, if so used for any such other purpose, complies with the provisions of any by-law, scheme or regulation relating to such use.

PART III.—DEVELOPMENT.

- 3.1 (a) In this clause—

“gross total floor area” means the floor area of a building calculated in the manner prescribed by the provisions of any Town Planning Scheme, by-law, order or regulation applying from time to time to the Scheme Area for the purpose of ascertaining the permissible plot ratio;

“permissible plot ratio” means the plot ratio fixed by any Town Planning Scheme, by-law, order or regulation applying from time to time to the Scheme Area.

(b) The gross total floor area of any building hereafter erected within the Wesley Trust Area shall be such that, when combined with the gross total floor area of all other buildings erected within that Area and pursuant to this Scheme, the ratio which such total bears to the area of the Wesley Trust Area does not exceed the permissible plot ratio.

(c) The gross total floor area of any building hereafter erected within the Travel Centre Area shall be such that, when combined with the gross total floor area of all other buildings erected within that Area and pursuant to this Scheme, the ratio which such total bears to the area of the Travel Centre Area does not exceed the permissible plot ratio.

3.2 After the commencement date, development within the Scheme Area may only be carried out subject to the provisions of the Scheme and in compliance with the following conditions:—

- (a) That portion of the Scheme Area which is marked on the Scheme Map as ground level open space shall be retained as such and shall, subject to clause 3.3, be open to the public.

- (b) Subject to paragraphs (b) and (c) of clause 3.1 for the purposes of any Town Planning Scheme, by-law, order or regulation applying to the Scheme Area from time to time, the Scheme Area shall be deemed to be one site in one occupancy.

3.3 Nothing in this Scheme shall constitute or be deemed to constitute a dedication or an implied dedication to the public of a right of user of the land shown on the Scheme Map as ground level open space and so that the owner of that land may, in order to negative any dedication or implied dedication as aforesaid, such owner may from time to time close access to any portion of that land as the owner thinks fit.

3.4 In addition to all other powers vested in it, the Council may enter into any agreement or arrangement with any of the owners for the purposes of the Scheme.
