WHEREAS by clause XIV of the Letters Patent passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom constituting the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, dated 29 October 1900, it is provided that in the event of the Governor having occasion to be temporarily absent from the seat of Government or from the State, he may in every such case, by an instrument under the Public Seal of the State, constitute and appoint the Lieutenant-Governor, or if there be no such officer, or if such officer be absent or unable to act, then any other person, to be his Deputy during such absence, and in that capacity to exercise, perform, and execute for and on behalf of the Governor during such absence, but no longer, all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor by such Letters Patent, as shall in and by such instrument be specified; and whereas by those Letters Patent I, the said Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, am authorized, empowered, and commanded by Her Majesty to do and execute, during Her Majesty's pleasure, all things that belong to the Office of Governor according to the tenor of those Letters Patent and according to the instructions to the said Governor mentioned therein and the laws of the State; and whereas I, the said Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, propose to absent myself temporarily from the State: Now, therefore, I, the said Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, do by this instrument under the Public Seal of the State constitute and appoint

you the said Alkin Robert Alexander Wallace as from the time and date of my departure upon the said absence and during such absence to be my Deputy, and in that capacity to exercise, perform, and execute for and on my behalf, as such Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, all the powers and authorities vested in me by the said Letters Patent.
