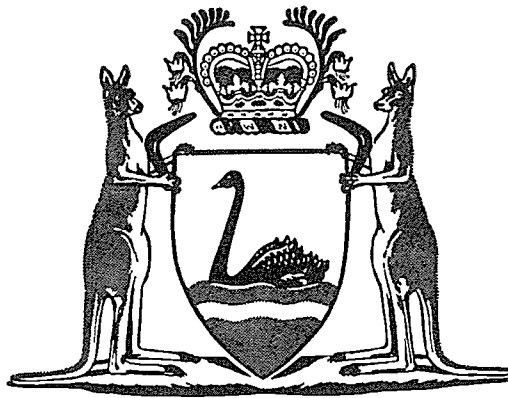

WEIGHTS AND MEASURES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1984.

MADE by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures Amendment Regulations 1984. Citation.
2. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 August 1984. Commencement.
3. In these regulations the Weights and Measures Regulations 1927*, as amended, are referred to as the principal regulations. Principal regulations.
4. Table XIII to the principal regulations is repealed and the following Table is substituted— Table XIII repealed and substituted.
