

#### ALCOHOL AND DRUG AUTHORITY ACT 1974

#### ALCOHOL AND DRUG AUTHORITY REGULATIONS 1990

Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council.

#### Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Alcohol and Drug Authority Regulations 1990*.

#### Prohibition notice

2. (1) The chief executive officer of the Authority may, by notice in writing (“a prohibition notice”) served on a person, prohibit the person from entering or remaining in such Centres as are specified in the notice.

(2) A prohibition notice remains in force until it is revoked in writing by the chief executive officer.

(3) While a prohibition notice remains in force, a police officer, an officer or employee of the Authority, or a person authorized by the Authority for the purposes of this regulation, may with the use of reasonable force exclude or remove the person who is the subject of the notice from a Centre specified in the notice or have the person so excluded or removed.

(4) A person who is the subject of a prohibition notice shall not enter or remain in a Centre specified in the notice while the notice is in force.

Penalty: \$40.

#### By-laws Relating to Parking of Commercial Vehicles on Street Verges

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and of all other powers enabling it, the Council of the abovementioned municipality hereby records having resolved on 20 November 1990 to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor, the following by-law—

#### Repeal

1. The by-laws published in the *Government Gazette* No. 112 of 16 December 1971 and amended from time to time thereafter relating to the parking of commercial vehicles on street verges are hereby repealed.
2. Interpretation—  
In these by-laws unless the context otherwise requires—  
  - “Commercial Vehicle” means a vehicle designed for or used for commercial purposes, exceeding the load capacity of one tonne and/or a vehicle designed for or used for industrial purposes;
  - “Park” means to permit a vehicle, whether attended or not, to remain stationary and “parking” has a correlative meaning;
  - “Street verge” means that portion of a street which lies between the portion of a street that is improved, paved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic and the nearest street boundary.
  - “Road” means any Road, Street, Lane, thoroughfare or similar place which the public is allowed to use and includes all of the land lying between the property lines including the street verge and footpath appurtenant thereto and which is within the parking region.
3. Subject to the parking facilities by-laws and parking schemes in the City of Melville no person shall—
  - (a) Park a commercial vehicle on a road or street verge for more than four hours consecutively without the consent in writing of the City Manager/Town Clerk;
  - (b) Park a commercial vehicle on a road or street verge within six metres of where that street meets or intersects any other street; or
  - (c) Park a commercial vehicle on a road or street verge for repairs, service or to clean a commercial vehicle.

4. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provisions of this by-law commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a penalty as prescribed in sections 190 (7) (d) (i) and (ii) of the Local Government Act 1960.

then the Council may cause a notice under the hand of the Town Clerk to be served on the owner or occupier of such land requiring, within the time specified in the notice, the clearance of such trees, scrub, undergrowth or rubbish or the refuse, rubbish or disused material from the land. The time specified for clearance or removal shall be not less than 7 days from the date of service.
4. Every owner or occupier of land upon whom a notice is served under By-law 3 of these By-laws, shall comply with such notice within the time therein specified and any owner or occupier of land who fails to comply with terms of the notice so served commits an offence.
5. Where the owner or occupier does not clear the land of such trees, scrub, undergrowth and rubbish, or remove such refuse, rubbish or disused material as required by the notice given by the Council, the Council is authorised without payment of any compensation in respect thereof to remove it and dispose of it at the expense of the owner or occupier, and recover in a court of competent jurisdiction, the amount of the expenses from the owner or occupier to whom the notice was given.

6. Any person who commits an offence under By-law 3 is liable, upon conviction, to a penalty not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
7. Any person who continues to fail to comply with a notice served under By-law 3 after conviction of an offence under that By-law commits a further offence and is liable to a daily penalty not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) for every day or part of a day during which the offence continues.

**Posters and graffiti etc. prohibited**

" 41. Unless authorised in writing by the Trust, a person shall not affix anything to or put paint or write on—

- (a) a vehicle;
- (b) Trust premises;
- (c) property owned by or under the control or management of the Trust. "

**Regulation 46 repealed and a regulation substituted**

4. Regulation 46 of the principal regulations is repealed and the following regulation is substituted—

**Regulation of pedestrians on Trust premises**

" 46. (1) The Trust may, by road markings, signs or other means, regulate or prohibit the passage of pedestrians in any Trust premises.

(2) A pedestrian who is not an employee of the Trust shall not disobey a road marking, sign, or other means employed pursuant to subregulation (1). "

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
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
