FINANCE BROKERS CONTROL ACT 1975

CODE OF CONDUCT

The following code of conduct has been approved by the Finance Brokers Supervisory Board pursuant to the provisions of section 81 of the *Finance Brokers Control Act 1975*.

Finance Brokers failing to comply with the terms of the Code will be liable for disciplinary action (see 83 (2) (c) (iii) of the Act).

1. A Brokers relationship with his client is confidential and Brokers shall not allow or permit except so far as the law requires any publication of any information relating to his client's affairs without the consent of the client.

2. Brokers are responsible for the conduct acts and statements of all persons employed in the business of the Broker in the normal course of business.

3. Brokers shall understand fully the duties and obligations imposed upon them by the Finance Brokers Control Act and Regulations and this Code of Conduct.

Brokers shall be as fully informed as possible in matters of the practice of a Finance Broker and shall advise their clients as to their responsibilities and obligations under any agreement negotiated by the Broker on behalf of a client.

4. Brokers shall at all times act in the interests of their clients and shall not place a lender or borrower to disadvantage for the Brokers own benefit.

5. A Broker shall make full disclosure to any prospective lender of any interest whatsoever which the Broker or any employee of the Broker or any member of their respective families may directly or indirectly have in any property offered as security for a loan.

In the event of the existence of any such interest then in addition to disclosure the Broker shall not permit any such loan to be made unless the lender has received separate advice from an independent Solicitor, Valuer or Finance Broker.

6. Brokers shall not be entitled to make any charge for services other than those laid down in the Scale of Fees established under the Finance Brokers Control Act without the prior written consent of their clients.

7. Brokers shall take all reasonable precautions to protect their clients against fraud, misrepresentation and other unethical practice and to ascertain and communicate to them all available relevant facts relating to a property offered as security to a lender.

8. Where a Broker is also a licensed Estate Agent and where a loan is negotiated on behalf of a borrower that loan shall not be made conditional on the granting to the agent/broker of a selling agency or property management agreement.

9. Brokers shall inquire whether a prospective borrower is eligible for a low interest government or other beneficial loan and if so, the Broker shall advise the applicant accordingly before taking an application for a loan from the prospective borrower.

10. Where two Brokers act in conjunction in satisfying an applicant for a loan the Brokers shall share the brokerage by predetermined arrangement and no additional fees shall be paid by any person by virtue of such arrangement.

11. A person being the licensee of a business operated under a licence, and a person holding himself out as being in *bona fide* control of a business operated under a licence, including the manager of a branch office of such a business, shall—

- (a) ensure that such business is conducted from premises to which the public have access during normal business hours, on days that business is generally conducted in the district in which those premises are situate, unless by advertisement displayed on the premises and which can readily be seen and read from outside the premises, the public is informed that those premises will only be open on stated days or part days of the week;
- (b) personally manage full time and carry out the principal managerial duties of such business and where a branch office of the business is conducted, ensure that the manager of each branch office personally manages and carries out the principal managerial duties of such branch office business;
- (c) except for reasons of genuine emergency, sickness, or for the taking of annual holidays, a licensee or person in *bona fide* control of a business operated under a licence shall attend at the premises from which that business is conducted and the manager of every branch office of that business shall attend at the branch office of the business which he manages and from which the business is conducted, at such times and as frequently as shall be required, so as to ensure that the licensee or person in *bona fide* control of the business is in *bona fide* control of that business and can capably and properly manage the affairs thereof and so as to ensure that every manager of every branch office of the business is in full control of that branch office and can capably and properly manage the affairs thereof;
- (d) when persons call at the premises from which a business operated under a licence is conducted, or telephone those premises, for the purpose of speaking to the licensed person, or the person in *bona fide* control of the business, or to the manager of the branch office, as the case may be, on business concerning such business, the licensed person, or the person in *bona fide* control of the business, or the manager of the branch office, as the case may be, shall make such arrangements as may be necessary to enable the person who calls or telephones to speak with him as soon as reasonably possible;
- (e) not take holidays of more than twenty consecutive days (excluding weekends and public holidays) in any one calendar year, without the prior written consent of the Finance Brokers Supervisory Board.

12. Upon request by a borrower or lender Brokers shall provide free of cost to the person requesting the statement a statement of account in respect of a current loan relating to such person which is managed by the Broker but not more often than intervals of six months. Any additional statements shall be at a cost to the person requesting the statement.

13. A Broker or any of his employees shall not be excused for non-observance of the terms of this Code by reason of any claimed ignorance of the terms of the Code.

14. Prior to registration of any mortgage to secure a loan negotiated by a Broker, a Broker shall provide the lender and borrower with a written statement setting out the following information—

- (i) Full name and address of lender.
- (ii) Full name and address of borrower.
- (iii) Amount of loan.
- (iv) Description of mortgaged property.
- (v) Commencement date for interest.
- (vi) Date of advance.
- (vii) Interest rate.
- (viii) Penalty rate.
- (ix) Dates payment due.
- (x) Term of loan.
- (xi) Rights of discharge.

15. A Broker shall not engage in any harsh or unconscionable conduct.

16. (1) Except as provided in subclause (3), a Broker shall obtain from every person intending to lend money through the Broker a statement signed by the person containing particulars of—

- (a) the rate of interest and when interest is payable;
- (b) the terms of repayment;
- (c) the security;
- (d) the ratio of loan to valuation;
- (e) the requirements of the lender as to valuation of the security;
- (f) the requirements of the lender for insurance;
- (g) responsibility for preparation and custody of documents as to security.

(2) The Broker shall retain the statement and give a copy of it to the lender.

(3) The requirement prescribed by subclause (1) does not apply where the person intending to lend money is a body corporate licensed under or exempt from licensing under the *Credit (Administration) Act 1984*.

RETAIL TRADING HOURS EXEMPTION ORDER (No. 12) 1991

Made by the Minister for Consumer Affairs under Section 5

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the *Retail Trading Hours Exemption Order (No. 12) 1991*.

Exemption

2. The operators of the filling stations specified in the schedule may at those filling stations sell fuel or allow fuel to be sold between 1pm and 6pm on Saturdays and to that extent the *Retail Trading Hours Act 1987* does not apply to those filling stations.

DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION POLICY FOR WETLANDS OF THE SWAN COASTAL PLAIN

Public Comment Invited

In June 1990 the Environmental Protection Authority published a discussion paper about the protection of groundwater, wetlands and associated ecosystems of the Swan Coastal Plain. That paper and comments received on it, provide a framework for policies directed at particular aspects of the Swan Coastal Plain.

A Draft Policy to protect the values of the wetlands of the Swan Coastal Plain has now been published. This Draft Policy seeks to control the filling, drainage, mining and excavation, and pollution of wetlands. It includes a series of maps of the Swan Coastal Plain identifying approximately 3000 wetlands to be protected. Approximately 1500 properties will be affected by this policy.

In accordance with section 26 (d) of the Environmental Protection Act, the Environmental Protection Authority invites submissions from the public.

The Public is hereby notified that I have issued a permit to WA Yabbie Farms to establish a processing establishment to process fish in pursuance of the provisions of section 35C of the Fisheries Act 1905 at Roe Location 1862, subject to the following conditions:

That the processing establishment—

1. Shall comply with the requirements of the Fisheries Act 1905 and all Regulations, Orders in Council, and Notices and Ministerial Directions issued thereunder.
2. Shall not be used for the processing of any species of fish other than koonacs (*Cherax plebejus* and *C. glaber*) and yabbies (*Cherax destructor-alibus*) in accordance with these conditions.
3. Shall comply with the requirements of the Health Act 1911 (amended).
4. Shall comply with the requirements of any Town Planning Scheme or Interim Development Order gazetted under the provisions of the Town Planning and Development Act 1928 (amended), or the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act 1959 (amended).
5. Shall be registered as an export establishment pursuant to the provisions of the Parliament of the Commonwealth Export Control Act 1982, and orders made thereunder, more specifically the prescribed goods (general) orders and the fish orders, should it be used to process fish for export.
6. Shall not be used for the processing of marron (*Cherax tenuimanus*) unless a licence is held under section 39C of the Fisheries Act 1905.
7. Live koonacs and/or yabbies shall not be purchased from any person other than a person authorised under Part V of the Fisheries Act.
8. Shall not be used to process koonacs and/or yabbies other than by cleansing and packing whole.
9. Shall not consign packaged koonacs or yabbies unless each container is marked with the species it contains, the place of packaging and the destination of the consignment.
10. Shall not pack koonacs and yabbies in the same container.
11. Yabbies and/or koonacs shall not be sold unless a consignment note is completed in triplicate by the licensed processor on the form provided by the Fisheries Department.
12. The completed consignment note shall be securely attached to the consignment of yabbies and/or koonacs sold. A second copy shall be lodged with the Fisheries Department within seven days of the sale. A third copy shall be retained by the licensee for a period of two years commencing from the day of consignment.

In accordance with the provisions of section 35K, any person aggrieved by this decision may, within fourteen days after publication of this Notice, appeal against the decision or order by serving on the Minister for Fisheries a statement, in writing, on the grounds of their appeal.

- “ (b) the high tension generator shall be—
 (i) so designed that it maintains the tube potential and current within plus or minus 2% of the preset values; and

 - (A) a meter to indicate a deviation from the preset values of the tube potential or current; or
 - (B) a visual or audible indicator to react if the tube potential or current transgresses the preset values;
 - (ba) electronic circuits shall be provided to identify the choice and location of interchangeable filters;
 - (bc) where a choice of interchangeable filters can be made by an operation within the treatment room—
 - (i) exposure shall not be capable of being made until the choice has been verified by a confirming operation at the control panel; and
 - (ii) when the confirming operation has been completed, the chosen filter combination shall be displayed at the control panel; ”;

- (b) by deleting paragraphs (i) and (j) and substituting the following paragraphs—
 - “ (i) an indicator light shall be provided near the entrance to the treatment room to indicate when the useful beam is being transmitted;
 - (j) the equipment shall be so designed that—
 - (i) the full operating tube potential and current are attained within a period of time such that the skin dose to the patient does not exceed 50 milligrays during that time; or
 - (ii) the tube assembly carries a remotely operated shutter to control the useful beam so that the skin dose to the patient does not exceed 50 milligrays during the period of time it takes for the shutter to open;
 - (k) subject to paragraph (q), the equipment shall be provided with 2 automatic timers, comprising a primary timer and a back-up timer;
 - (l) the timers referred to in paragraph (k) shall be so designed and arranged that—
 - (i) the failure of one timer does not affect the operation of the other timer;
 - (ii) the possibility of accidental communication between the timers is minimised;
 - (iii) the failure of the main power supply to either timer will terminate the exposure;
 - (iv) each timer is capable of terminating the exposure independently of the other timer;
 - (v) the 2 terminating circuits are kept physically separated;
 - (vi) each timer counts upwards from zero so that an over exposure will give a reading;
 - (vii) the primary timer terminates the exposure when the preset time for termination of the exposure is reached;
 - (viii) the back-up timer terminates the exposure after, but not more than 0.1 minutes after, the preset time for termination of exposure on the primary timer;
 - (ix) each timer continues to record and display until the exposure is terminated by whatever means and retains the display of its readings on and after termination;
 - (x) in the event of a power failure, readings displayed at the time of that failure are stored in a retrievable form;
 - (xi) a single preselection of the exposure time presets both timers;
 - (xii) the displays of the timers are positioned closely together on the control panel, identical in form and easy to read;
 - and
 - (xiii) the timers are single scaled in minutes and decimals of minutes or in seconds only and are capable of being read without further calculation;
 - (m) there shall be a clearly visible or audible indicator on the control panel which is activated when the exposure is terminated otherwise than by the primary timer referred to in paragraph (k);

- (n) subject to paragraph (o), the electronic circuits of the equipment shall be so designed that after each exposure—
- (i) the tripping mechanism of the back-up timer is checked; and
 - (ii) the setting of each timer is returned to zero,
- by the operator of the equipment before a new exposure can be made;
- (o) the procedures referred to in paragraph (n) may be carried out automatically if the equipment is provided with timers that produce a permanent printout or chart record;
- (p) equipment which can operate at tube potentials exceeding 150 kilovolts peak shall be provided with a transmission monitoring ionisation chamber or equivalent device positioned in the useful beam to provide a continuous check on the constancy of the radiation output;
- (q) the chamber referred to in paragraph (p) may be used as an integrating dose meter to control treatment dose in the place of the primary timer referred to in paragraph (k) and where that chamber is so used—
- (i) the integrating dose meter shall terminate the exposure by switching off the high tension or closing the shutter when the preset dose for the treatment is reached;
 - (ii) the equipment shall be provided with a back-up timer so designed and arranged that it—
 - (A) is capable of terminating the exposure independently of the integrating dose meter; and
 - (B) terminates the exposure after the expiry of a period of time that exceeds the period of time estimated for the treatment by not more than 10% of that estimated period of time;
 - (iii) the integrating dose meter and the back-up timer shall count upwards from zero so that an over exposure will give a reading; and
 - (iv) the integrating dose meter and the back-up timer shall continue to record and display until the exposure is terminated by whatever means and shall retain the display of their readings on and after termination. ”
