1. This notice may be cited as the *Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery Notice 1993*.

Interpretation

2. In this notice unless the contrary intention appears—

“approved form” means in a form approved by the Director;

“area” means an area as described in Item 2 of the Schedule;

“authorised boat” means a boat which is authorised by licence or endorsement to take prawns from the waters of the fishery;

“boat units” means boat units calculated in accordance with clause 16;

“Code” means the Uniform Shipping Laws Code adopted by the Marine and Ports Council of Australia and published in the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette* on 11 May 1981;

“eight fathom net” shall be an otter trawl net with a headrope length exceeding 5 metres but not exceeding 14.83 metres and shall—

- (a) have attached to each end of the headrope a single otter board the measurements of which do not exceed 2.44 metres in length and 0.91 metres in breadth and have shoes which do not exceed 150 millimetres in width and 25 millimetres in depth;

- (b) have attached to it one ground chain the links of which do not exceed 10 millimetres in diameter; and

- (c) not contain meshes greater than 60 millimetres;

“Fishery” means the Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery declared under Clause 3;

“headrope length” means the distance measured along the headrope from where the otter trawl net attaches to one end of the headrope to where it attaches to the other end of the headrope;

“licence” means a licence authorising a boat to operate in the Fishery;

“nursery” means an area of the Fishery as described in Item 2 of the Schedule;

“otter board” means one of the boards used on a otter trawl net to keep the mouth of the net open while under tow;

“prawns” means all species of decapod crustacea of the Family *Penaeidae*;

“six fathom net” shall be an otter trawl net with a headrope length exceeding 5 metres but not exceeding 10.97 metres and shall—

- (a) have attached to each end of the headrope a single otter board the measurements of which do not exceed 2.44 metres in length and 0.91 metres in breadth and have shoes which do not exceed 150 millimetres in width and 25 millimetres in depth;

- (b) have attached to it one ground chain the links of which do not exceed 10 millimetres in diameter; and

- (c) not contain meshes greater than 60 millimetres;

“streamed” means towing a trawl net on the surface of the water with the cod end open; and

“try net” means an otter trawl net with a headrope length not exceeding 5 metres.

Declaration of limited entry fishery

3. (1) It is hereby declared that the taking of prawns from the waters described in Item 1 of the Schedule shall constitute a limited entry fishery to be called the Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery.

- (2) The fishery shall be divided into areas as described in Item 2 of the Schedule.

Prohibition on taking prawns

4. A person, other than a person to whom section 32 (5) of the Act applies, shall not take or attempt to take prawns by any means in the waters described in Item 1 of the Schedule—

- (a) other than in accordance with this notice; and

- (b) unless that person is operating from a boat which is an authorised boat.

Prohibition on selling or dealing

5. (1) A person shall not sell or deal, or attempt to sell or deal in any way with prawns taken from the Fishery in contravention of this notice.

(2) A person shall not sell or deal, or attempt to sell or deal with prawns taken from the Fishery unless those prawns were taken by the holder of a professional fisherman's licence when operating from an authorised boat.

Criteria to determine the boats which may operate in the Fishery

6. The criteria that shall be applied to determine the boats which may operate in the fishery are—

- (a) that immediately before the coming into operation of this notice the boat was authorised to take prawns in the Shark Bay Prawn Limited Entry Fishery; or
- (b) the boat replaces a boat to which paragraph (a) applied.

Application for a licence

7. The owner of a boat which fulfils the criteria in Clause 6 (a) or (b) may apply in accordance with Clause 20 for a licence authorising the boat to operate in the Fishery.

Details on a licence

8. A licence shall contain the following details—

- (a) the name and licensed fishing boat number in respect of which it is issued;
- (b) the name and address of the owner or licensee of that boat;
- (c) the licence number;
- (d) the date of issue;
- (e) the period for which the licence is valid;
- (f) the number of eight fathom nets which the boat is authorised to use; and
- (g) any conditions imposed on the licence.

Publication of details

9. The Director may from time to time give notice of—

- (a) the names of licensees;
- (b) the names and registration numbers of boats authorised to operate in the Fishery; and
- (c) the number of nets that a boat may use, by publishing that information in such a manner as deemed appropriate.

Closure of the Fishery

10. (1) A person shall not take or attempt to take prawns at any time within—

- (a) a nursery; or
- (b) any other area of the Fishery except in accordance with a declaration of the Minister made under subclause (2).

(2) The Minister may at any time, in writing, declare the times and dates during which prawns may or may not be taken from any specified area of the Fishery.

Authorised means of operating in the Fishery

11. (1) Unless otherwise authorised in writing by the Minister a person shall not take, or attempt to take prawns in the Fishery other than by either—

- (a) two or three or four eight fathom nets as endorsed on the licence; or
- (b) one try net.

(2) Unless otherwise authorised in writing by the Minister a boat authorised to be operated with two eight fathom nets shall not be greater than 375 boat units.

(3) A boat authorised to be operated with three eight fathom nets or four eight fathom nets shall not be greater than 650 boat units.

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subclause (1) a person operating an authorised boat and the licence is endorsed to permit the boat to use three eight fathom nets may use four six fathom nets.

(5) The licensee or the person in charge of a boat authorised to be operated in the Fishery shall not permit that boat to be operated with—

- (a) more nets than are specified on the licence for that boat if the boat is using eight fathom nets; or
- (b) subject to subclause (4), more than four six fathom nets.

Net entitlement and transfer

12. (1) All boats authorised to operate in the Fishery at the date of commencement of the operation of this notice shall be authorised to use two eight fathom nets and the licence shall be endorsed accordingly.

(2) The minimum net holding that may be endorsed on a licence is one eight fathom net.

(3) The owner of a boat authorised to operate in the Fishery may, subject to the provisions of subclause (1) and with the prior written approval of the Director, transfer to another authorised boat the whole or part of the whole net entitlement endorsed on the licence.

(4) Net entitlement may be transferred to a boat not authorised to operate in the Fishery and a new licence issued if—

- (a) the boat is a licensed Western Australian fishing boat; and
- (b) the boat is authorised to be operated in another Western Australian trawl fishery.

(5) A transfer made in accordance with the provisions of this Clause shall be either one eight fathom net or in multiples of one eight fathom net.

(6) Where the total net entitlement of an authorised boat is transferred and the boat does not have access to another limited entry fishery declared under this Act that boat shall be withdrawn from the Fishery and the Western Australian fishing boat licence cancelled.

Stowage of otter boards and otter trawl nets

13. (1) Unless otherwise approved in writing by the Minister, otter boards, trawl wires and otter trawl nets carried or attached to any boat shall be secured to that boat and kept out of the water—

- (a) between 0800 and 1700 hours each day in zones of the Fishery open to the taking of prawns except that otter trawl nets may be streamed between 0800 hours and 0900 hours on those days; and
- (b) at all times in zones of the Fishery closed to the taking of prawns.

(2) Boats licensed to operate in the Fishery are exempted from the provisions of this clause when trialling gear in the area of water described in Item 3 of the Schedule provided that—

- (a) the codend is open when the boat is being trialled;
- (b) no prawns are held on board the boat; and
- (c) trials are only undertaken during the hours of daylight.

(3) Trialling of gear in the area of water described in Item 3 of the Schedule may only commence 14 days prior to the opening of the Fishery.

Crew limits

14. Unless otherwise authorised in writing by the Minister a boat which is authorised to use—

- (a) two eight fathom nets shall not have more than six persons on the boat;
- (b) three eight fathom nets or four six fathom nets shall not have more than nine persons on board the boat; or
- (c) four eight fathom nets shall not have more than twelve persons on the boat; at any one time.

Transfer of licence

15. With the prior written approval of the Director a licence granted under this notice may be transferred and the licence shall be endorsed accordingly.

Boat replacement

16. (1) For the purpose of this clause—

“B” means “breadth” as defined in the Code;

“D” means “depth” as defined in the Code;

“IEP” is installed engine power in kilowatts of the boat’s engine as certified by the supplier; and

“ML” means “measured length” as defined in the Code measured in accordance with Appendix A to Section one of the Code.

(2) Subject to the prior written approval of the Director a boat licensed to operate in the Fishery may be replaced by another boat provided that the boat units of the replacement boat do not exceed the number permitted in accordance with subclauses 11(2) and 11(3) and are calculated in accordance with the following formula—

$$\frac{ML \times B \times D \times 0.6}{2.83} + IEP$$

Boat modification

17. The owner of a boat authorised to operate in the Fishery shall not, without the prior written approval of the Director repower the boat by—

- (a) changing the configuration of the existing engine, gearbox, propeller shaft or other components; or
- (b) installing a new engine.

Engine seals

18. (1) The owner of a boat licensed to operate in the Fishery shall—

- (a) on the written instruction of the Director cause the suppliers of an engine for the boat to install a lead seal on the fuel pump of the engine; and
- (b) authorise the Director to install or permit the installation of any further lead seals as the Director may require.

(2) The owner of a boat which has had a seal installed on the engine in accordance with subclause 1 (a) or (b) shall—

- (a) not permit the removal or allow any interference to the seal without the prior written approval of the Director; and

Defines and sets aside the following area of the Outer Harbour of the Port of Fremantle for the purpose of water ski-ing and imposes as a condition of water ski-ing in any of the following areas of the Port that every person engaged therein shall conform with the rules of the Western Australian Water Ski Association for the time being in force.

(i) Ski-ing Area—Definition

Within the boundaries of an imaginary line commencing at Latitude 32d 15.57' South, Longitude 115d 44.24' East, thence extending in a south-westerly direction in an easy curve to the right at a constant 600 metres distance from the shoreline and running parallel to the shoreline at 600 metres distance to a point 600 metres from the Garden Island causeway groyne in position Latitude 32d 16.29' South, Longitude 115d 42.26' East, thence in a northerly direction parallel to and 600 metres from the eastern side of the groyne until the line intersects the "Naval Waters" limiting boundary in position Latitude 32d 14.54' South, Longitude 115d 42.21' East, thence along the "Naval Waters" boundary in an approximately north-easterly direction to a point on the "Naval Waters" boundary in position Latitude 32d 15.57' South, Longitude 115d 42.58' East, from this point the ski-ing area's defined boundary continues in a south-easterly direction of a true bearing of 317 degrees to a position Latitude 32d 15.57' South, Longitude 115d 44.24' East, this being the termination point and coinciding with the point of commencement as mentioned above.

(ii) Restricted Area

The only exception to the defined ski-ing area is within Minstrel Channel where ski-ing is strictly forbidden.

- (iii) The take-off area of 200 metres length is situated along the foreshore immediately opposite Weld Street, Rockingham, and a corridor of the same width from the shore extends westward to meet the ski area's eastern boundary on the same alignment as Weld Street of approximate bearing of 130d 00' true.

The corridor will be marked by PVC-type spar buoys.

Ski-ing is permitted within the corridor whilst travelling between the take-off area and the ski-ing area but all craft must keep to the starboard side of the thoroughfare and proceed with proper lookout and caution.

3. Limits the speed of motor boats to that of eight knots within the following areas of the Port of Fremantle.

- (i) Within the Inner Harbour
- (ii) Within that part of the Outer Harbour eastward of an imaginary line extending from the North Mole Lighthouse to a point where the northern boundary of the Outer Harbour meets the shore of the mainland
- (iii) Within a radius of 1 740 metres or thereabouts from position Latitude 32d 14.05' South approximately, Longitude 115d 45.78' East approximately, intersecting the shoreline North of James Point and continuing in a southerly direction to terminate at position Latitude 32d 14.695' South Longitude 115d 44.96' East, thence in an easterly direction on a true bearing of 109d 00' to the shoreline.
- (iv) In any navigational channel or within 45 metres of any buoy or beacon marking any such channel.

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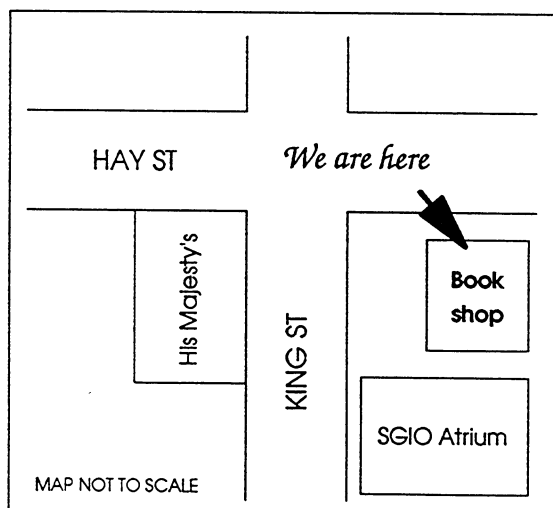
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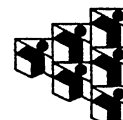
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
