Made by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council under section 5.

**Citation**

1. This order may be cited as the *Fire Brigades (Rockingham Fire District) Order 1993*.

**Rockingham Fire District**

2. The boundaries of the Rockingham Fire District are adjusted so that the boundaries are in accordance with the description in the Schedule.

**SCHEDULE**

[Clause 2]

**ROCKINGHAM FIRE DISTRICT**

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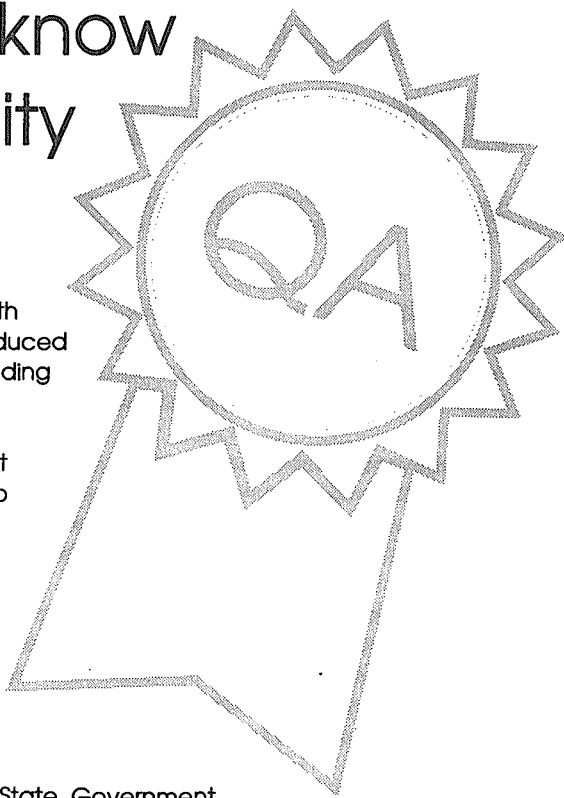
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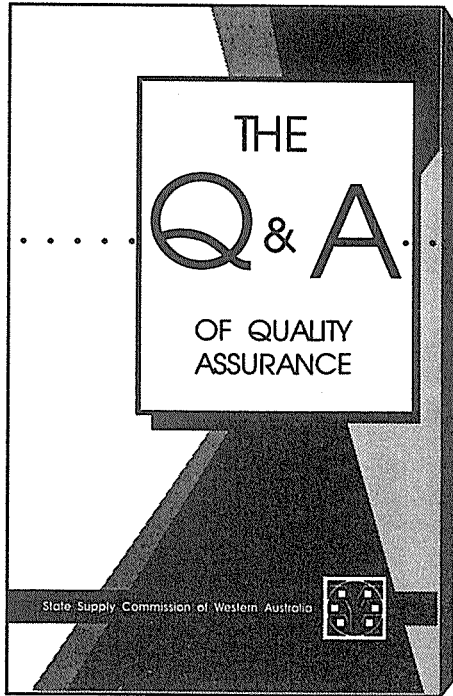
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
