**AGRICULTURE****AG401****AGRICULTURE AND RELATED RESOURCES PROTECTION ACT 1976  
POISONING OF FERAL GOATS IN PARTICULAR AREAS**

Notice under Section 68 (1)

**Agriculture Protection Board to use Poison**

1. The Agriculture Protection Board proposes to use Sodium Fluoroacetate (1080) in the area specified in the schedule.

**Taking of feral goats prohibited absolutely for a period of time**

The taking of feral goats is prohibited absolutely in the area specified in the schedule from 4 November 1995 to 10 November 1995.

**Offence to take feral goats—penalty \$1,000**

Any person who takes feral goats in the area specified in the schedule commits an offence under Section 68 (6) of the Act, the penalty for which is \$1,000.

**WARNING: FERAL GOATS TAKEN FROM THE AREA SPECIFIED IN THE SCHEDULE DURING THE TIME THIS NOTICE IS IN FORCE ARE LIKELY TO ENDANGER OR BE DETRIMENTAL TO HUMAN HEALTH OR LIFE IF HANDLED OR CONSUMED.**

**Schedule 1 amended**

3. Schedule 1 to the principal regulations is amended by deleting the item "Instrument Electrical Fitting".

**Savings**

4. (1) In this regulation “**former trade**” means the trade deleted by regulation 3 of these regulations from the trades listed in Schedule 1 to the principal regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in these regulations an apprenticeship agreement relating to the former trade continues in force subject to the *Industrial Training Act 1975*, the principal regulations and the *Industrial Training (General Apprenticeship) Regulations 1981* as though the former trade continued to be a trade under the Act after the commencement of these regulations.

(3) Any record, certificate or order made or given in relation to an apprenticeship in the former trade continues to have effect notwithstanding anything in these regulations.

(4) Any person who completes the course of training prescribed in relation to the former trade under the principal regulations as in force before the commencement of these regulations is entitled to be issued with a certificate to that effect as though the former trade continued to be a trade under the Act at the time of such completion.

INDUSTRIAL TRAINING (APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING)

**Schedule 1 amended**

3. Schedule 1 to the principal regulations is amended —

(a) by deleting the following items —

“ Marine Mechanics ”

“ Motor Cycle Mechanics ”

“ Motor Mechanics ”; and

(b) by inserting after the item “Engine Reconditioning” the following item —

“ Engineering Tradesperson (Automotive) ”.

**Schedule 2 amended**

**Savings**

7. (1) In this regulation "**former trade**" means a trade deleted by regulation 3 of these regulations from the trades listed in Schedule 1 to the principal regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in these regulations an apprenticeship agreement relating to a former trade continues in force subject to the *Industrial Training Act 1975*, the principal regulations and the *Industrial Training (General Apprenticeship) Regulations 1981* as though the former trade continued to be a trade under the Act after the commencement of these regulations.

(3) Any record, certificate or order made or given in relation to an apprenticeship in a former trade continues to have effect notwithstanding anything in these regulations.

(4) Any person who completes the course of training prescribed in relation to a former trade under the principal regulations as in force before the commencement of these regulations is entitled to be issued with a certificate to that effect as though the former trade continued to be a trade under the Act at the time of such completion.

**HEALTH****HE301****TOBACCO CONTROL ACT 1990****TOBACCO CONTROL (EXEMPTION) NOTICE (No. 3) 1995**

Made by the Minister for Health under section 14 of the Act after consultation with the Minister for Sport and Recreation.

**Citation**

1. This notice may be cited as the *Tobacco Control (Exemption) Notice (No. 3) 1995*.

**Exemption**

2. (1) Subject to the conditions set out in clause 3, the Western Australian Cricket Association (Incorporated) and its agents and servants and all persons entitled to the use in Western Australia of Benson and Hedges trademarks and brand names and their agents and servants are exempted from the operation of sections 5 and 8 of the *Tobacco Control Act 1990* during the period 1 October 1995 to 30 April 1996 in respect of signs, clothing and items (other than the items referred to in subclause (2)) that—

- (a) are publicly displayed at the Western Australian Cricket Association ground at Nelson Crescent, East Perth ("the WACA ground") during cricket test matches, World Series Cricket matches and Sheffield Shield cricket matches held at the WACA ground; and
- (b) promote, bear or contain Benson and Hedges trademarks or brand names.

(2) All persons are exempted from the operation of sections 5 and 8 of the *Tobacco Control Act 1990* during the periods referred to in subclause (1) in respect of itinerary cards, official tour programs, media guides and commemorative ports and wines promoting, bearing or containing—

- (a) Benson and Hedges trademarks or brand names; and
- (b) except in the case of the commemorative ports and wines, details of cricket fixtures in Australia during the 1995/1996 cricket season.

**Conditions**

3. The conditions subject to which the exemption referred to in clause 2 (1) is granted are that—

- (a) the signs, clothing and items referred to in clause 2 (1) shall be limited to—
  - (i) 4 perimeter signs, each not exceeding 22.496 metres in length and 0.914 metres in height;
  - (ii) one scoreboard sign not exceeding 10 metres in length and one metre in height;
  - (iii) one, sign (other than a perimeter sign or a scoreboard sign) not exceeding 6 metres in length and 6 metres in height;
  - (iv) one drinks trolley;
  - (v) any number of flags;
  - (vi) 2 on-grass signs, each not exceeding 6 metres in length and 6 metres in height; and
  - (vii) clothing worn by the players during the cricket matches referred to in clause 2 (1) (a);
- (b) a Benson and Hedges trademark or brand name displayed on any sign, clothing or item (other than a flag or on-grass sign) referred to in clause 2 (1) shall be accompanied by the health warning—
  - (i) "SMOKING KILLS"; or
  - (ii) "SMOKING IS ADDICTIVE";
- (c) the area exclusively devoted to the display of a health warning referred to in paragraph (b) shall be not less than one third of the total area devoted to the display of the Benson and Hedges trademark or brand name that the health warning accompanies;
- (d) a health warning referred to in paragraph (b) shall—
  - (i) immediately precede the first word, number or symbol of the Benson and Hedges trademark or brand name that the health warning accompanies;
  - (ii) appear in white Helvetica Bold capitals on a black background; and
  - (iii) occupy not less than 80% of the area devoted to the display of the health warning.

- (e) the letters of the statement "Health Authority Warning" shall—
- (i) appear in Helvetica Medium capitals and Helvetica Medium lower case type; and
  - (ii) not exceed half the height of the letters used for the health warning referred to in paragraph (b); and
- (f) all signs, clothing and items (including flags and on-grass signs) shall be removed from public display by 30 April 1996.

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
