- (k) in subparagraph 14(c)(x) by deleting “in any year”; and
- (l) in subparagraphs 14(c)(i), 14(c)(ii), 14(c)(iii), 14(c)(iv), 14(c)(v), 14(c)(vi), 14(c)(vii), 14(c)(viii), 14(c)(ix) and 14(c)(x), by deleting “shall not”.

“5.2.12 Tourist Enterprise

- (i) Development within the Tourist Enterprise Zone shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Building Code of Australia and the provisions of subclause (iii) of this clause.
 - (ii) Table No. 1 defines the uses permitted within the Tourist Enterprise Zone.
 - (iii) In the case of development within the Tourist Enterprise Zone, Council shall have regard to the following standards—
 - (a) The overall building plot ratio calculated on all uses shall not exceed 0.5;
 - (b) The provisions of the Residential R10 Planning Code shall apply in the Tourist Enterprise Zone with respect to the residential component of development on a lot within the zone;

 - Minimum Effective Frontage (m): 17 metres

 - (iv) (a) Prior to development/subdivision occurring in the Pemberton Tourist Enterprise zone, a Development Guide Plan shall be approved by Council and the Western Australian Planning Commission. This plan will illustrate—
 - indicative subdivision;
 - indicative land uses;
 - indicative road alterations;
 - civic design elements, landscaping and street furniture;
 - any other matter necessary for the orderly and proper development of the area.
 - (b) The Development Guide Plan shall contain measures for the implementation of subdivision and development within the precinct.
 - (c) All use and development (including subdivision) shall have regard to the Development Guide Plan and be in accordance with TPS No. 2. The Development Guide Plan may only be adopted after it has been advertised for public comment or subsequently modified after such modification has been advertised.
- The Development Guide Plan can only be adopted in conjunction with the Design Guidelines required pursuant to Clause 5.3.3.

- (d) Where there is any inconsistency between Table 1 and the Development Guide Plan the Development Guide Plan shall take precedence.
- (e) Despite the provision of sub-paragraph (a) Council may approve P uses prior to the adoption of the Development Guide Plan and Design Guidelines.
- (v) "5.2.12 Appeal rights
 - (a) Where Council rejects the Development Guide Plan for the Pemberton Tourist Enterprise zone or attaches conditions or requires modification which the applicant considers unreasonable, the applicant shall have a right of appeal pursuant to Part V of the Act.
 - (b) Notwithstanding Clause 5.2.12 (v) a) the applicant shall prior to exercising any right of appeal pursuant to Part V of the Act, submit the Development Guide Plan and Council's resolution to the Western Australian Planning Commission and request the Western Australian Planning Commission to make a determination.

4. Amending Clause 5.3 (Policy Precincts—Special Design) of the Scheme Text by the insertion of a new Clause 5.3.3 to read—

"Clause 5.3.3 Precinct Pemberton 2 (PP2)

Councils objectives, recognising the Precincts townscape and recreational significance are—

- To encourage the development of Precinct Pemberton 2 as one of the focal points for tourist/visitor related activities within the Pemberton townsite.
- Encourage a variety of tourist—related land use activities including chalet accommodation, cottage industry and bed/breakfast accommodation.
- Consolidate the commercial nature of Brockman Street.
- Encourage development which recognises the historic architectural style and scale of development present within the Pemberton townsite.
- To allow residential development which is compatible with the objectives of the Precinct as outlined above.

- (c) Council will require that development or works which are the subject of an application for planning approval adhere as closely as possible to the intent of the Policy Statement and to the Development guidelines, and Council when considering the application may negotiate with the applicant means of carrying out the development in order to achieve Council's objective.
- (d) Where planning Approval is granted under the provisions of this Clause, Council will require that buildings or other structures are of design and materials compatible with other buildings in the Precinct and the intent of Council's Objective.
- (e) The provisions of this clause will apply in addition to any other scheme requirement applying to zones in the scheme, and where any provision of this clause is inconsistent with any other requirement of the scheme, the provisions of this clause shall prevail.
- (f) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Residential Planning Codes, Council may vary the front building setback within the Precinct in order to achieve a consistent structure in keeping with the original streetscape.
