Declaration of School Boundaries pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 21.

The Honourable Minister for Education has declared that the boundaries for the schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children who live within the areas and boundaries stated shall attend the schools to which such boundaries apply unless directed otherwise or unless an option is provided. Children who live outside the areas and boundaries shall not attend the schools to which such boundaries apply unless written approval for such admission is obtained from the undersigned.

BOULDER PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the Super Pit at a point coinciding with the easterly extension of Millen Street, west from this point to and along Millen Street to Ivanhoe Street, south along Ivanhoe Street and its extension to Anzac Drive and continuing therefrom in a southerly direction.

The boundary street of Ivanhoe Street (east side), is included within the area for Boulder Primary School, while the boundary parts of Millen Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for Boulder Primary School.

BUNGAREE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the junction of Read Street and Swinstone Street, west along Swinstone Street to Townsend Road, west and southwest along Townsend Road to the western arm of Boon Court, south between Boon Court and Chester Way to the east, and Cato Court and Daley Court to the west, to the southern extremity of Daley Court, southwest from this point to the western extremity of Swifts Court, continuing in a southwesterly direction to the proposed Garden Island Highway, west along the alignment of the Garden Island Highway to Read Street, and north along Read Street to Swinstone Street.

The boundary parts of Townsend Road east of Broughton Way (both sides), Garden Island Highway (north side) and Read Street (west side) and the boundary street of Swinstone Street (both sides), are included within the area for Bungaree Primary School, while the boundary parts of Townsend Road west of Broughton Way (both sides) are excluded from the area for Bungaree Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Bungaree, Rockingham Beach and Safety Bay Primary Schools:

From the point at which the Rockingham North Branch Drain enters Lake Richmond, east along the Drain to a point due north of the junction of Broughton Way and Townsend Road, south from this point to Townsend Road, southwest along Townsend Road to the western arm of Boon Court, south between Boon Court and Chester Way to the east, and Cato Court and Daley Court to the west, to the southern extremity of Daley Court, southwest from this point to the western extremity of Swifts Court, continuing in a southwesterly direction to the proposed Garden Island Highway, northwest along the alignment of Garden Island Highway to Lake Richmond, and east and north along the edge of Lake Richmond to the Rockingham North Branch Drain.

The boundary parts of Townsend Road (both sides) and the proposed Garden Island Highway (north side) are included within the optional area.

The following is an optional area for Bungaree, Hillman and Rockingham Beach Primary Schools:

The area bounded by Patterson Road (south side), Read Street (east side), Rae Road (north side) and Ennis Avenue (west side).

The following is an optional area for Bungaree, Cooloongup and Safety Bay Primary Schools:

The area bounded by Waikiki Road (both sides), Malibu Road (north side), Read Street (west side) and Rae Road (south side).

CALISTA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this schools is as follows:

From the junction of Wellard Road and Parmelia Avenue, north along Parmelia Avenue to Challenger Avenue, west along Challenger Avenue to Gilmore Avenue, north along Gilmore Avenue to a point coinciding with the southern arm of Leasham Way, west from this point to and along Leasham Way to Summerton Road, west along Summerton Road to Stanyford Way, north along Stanyford Way to Gentle Road, west along Gentle Road to Tasker Road, west along Tasker Road to the proposed Fremantle Rockingham Highway, south along the proposed Fremantle Rockingham Highway to Wellard Road and eastsoutheast along Wellard Road to Parmelia Avenue.

The boundary parts of Wellard Road (north side), Challenger Avenue (both sides), Gilmore Avenue (west side) and the Fremantle Rockingham Highway (east side) are included within the area for Calista Primary School, while the boundary parts of Parmelia Avenue (both sides), Leasham Way (both sides), Stanyford Way (both sides), Tasker Road (both sides), Gentle Road (both sides) and the boundary street of Summerton Road (both sides) are excluded from the area for Calista Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Calista Primary School and Orelia Primary School:

From the junction of Gilmore Avenue and Challenger Avenue, east along Challenger Avenue to Parmelia Avenue, north along Parmelia Avenue to Sulphur Road, west along Sulphur Road to Gilmore Avenue and south along Gilmore Avenue to Challenger Avenue.

The boundary parts of Sulphur Road (south side) and Gilmore Avenue (east side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Parmelia Avenue (both sides) and the boundary street of Challenger Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

CLIFTON HILLS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is an optional area for Clifton Hills and Gosnells Primary Schools:

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, southwest along Tonkin Highway to the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the boundary between the City of Gosnells and the City of Armadale, in a general easterly direction along this boundary to the western site boundary of Cohuna Wildlife Sanctuary, north from this point to a point due east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and west along Mills Road East to Tonkin Highway.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (southeast side) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within the optional area.

COOLOONGUP PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the intersection of Rae Road and Read Street, southsoutheast along Read Street to a point adjacent to the northern arm of Frome Way, in an eastnortheasterly direction from this point to and along Frome Way to Broaden Drive, south along Broaden Drive to Norring Street, in an eastnortheasterly direction between Raby Court, Lara Court, Greta Court and Rydal Court to the north and Tanby Place, Windale Place and Toora Place to the south to and across Linville Avenue and Willmott Drive to Grange Drive, continuing in a general northeasterly direction along Grange Drive to Ennis Avenue, northwest along Ennis Avenue to Rae Road and in a westsouthwesterly direction along Rae Road to Read Street.

The boundary parts of Read Street (east side), Broaden Drive (both sides), Ennis Avenue (west side), Rae Road (south side) and the boundary street of Grange Drive (north side) are included within the area for Cooloongup Primary School, while the boundary parts of Frome Way (both sides) are excluded from the area for Cooloongup Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Cooloongup, Bungaree and Safety Bay Primary Schools:

The area bounded by Read Street (west side), Rae Road (south side), Waikiki Road (both sides) and Malibu Road (north side).

The following is an optional area for Cooloongup and Hillman Primary Schools:

From the intersection of Dixon Road and the proposed Garden Island Highway, westsouthwest along the proposed Garden Island Highway to Ennis Avenue, southeast and south along Ennis Avenue to Willmott Drive, east from this point to Mandurah Road and in a general northerly direction along Mandurah Road to Dixon Road.

The boundary parts of the proposed Garden Island Expressway (south side), Ennis Avenue (east side) and Mandurah Road (west side) are included within the optional area.

DIANELLA HEIGHTS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is a contributory area to this school:

From the junction of Yirrigan Drive and Broadmoor Avenue, north along Broadmoor Avenue to Ajana Way, north from this point to the common junctions of Benghazi Loop, Sattelberg Ramble and Pomona Lane, continuing north to the western extension of Eora Creek Gardens, in a general northerly direction to Dechaineux Parkway, in a general northerly direction along the eastern arm of Dechaineux Parkway to and across Cherrywood Avenue to Reid Highway, west along Reid Highway to Northwood Drive, south along Northwood Drive to Yirrigan Drive and east along Yirrigan Drive to Broadmoor Avenue.

The boundary parts of Reid Highway (south side), Northwood Drive (east side), Yirrigan Drive (north side) and Dechaineux Parkway (both sides) and the boundary street of Broadmoor Avenue (west side) are included within the area for Dianella Heights Primary School.

DUDLEY PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the Estuary Bridge adjacent to Pinjarra Road, east along Pinjarra Road to the Mandurah Bypass, south along the Mandurah Bypass to a point coinciding with the southern extremity of Wellstead Way and the northern extremity of Tankerton Way, east from this point to and across Templetonia Park to the western extremity of Maclaggan Turn, southeast along Maclaggan Turn to Newlyn Way, in a general easterly direction to and across Casula Avenue to Alderley Place, east and northnortheast along Alderley Place and its extension to Pinjarra Road, east along Pinjarra Road to the Serpentine River, south along the Serpentine River to the Peel Inlet, west along the Peel Inlet to the Mandurah Estuary and north along the Mandurah Estuary to the Estuary Bridge.

The boundary parts of Pinjarra Road (south side) are included within the area for Dudley Park Primary School, while the boundary parts of the Mandurah Bypass (east side), Maclaggan Turn (both sides) and the boundary street of Alderley Place (both sides) are excluded from the area for Dudley Park Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Dudley Park and Greenfields Primary Schools:

From the intersection of Pinjarra Road and the Mandurah Bypass, south along the Mandurah Bypass to a point coinciding with the southern extremity of Wellstead Way and the northern extremity of Tankerton Way, east from this point to and across Templetonia Park to the western extremity of Maclaggan Turn, southeast along Maclaggan Turn to Newlyn Way, in a general easterly direction to and across Casula Avenue to Alderley Place, east and northnortheast along Alderley Place and its extension to Pinjarra Road, and west along Pinjarra Road to the Mandurah Bypass.

The boundary parts of the Mandurah Bypass (east side), Maclaggan Turn (both sides), Pinjarra Road (south side), and the boundary street of Alderley Place (both sides), are included within the optional area.

EAST KALGOORLIE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

The Kalgoorlie-Leonora Road at a point adjacent to Kalgoorlie International Speedway, in a general southerly direction from this point along the Kalgoorlie-Leonora Road and the Eastern By-Pass Road to a point coinciding with the eastern extension of Millen Street and continuing east from this point to the Super Pit.

The boundary parts of the Kalgoorlie-Leonora Road (east side) and the Eastern By-Pass Road (east side) are included within the area for East Kalgoorlie Primary School.

EAST MADDINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is an optional area for East Maddington and Gosnells Primary Schools:

From the eastern extremity of Rushton Road, west and northwest along Rushton Road to Ellis Brook, in a general westerly direction along Ellis Brook to Mills Road West, northwest along Mills Road West to Gosnells Road, west along Gosnells Road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road, west along Fremantle Road to the railway line, southeast and south along the railway line to a point due west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east from this point to Tonkin Highway, northeast along Tonkin Highway to Mills Road East, east along Mills Road East to Pages Way and due east from this point.

The boundary parts of Rushton Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Fremantle Road (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (west side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Mills Road West (both sides), Gosnells Road (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

ELLENBROOK PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the confluence of the Swan River and Ellen Brook, in a general northerly direction along Ellen Brook to the locality boundary of Belhus and Ellenbrook, in a general northnorthwesterly direction along this boundary to its westernmost point, in a general northwesterly direction from this point to the junction of the unmade Halden Road and Maralla Road, west along the unmade alignment of Maralla Road to the north-south alignment of the locality boundary between Ellenbrook and Bullsbrook, south along this boundary to the locality boundary between Ellenbrook and Lexia, southwest along this boundary to Gngangara Road, east along Gngangara Road to Henry Street and east along Henry Street and its extension to the Swan River.

The boundary parts of Maralla Road (both sides) are included within the area for Ellenbrook Primary School, while the boundary parts of Gngangara Road (both sides) and the boundary street of Henry Street (both sides), are excluded from the area for Ellenbrook Primary School.

Children attending Government schools in Year 7 in 1996, and living within the area for Ellenbrook Primary School, may complete their primary education at their 1995 school or may transfer to Ellenbrook Primary School.

Children in Years 1 to 6 inclusive in 1996 (Years 1 to 7 thereafter), and living within the area for Ellenbrook Primary School shall attend Ellenbrook Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Ellenbrook, Caversham and Upper Swan Primary Schools:

The locality of Henley Brook as delineated in the 1996 Perth StreetSmart Directory.

GOSNELLS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is an optional area for Gosnells and East Maddington Primary Schools:

From the eastern extremity of Rushton Road, west and northwest along Rushton Road to Ellis Brook, in a general westerly direction along Ellis Brook to Mills Road West, northwest along Mills Road West to Gosnells Road, west along Gosnells Road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road, west along Fremantle Road to the railway line, southeast and south along the railway line to a point due west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east from this point to Tonkin Highway, northeast along Tonkin Highway to Mills Road East, east along Mills Road East to Pages Way and due east from this point.

The boundary parts of Rushton Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Fremantle Road (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (west side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Mills Road West (both sides), Gosnells Road (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

The following is an optional area for Gosnells and Clifton Hills Primary Schools:

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, southwest along Tonkin Highway to the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the boundary between the City of Gosnells and the City of Armadale, in a general easterly direction along this boundary to the western site boundary of Cohuna Wildlife Sanctuary, north from this point to a point due east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and west along Mills Road East to Tonkin Highway.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (southeast side) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within the optional area.

GREENFIELDS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the intersection of Fremantle Road and Pinjarra Road, east along Pinjarra Road to Lakes Road, northeast along Lakes Road to Murdoch Drive, in a westerly direction along Murdoch Drive to Valentine Drive, northeast along Valentine Drive to Cassilis Court, north between Cassilis Court and Takura Close on the east and Esprit Parkway on the west to and across Waldron Boulevard, continuing north between Royce Road and Perida Way to Exchequer Avenue, in a general westerly direction along Exchequer Avenue to Bortolo Drive, north along Bortolo Drive to a point due east of the junction of Rafferty Road and Fremantle Road, west from this point to Fremantle Road and south along Fremantle Road to Pinjarra Road.

The boundary parts of Pinjarra Road (north side), Lakes Road (west side), Murdoch Drive (both sides), Exchequer Avenue (both sides) and Fremantle Road (east side) are included within the area for Greenfields Primary School, while the boundary parts of Valentine Drive (both sides) and Bortolo Drive (both sides) are excluded from the area for Greenfields Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Greenfields and Dudley Park Primary Schools:

From the intersection of Pinjarra Road and the Mandurah Bypass, south along the Mandurah Bypass to a point coinciding with the southern extremity of Wellstead Way and the northern extremity of Tankerton Way, east from this point to and across Templetonia Park to the western extremity of MacLaggan Turn, southeast along MacLaggan Turn to Newlyn Way, in a general easterly direction to and across Casula Avenue to Alderley Place, east and northnortheast along Alderley Place and its extension to Pinjarra Road, and west along Pinjarra Road to the Mandurah Bypass.

The boundary parts of the Mandurah Bypass (east side), MacLaggan Turn (both sides), Pinjarra Road (south side), and the boundary street of Alderley Place (both sides), are included within the optional area.

HANNANS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

The Kalgoorlie-Leonora Road at a point adjacent to Kalgoorlie International Speedway, south from this point along the Kalgoorlie-Leonora Road to the extension of Killarney Street, southwest to and along Killarney Street and its extension to Kalgoorlie Arboretum, and continuing therefrom in a south-westerly direction.

The boundary parts of the Kalgoorlie-Leonora Road (west side) and the boundary street of Killarney Street (both sides) are included within the area for Hannans Primary School.

HOPE VALLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the Indian Ocean at a point coinciding with the westerly extension of Hope Valley Road, east from this point to and along Hope Valley Road to Rockingham Road, in a general eastsoutheasterly direction along Hope Valley Road to Anketell Road, east along Anketell Road to Thomas Road, southwest and west along Thomas Road to Rockingham Road and due west from this point to the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of Hope Valley Road (south side), Anketell Road (south side) and Thomas Road (north side) are included within the area for Hope Valley Primary School.

Both sides of Mandogalup Road between Anketell Road and Norkett Road are optional for Hope Valley, Orelia and Wattleup Primary Schools.

KALGOORLIE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the junction of Anzac Drive and Great Eastern Highway, northeast along Great Eastern Highway to a point coinciding with the westerly extension of Speculation Road, in a general easterly direction from this point to Meldrum Avenue, northnortheast along Meldrum Avenue to Charles Street, eastsoutheast along Charles Street to Cheetham Street, northeast along Cheetham Street to Wilson Street, southeast along Wilson Street to Roberts Street, northeast along Roberts Street to the Eastern By-Pass Road, northnorthwest along the Eastern By-Pass Road to Hare Street, southwest along Hare Street to the railway line, southeast along the railway line to the northern extension of Collins Street, southwest from this point to and along Collins Street to Marshall Street and continuing from this point in a southwesterly direction to Kalgoorlie Sewerage Ponds.

The boundary parts of Great Eastern Highway (northwest side), Charles Street (north side), Wilson Street (northeast side), Roberts Street (both sides), the Eastern By-Pass Road (west side), and the boundary streets of Meldrum Avenue (west side), Cheetham Street (both sides) and Collins Street (both sides) are included within the area for Kalgoorlie Primary School, while the boundary parts of Hare Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for Kalgoorlie Primary School.

KOORANA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the junction of Port Kennedy Drive and Warnbro Sound Avenue, in a general northerly direction along Warnbro Sound Avenue to a point coinciding with the westerly extension of Oslo Place, east from this point between Moreton Crescent, Dress Circle and Ryde Close to the north and Manly Crescent, Darwin Place and Rhyl Close to the south, to Ennis Avenue, south along Ennis Avenue to Port Kennedy Drive and westsouthwest along Port Kennedy Drive to Warnbro Sound Avenue.

The boundary parts of Warnbro Sound Avenue (east side), Ennis Avenue (west side) and Port Kennedy Drive (both sides) are included within the area for Koorana Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Koorana and Warnbro Primary Schools:

From the intersection of Safety Bay Road and Warnbro Sound Avenue, south along Warnbro Sound Avenue to a point coinciding with the westerly extension of Oslo Place, east from this point between Moreton Crescent, Dress Circle and Ryde Close to the north and Manly Crescent, Darwin Place and Rhyl Close to the south, to Ennis Avenue, north along Ennis Avenue to Safety Bay Road, and west along Safety Bay Road to Warnbro Sound Avenue.

The following is an optional area for Koorana, Chathouse, East Waikiki and Warnbro Primary Schools:

The area bounded by Gwangara Drive (south side), Read Street (east side), Safety Bay Road (north side), Ennis Avenue (west side) and Willmott Drive (south side).

KOORILLA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is an optional area for Koorilla and Southwell Primary Schools:

From the intersection of Forrest Road and Stock Road, south along Stock Road to Phoenix Road, east along Phoenix Road to North Lake Road, north along North Lake Road to the proposed Roe Highway, westsouthwest along the alignment of the Roe Highway to Forrest Road, and west along Forrest Road to Stock Road.

The boundary parts of Stock Road (east side), Phoenix Road (north side), North Lake Road (west side), the Roe Highway (south side) and Forrest Road (south side) are included within the optional area.

LEDA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

The locality of Leda as delineated in the 1996 Perth StreetSmart Directory.

The following is an optional area for Leda and Medina Primary Schools:

The locality of Wellard as delineated in the 1996 Perth StreetSmart Directory.

MANDURAH PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

Southeast from the mouth of the Mandurah Estuary to the Estuary Bridge (adjacent to Pinjarra Road), east along Pinjarra Road to Fremantle Road, north along Fremantle Road to the easterly extension of Morfitt Street, west to and along Morfitt Street to Anstruther Road, north and northwest along Anstruther Road to Henson Street and northwest along Henson Street to the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of Pinjarra Road (north side), Fremantle Road (west side), Anstruther Road (both sides), and the boundary streets of Morfitt Street (both sides) and Henson Street (both sides) are included within the area for Mandurah Primary School.

Children living outside the boundary for Mandurah Primary School may enrol there, subject to accommodation being available.

MEDINA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the junction of Thomas Road and Gilmore Avenue, south along Gilmore Avenue to a point coinciding with the southern arm of Leasham Way, west from this point to and along Leasham Way to Summerton Road, west along Summerton Road to Stanyford Way, north along Stanyford Way to Gentle Road, west along Gentle Road to Tasker Road, west along Tasker Road to the proposed Fremantle Rockingham Highway, north along the proposed Fremantle Rockingham Highway to Thomas Road, and east along Thomas Road to Gilmore Avenue.

The boundary parts of Gilmore Avenue (west side), Leasham Way (both sides), Stanyford Way (both sides), Gentle Road (both sides), Tasker Road (both sides), Fremantle Rockingham Highway (east side), Thomas Road (south side) and the boundary street of Summerton Road (both sides) are included within the area for Medina Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Medina and Leda Primary Schools:

The locality of Wellard as delineated in the 1996 Perth StreetSmart Directory.

MOUNT LOCKYER PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the junction of Albany Highway and Link Road, southwest along Link Road to Lancaster Road, east along Lancaster Road to Marbelup Street, south along Marbelup Street and its continuation to the westerly extension of Salvado Road, east and southeast along Salvado Road to Le Grande Avenue, east and eastnortheast along Le Grande Avenue to Albany Highway, southeast along Albany Highway to Hanrahan Road, southwest and south along Hanrahan Road to Frenchman Bay Road, southwest along Frenchman Bay Road to Lower Denmark Road and west along Lower Denmark Road.

The boundary parts of Hanrahan Road are included within the area for Mount Lockyer Primary School, while the boundary parts of Lancaster Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Frenchman Bay Road (both sides), Lower Denmark Road (both sides) and the boundary streets of Link Road (both sides), Marbelup Street (both sides), Salvado Road (both sides) and Le Grande Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the area for Mount Lockyer Primary School.

The following are optional areas for Mount Lockyer and Yakamia Primary Schools:

- (a) From the junction of Harvey Road and Chester Pass Road, in a general southwesterly direction along Chester Pass Road to Albany Highway, northwest along Albany Highway to Le Grande Avenue, westsouthwest along Le Grande Avenue to Salvado Road, northwest and west along Salvado Road and its extension to the southerly extension of Marbelup Street, north to and along Marbelup Street to Lancaster Road, west along Lancaster Road to Link Road, and northeast along Link Road to Albany Highway.

The boundary parts of Chester Pass Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Lancaster Road (both sides), Link Road (both sides), and the boundary streets of Le Grande Avenue (both sides), Salvado Road (both sides) and Marbelup Street (both sides) are included within the optional area.

- (b) From the western end of Roberts Road, east and northeast along Roberts Road to Robinson Road, in a general easterly direction along Robinson Road to Frenchman Bay Road, northeast along Frenchman Bay Road to Lower Denmark Road and west along Lower Denmark Road.

The boundary parts of Frenchman Bay Road (both sides) and Lower Denmark Road (both sides), are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Robinson Road (both sides) and the boundary street of Roberts Road (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

NORTH KALGOORLIE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the southwesterly extension of Collins Street at a point adjacent to Kalgoorlie Sewerage Ponds, northeast from this point to and along Collins Street and its extension to the railway line, northwest along the railway line to Hare Street, northeast along Hare Street to the Eastern By-Pass Road, northnorthwest along the Eastern By-Pass Road to the extension of Killarney Street, southwest to and along Killarney Street and its extension to Kalgoorlie Arboretum, and continuing therefrom in a southwesterly direction.

The boundary parts of Hare Street (both sides) and the Eastern By-Pass Road (west side), are included within the area for North Kalgoorlie Primary School, while the boundary streets of Collins Street (both sides) and Killarney Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for North Kalgoorlie Primary School.

NORTH MANDURAH PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

The Indian Ocean from the western extension of Henson Street, southeast along Henson Street to Anstruther Road, southeast and south along Anstruther Road to Morfitt Street, east along Morfitt Street and its extension to Fremantle Road, north along Fremantle Road to Rafferty Road, east from

this point to Bortolo Drive, north along Bortolo Drive to Gordon Road, east along Gordon Road and Lakes Road to the Serpentine River, north along the Serpentine River to a point due east of the locality boundary between Lakelands and Parklands, due west from this point to the aforementioned locality boundary, continuing due west to the locality boundary between Madora and San Remo, and due west to the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of Fremantle Road (west side) are included within the area for North Mandurah Primary School, while the boundary parts of Anstruther Road (both sides), Bortolo Drive (both sides), Gordon Road (both sides), Lakes Road (both sides) and the boundary streets of Henson Street (both sides) and Morfitt Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for North Mandurah Primary School.

NORTH MORLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is a contributory area to this school:

From the junction of Yirrigan Drive and Broadmoor Avenue, north along Broadmoor Avenue to Ajana Way, north from this point to the common junctions of Benghazi Loop, Sattelberg Ramble and Pomona Lane, continuing north to the western extension of Eora Creek Gardens, in a general northerly direction to Dechaineux Parkway, in a general northerly direction along the eastern arm of Dechaineux Parkway to and across Cherrywood Avenue to Reid Highway, east along Reid Highway to Alexander Drive, south along Alexander Drive to Yirrigan Drive and west along Yirrigan Drive to Broadmoor Avenue.

The boundary parts of Reid Highway (south side), Alexander Drive (west side), Yirrigan Drive (north side), and the boundary street of Broadmoor Avenue (east side), are included within the area for North Morley Primary School, while the boundary parts of Dechaineux Parkway (both sides) are excluded from the area for North Morley Primary School.

NORTH PARMELIA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the intersection of Thomas Road and Johnson Road, south along Johnson Road to Bertram Road, northwest, west and south along Bertram Road to Wellard Road, west along Wellard Road to Parmelia Avenue, north along Parmelia Avenue to Sulphur Road, east along Sulphur Road to Hennessy Avenue, northwest along Hennessy Avenue to Wiggins Road, northeast along Wiggins Road and its extension to Leghorn Road, north from this point to the intersection of McLaughlan Road and Dunrobin Avenue, north along Dunrobin Avenue to Nottingham Parkway, northwest and north along Nottingham Parkway and its extension to Thomas Road and east along Thomas Road to Johnson Road.

The boundary parts of Johnson Road (west side), Bertram Road (north and west sides), Wellard Road (north side), Parmelia Avenue (both sides), Sulphur Road (south side), Dunrobin Avenue (both sides) and Thomas Road (south side) are included within the area for North Parmelia Primary School, while the boundary parts of Hennessy Avenue (both sides) Nottingham Parkway (both sides) and the boundary street of Higgins Road (both sides) are excluded from the area for North Parmelia Primary School.

O'CONNOR PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the junction of Anzac Drive and Great Eastern Highway, northeast along Great Eastern Highway to a point coinciding with the westerly extension of Speculation Road, in a general easterly direction to and along Speculation Road to Maxwell Street, south and southeast along Maxwell Street to Johnston Street, eastnortheast along Johnston Street to Millen Street, southeast and east along Millen Street to Ivanhoe Street, south along Ivanhoe Street and its extension to Anzac Drive and continuing therefrom in a southerly direction.

The boundary parts of Great Eastern Highway (southeast side), Maxwell Street north of Thorn Place (west and southwest sides), Ivanhoe Street (west side) and the boundary street of Speculation Road (south side) are included within the area for O'Connor Primary School, while the boundary parts of Millen Street (both sides) and Johnston Street (both sides), Maxwell Street south of Thorn Place (both sides) are excluded from the area for O'Connor Primary School.

Children in Year 7 in 1996, and living within the area for O'Connor Primary School, shall have the option of completing their primary education at their current (1995) school or of transferring to O'Connor Primary School.

Children attending Government schools in Years 1 to 6 in 1996 (Years 1 to 7 thereafter), and living within the area for O'Connor Primary School, shall attend O'Connor Primary School.

The following is an optional area for O'Connor and South Kalgoorlie Primary Schools:

From the junction of Maxwell Street and Johnston Street, eastnortheast along Johnston Street to Phoenix Place, northnorthwest along Phoenix Place to Boomerang Crescent, westsouthwest along Boomerang Crescent to Maxwell Street and southsoutheast along Maxwell Street to Johnston Street.

The boundary parts of Maxwell Street (both sides), Johnston Street (both sides) and the boundary street of Phoenix Place (both sides) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Boomerang Crescent (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

ORELIA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the junction of Gilmore Avenue and Sulphur Road, east along Sulphur Road to Hennessy Avenue, northwest along Hennessy Avenue to Wiggins Road, northeast along Wiggins Road and its extension to Leghorn Road, north from this point to the intersection of McLaughlan Road and Dunrobin Avenue, north along Dunrobin Avenue to Nottingham Parkway, northwest and north along Nottingham

ham Parkway and its extension to Thomas Road, west along Thomas Road to Gilmore Avenue and south along Gilmore Avenue to Sulphur Road.

The boundary parts of Sulphur Road (north side), Hennessy Avenue (both sides), Nottingham Parkway (both sides), Thomas Road (south side), Gilmore Avenue (east side) and the boundary street of Wiggins Road (both sides) are included within the area for Orelia Primary School, while the boundary parts of Dunrobin Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the area for Orelia Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Orelia and Calista Primary Schools:

From the junction of Gilmore Avenue and Challenger Avenue, east along Challenger Avenue to Parmelia Avenue, north along Parmelia Avenue to Sulphur Road, west along Sulphur Road to Gilmore Avenue and south along Gilmore Avenue to Challenger Avenue.

The boundary parts of Sulphur Road (south side) and Gilmore Avenue (east side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Parmelia Avenue (both sides) and the boundary street of Challenger Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

Both sides of Mandogalup Road between Anketell Road and Norkett Road are optional for Orelia, Hope Valley and Wattleup Primary Schools.

PORT KENNEDY PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this schools is as follows:

From the Indian Ocean at the locality boundary between Warnbro and Port Kennedy, due east along this boundary to the proposed extension of Currie Street, south along Currie Street to Grand Ocean Boulevard, east along Grand Ocean Boulevard to Warnbro Sound Avenue, south along Warnbro Sound Avenue to Port Kennedy Drive and west along the proposed alignment of Port Kennedy Drive and its extension to the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of Currie Street (both sides), Warnbro Sound Avenue (west side) and Port Kennedy Drive (both sides) are included within the area for Port Kennedy Primary School.

Children attending Government schools in Year 7 in 1996, and living within the area for Port Kennedy Primary School, may complete their primary education at their 1995 school or may transfer to Port Kennedy Primary School.

Children in Years 1 to 6 inclusive in 1996 (Years 1 to 7 thereafter), and living within the area for Port Kennedy Primary School, shall attend Port Kennedy Primary School.

The following is an optional are for Port Kennedy and Singleton Primary Schools:

The locality of Secret Harbour as delineated in the 1996 Perth StreetSmart Directory.

(Transport will only be provided for Secret Harbour children who attend Singleton Primary School).

ROCKINGHAM BEACH PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the Indian Ocean at a point west of the extension of Boundary Road, due east from this point to and along Boundary Road and its extension to Lake Richmond, in an eastnortheasterly direction across Lake Richmond to the Rockingham North Branch Drain, east along the Drain to a point due north of the junction of Broughton Way and Townsend Road, south from this point to Townsend Road, northeast and east along Townsend Road to Swinstone Street, east along Swinstone Street to Read Street, northnorthwest along Read Street to Patterson Road and eastnortheast along Patterson Road to Ennis Avenue.

The boundary parts of Read Street (west side) and Patterson Road (north side) are included within the area for Rockingham Beach Primary School while the boundary parts of Townsend Road (both sides), and the boundary streets of Boundary Road (both sides) and Swinstone Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for Rockingham Beach Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Rockingham Beach, Bungaree and Safety Bay Primary Schools:

From the point at which the Rockingham North Branch Drain enters Lake Richmond, east along the Drain to a point due north of the junction of Broughton Way and Townsend Road, south from this point to Townsend Road, southwest along Townsend Road to the western arm of Boon Court, south between Boon Court and Chester Way to the east, and Cato Court and Daley Court to the west, to the southern extremity of Daley Court, southwest from this point to the western extremity of Swifts Court, continuing in a southwesterly direction to the proposed Garden Island Highway, northwest along the alignment of Garden Island Highway to Lake Richmond, and east and north along the edge of Lake Richmond to the Rockingham North Branch Drain.

The boundary parts of Townsend Road (both sides) and the proposed Garden Island Highway (north side) are included within the optional area.

The following is an optional area for Rockingham Beach, Bungaree and Hillman Primary Schools:

The area bounded by Patterson Road (south side), Read Street (east side), Rac Road (north side) and Ennis Avenue (west side).

SAFETY BAY PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary of this school is as follows:

From the Indian Ocean at a point west of the extension of Boundary Road, due east from this point to and along Boundary Road and its extension to Lake Richmond, in an eastnortheasterly direction across Lake Richmond to the Rockingham North Branch Drain, south and west along the edge of Lake Richmond to the proposed Garden Island Highway, southeast along the alignment of Garden Island Highway to Rae Road, east along Rae Road to Waikiki Road, south along Waikiki Road to Malibu Road, and southwest along Malibu Road an its extension to Warnbro Sound.

The boundary parts of Garden Island Highway (south side), Rae Road (south side), Malibu Road (north side), and the boundary street of Boundary Road (both sides) are included within the area for Safety Bay Primary School, while the boundary street of Waikiki Road (both sides) is excluded from the area for Safety Bay Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Safety Bay, Bungaree and Rockingham Beach Primary Schools: From the point at which the Rockingham North Branch Drain enters Lake Richmond, east along the Drain to a point due north of the junction of Broughton Way and Townsend Road, south from this point to Townsend Road, southwest along Townsend Road to the western arm of Boon Court, south between Boon Court and Chester Way to the east, and Cato Court and Daley Court to the west, to the southern extremity of Daley Court, southwest from this point to the western extremity of Swifts Court, continuing in a southwesterly direction to the proposed Garden Island Highway, northwest along the alignment of Garden Island Highway to Lake Richmond, and east and north along the edge of Lake Richmond to the Rockingham North Branch Drain.

The boundary parts of Townsend Road (both sides) and the proposed Garden Island Highway (north side) are included within the optional area.

The following is an optional area for Safety Bay, Bungaree and Cooloongup Primary Schools:

The area bounded by Waikiki Road (both sides), Malibu Road (north side), Read Street (west side) and Rae Road (south side).

SINGLETON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the Indian Ocean at the locality boundary between Secret Harbour and Golden Bay, east along this boundary to Mandurah Road, south along Mandurah Road and Fremantle Road to the locality boundary between Madora and San Remo, and west along this boundary to the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of Mandurah Road (west side) and Fremantle Road (west side) are included within the area for Singleton Primary School.

Children attending Government schools in Year 7 in 1996, and living within the area for Singleton Primary School, may complete their primary education at their 1995 school or may transfer to Singleton Primary School.

Children in Years 1 to 6 inclusive in 1996 (Years 1 to 7 thereafter), and living within the area for Singleton Primary School, shall attend Singleton Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Singleton and Port Kennedy Primary Schools:

The locality of Secret Harbour as delineated in the 1996 Perth StreetSmart Directory. (Transport will only be provided for Secret Harbour children who attend Singleton Primary School.)

SOUTH KALGOORLIE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

The Eastern By-Pass Road at a point coinciding with the easterly extension of Millen Street, west from this point to and along Millen Street to Phoenix Place, northnorthwest along Phoenix Place to Boomerang Crescent, westsouthwest along Boomerang Crescent to Maxwell Street, northwest and north along Maxwell Street to Speculation Road, in a general westerly direction along Speculation Road to Meldrum Avenue, northnortheast along Meldrum Avenue to Charles Street, eastsoutheast along Charles Street to Cheetham Street, northeast along Cheetham Street to Wilson Street, southeast along Wilson Street to Roberts Street, northeast along Roberts Street to the Eastern By-Pass Road, and southeast and south along the Eastern By-Pass Road to the easterly extension of Millen Street.

The boundary parts of Maxwell Street (east and northeast sides) and Wilson Street (southwest side), and the boundary streets of Millen Street (both sides), Speculation Road (north side), Meldrum Avenue (east side), Charles Street (south side), Boomerang Crescent (both sides) and the Eastern by-Pass Road (west side) are included within the area for South Kalgoorlie Primary School, while the boundary parts of Roberts Street (both sides), and the boundary streets of Cheetham Street (both sides) and Phoenix Place (both sides), are excluded from the area for South Kalgoorlie Primary School.

The following is an optional area for South Kalgoorlie and O'Connor Primary Schools:

From the junction of Maxwell Street and Johnston Street, eastnortheast along Johnston Street to Phoenix Place, northnorthwest along Phoenix Place to Boomerang Crescent, westsouthwest along Boomerang Crescent to Maxwell Street and southsoutheast along Maxwell Street to Johnston Street.

The boundary parts of Maxwell Street (both sides), Johnston Street (both sides) and the boundary street of Phoenix Place (both sides) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Boomerang Crescent (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

SOUTHWELL PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is an optional area for Southwell and Koorilla Primary Schools:

From the intersection of Forrest Road and Stock Road, south along Stock Road to Phoenix Road, east along Phoenix Road to North Lake Road, north along North Lake Road to the proposed Roe Highway, westsouthwest along the alignment of the Roe Highway to Forrest Road, and west along Forrest Road to Stock Road.

The boundary parts of Stock Road (east side), Phoenix Road (north side), North Lake Road (west side), the Roe Highway (south side) and Forrest Road (south side) are included within the optional area.

WARNBRO PRIMARY SCHOOL

The boundary for this school is as follows:

From the Indian Ocean at a point coinciding with the westerly extension of Hokin Street, east from this point to Hokin Street, northeast along Hokin Street to Safety Bay Road, east along Safety Bay Road to Warnbro Sound Avenue, south along Warnbro Sound Avenue to Grand Ocean Boulevard, west along Grand Ocean Boulevard to the southern extension of Currie Street, north along the extension of Currie Street to the locality boundary between Warnbro and Port Kennedy, and due west along this boundary to the Indian Ocean.

Restrictions on advertising etc.

33. A podiatrist shall not, in relation to podiatry, use an advertisement, notice, sign, name-plate, business card or printed stationery that —

- (a) is false in a material particular;
- (b) is misleading or deceptive or is likely to mislead or deceive;
- (c) is vulgar, sensational or otherwise likely to adversely affect the reputation or standing of the podiatry profession by reason of its content, form or manner of presentation;
- (d) claims or implies that the podiatrist is superior to another podiatrist or podiatrists;
- (e) claims or implies that equipment or a technique used by the podiatrist is superior to the equipment or technique used by another podiatrist or podiatrists;
- (f) states or implies that the podiatrist offers or may offer a discount on the cost of goods or services provided by the podiatrist; or
- (g) comprises, includes or refers to a testimonial in any form.

Restrictions on publicising practice of podiatry

34. A podiatrist may participate and be identified by name and profession in a talk, public appearance, broadcast or publication in relation to podiatry unless —

- (a) the subject matter is not a matter of public interest;
- (b) where the subject matter concerns a matter in respect of which the podiatrist has been professionally engaged —
 - (i) the podiatrist does not have the client's express consent, or it is contrary to the interests of the client, to so participate;
 - (ii) the podiatrist gives an unobjective account of the matter; or
 - (iii) the podiatrist gives undue publicity or emphasis to the podiatrist's part in the matter;
- (c) the presentation is vulgar, sensational or otherwise likely to adversely affect the reputation or standing of the podiatry profession by reason of the content or form of the presentation or the manner of the podiatrist's participation;
- (d) the podiatrist claims or implies that the podiatrist is superior to another podiatrist or podiatrists;
- (e) the podiatrist claims or implies that equipment or a technique used by the podiatrist is superior to the equipment or technique used by another podiatrist or podiatrists; or
- (f) the podiatrist claims or implies that the podiatrist is representing the Board or is presenting the views of the Board, without having the express authority of the Board to do so.

Special knowledge and skills

35. Nothing in rule 33 (d) or (e) or rule 34 (d) or (e) prevents a podiatrist from informing persons that the podiatrist has an area of special knowledge or a special skill in relation to podiatry if that special knowledge or special skill is entered in the Register in respect of the podiatrist.

Board may direct action as to advertising etc.

36. Where the Board is of the opinion that a podiatrist has not complied with section 40 (5) of the Act or rule 32, 33 or 34, it may by written notice served on the podiatrist, direct that —

- (a) an advertisement, notice, business card or printed stationery be discontinued or altered in terms as directed by the Board;
- (b) a sign or name-plate be removed or altered in terms as directed by the Board; or
- (c) the podiatrist make a retraction in terms and in the manner as directed by the Board.

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Bank of Western Australia Ltd (Provision of Information) Regulations 1995*.

Prescribed information under section 22

2. (1) The information that the Treasurer may request the Bank to give for the purposes of section 22 of the Act is —

- (a) the funding requirements of the Bank for a specified period and the manner in which those requirements are to be met;
- (b) any factors known to the Bank that might materially affect —
 - (i) the ability of the Bank to meet those funding requirements; or
 - (ii) the liquidity of the Bank,
 during the specified period;
- (c) such further information as the Treasurer may request by way of explanation or amplification of information referred to in paragraph (a) or (b);
- (d) the amount of the financial obligations of the Bank guaranteed under section 20 of the Act as at a specified day;
- (e) action taken or to be taken by the Bank during a specified period to reduce the financial obligations referred to in paragraph (d) including those arising from wholesale debt that is undated or has a term of 3 years or more at the day of privatisation; and

- (f) information and reports in respect of prudential matters given to the Reserve Bank of Australia during a specified period under the *Banking Act 1959* of the Commonwealth.

(2) In subregulation (1) —

“**specified day**” means a day specified by the Treasurer in a notice given to the Bank under section 22;

“**specified period**” means a period not exceeding 12 months specified by the Treasurer in such a notice.

Prescribed returns under section 22

- (a) operating results;
- (b) financial position; and
- (c) cash flows,
