3. Local Laws 120(2)(a) and (b) are deleted and replaced as follows—
"A resolution may be revoked or changed at a meeting other than the one at which it was originally passed if—
 - (a) the motion to revoke or change the resolution is supported—
 - (i) in the case where an attempt to revoke or change the resolution has been made within the previous 3 months but had failed, by an absolute majority; or
 - (ii) in any other case, by at least one third of the number of offices (whether vacant or not) of members of the Council or Committee, which support is required to be given in writing at least 4 clear days prior to an Ordinary meeting of the Council or Committee;
 - (b) the member who proposes the revocation or change of the resolution—
 - (i) clearly identifies the resolution to be revoked or changed; and
 - (ii) clearly states the reason for seeking the revocation or change;

- (c) the motion to revoke or change the resolution is carried—
- (i) in the case where the resolution to be revoked or changed was required to be carried by an absolute majority or by a special majority, by that kind of majority; or
 - (ii) in any other case, by an absolute majority.”
4. Local Law 120(2)(c) is renumbered 120(2)(d).
 5. Local Law 120(3)(a) is amended by the addition of—
“and call for the verbal support of one third of the offices (whether vacant or not) of Council or Committee before considering the motion to rescind.”
following “close of the meeting”.
 6. Local Law 120(3)(b) is amended by the addition of—
“subject to the Chief Executive Officer having received the written support of one third of the offices (whether vacant or not) of Council or Committee”
between “list the notice for consideration” and “at the next Ordinary Meeting”.
 7. Local Law 120(4)(a) is amended to read as follows—
“A substantive resolution shall not be implemented by the CEO or another authorised officer of the Council, until 12 noon on the day following the commencement of the meeting at which the substantive resolution was passed.”
 8. Local Law 120(10) is amended to read as follows—
“This Local Law does not apply to a motion to change a resolution unless the effect of the change would be that the resolution would be revoked or would become substantially different.”

 - (i) the location, width and standard of proposed roads within the area and their connection with the road network in the locality;
 - (ii) the physical topographical and environmental characteristics of the area leading to the selection of land considered to be suitable for development and uses appropriate for the area;
 - (iii) natural vegetation in the area and the extent of clearing which may be necessary to implement the plan;
 - (iv) areas that should be retained for buffer and passive recreation purposes;
 - (v) within the western sector of the property, the subject of the endorsed Local Structure Plan, residential development shall generally be in accordance with the R Code policy plan included within the amendment report. The policy plan reflects the recommendations contained within the Structure Plan and may be amended from time to time by Council where this is deemed appropriate to better facilitate the implementation of the Structure Plan.

Upon receipt of the ODP, Council shall thereafter follow the procedures outlined in Clause 6.2 of this Scheme subsequent to which, the Plan shall be forwarded to the Western Australian Planning Commission, together with any modifications made to the plan as a result of submissions, for the Commission's consideration.

- (d) Notwithstanding the requirements of the above mentioned clauses, any Outline Development Plan within Area No. 6 shall include a description of the following:
- (i) The physical, topographical and environmental characteristics of the land including its slope, soil type, vegetation and drainage characteristics and the need to protect such features as creek systems, visually prominent landscapes, vegetation stands, high erosion or areas subject to flooding or inundation.
 - (ii) Proposed lot sizes and the location, width and standard of proposed roads and movement systems within the area and their connection with the road and the public recreation network in the locality.
 - (iii) Any subdivision design to maximise solar access.
 - (iv) An arterial road system and road hierarchy that indicates satisfactorily linkages to residential development areas north to Bussell Highway and Rosa Brook Road.
 - (v) Identification of a local commercial centre for the Outline Development Area.
 - (vi) Natural vegetation within the area and the extent of clearing which may be necessary to implement the Plan. Subdivision and/or development of vegetated areas will be considered by Council in terms the impact on the landscape generally.
 - (vii) The provision of public open space, drainage reserves and management thereof in the interest to protect the natural qualities of the area together with a delineation of areas for active and passive recreation.
 - (viii) Where any lot backs onto a public road or an area of open space, then Council will require the standard of fencing deemed compatible with the objectives of protecting visual and landscape amenity.
 - (ix) The need to ensure that the composition of any urban runoff entering the river system is sufficiently filtered or altered to avoid any adverse environmental impacts for siltation, pollution, nutrient loading or erosion hazard.
 - (x) The expected demographic profile of the population and any specific considerations for local area planning based on age characteristics or specific needs groups.
 - (xi) A full report addressing the geophysical characteristics of the soils and topography within the area, including the need to manage active clays within the site, likely potential for subsoil slippage, any existing underground water flows or seepage lines, recommendations on lot size—based upon soil, vegetation and slope analysis.
 - (xii) Details of drainage and other services necessary to service the subdivision and development and suggested management measures to protect the environmental integrity of the area, particularly in regard to stormwater discharge from the subdivision.
 - (xiii) Suggested provision of public open space and community infrastructure.
5. Renumber existing Clause 3.4.6 to 3.4.7.
6. Insert a new Clause 3.4.8 to read as follows;
- (a) Where Council rejects an Outline Development Plan for an Overall Planning Area, or attaches conditions or requires modification which the applicant considers unreasonable, the applicant shall have a right of appeal pursuant to Part V of the Act.

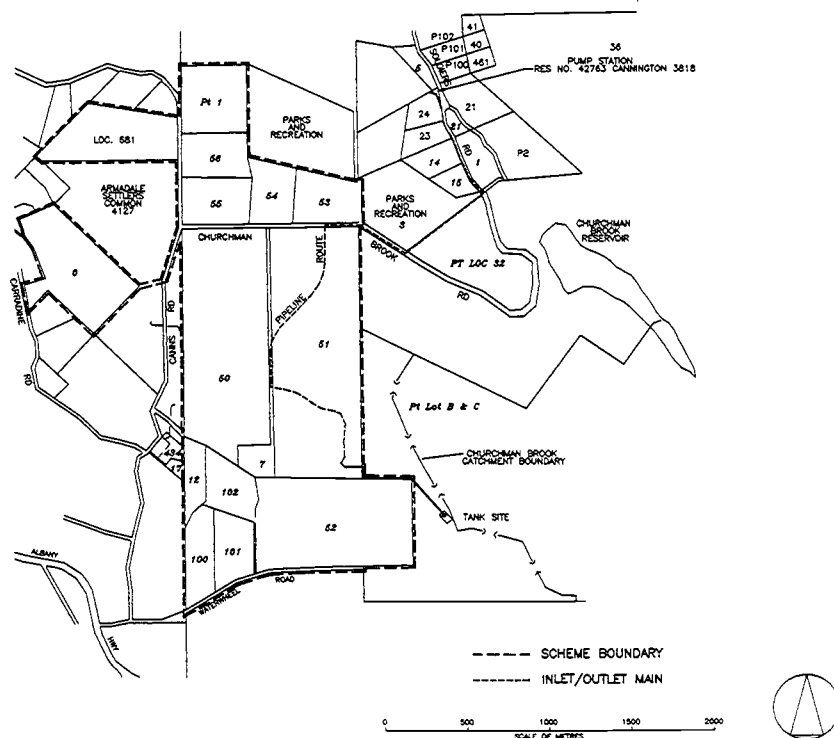
