  - (g) Insert a new definition into clause 1 as follows—
 

"Sandboard" means a thing of any material, ski, board or any other device of whatsoever description used or for use in skiing, sliding or surfing on sand."
2. Insert a new clause 2(n) as follows—
 

'(n) use a sandboard'.

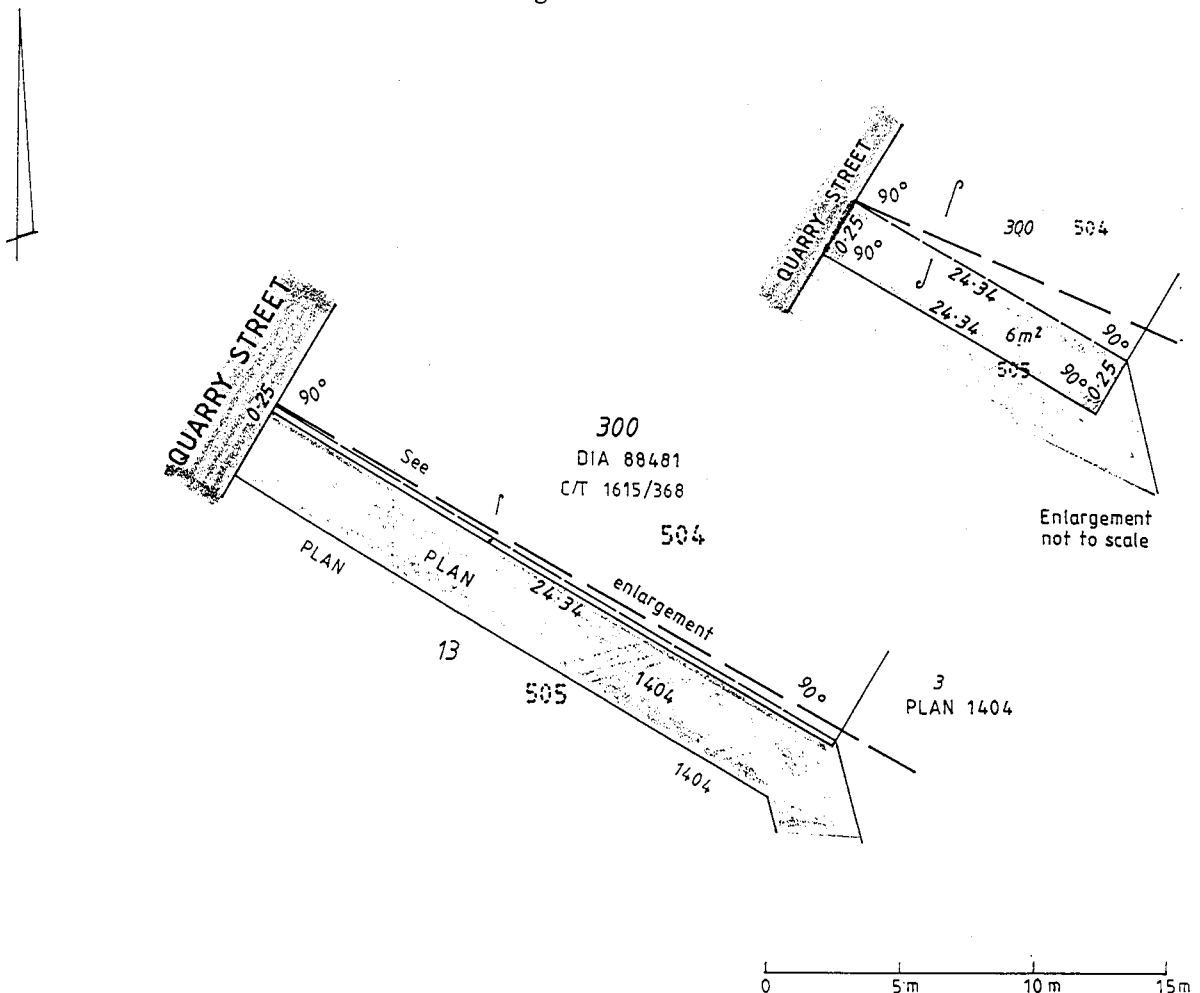
