BUSH FIRES ACT 1954*City of Nedlands*

1997/1998 Fire Break Order

Notice to all owners and occupiers of the land in the City of Nedlands

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, you are hereby required on or before the 30th day of November 1997, or within fourteen days of the date of you becoming owner or occupier of land within the City of Nedlands, should this be after 30th day of November 1997, to clear from the land all inflammable material and thereafter to maintain the land clear of all inflammable material up to and including the 31st day March 1998.

If for any reason it is considered impractical to clear the land of inflammable material as required by this notice, application must be made in writing to the Council or its duly Authorised Officer on or before the 30th day November 1997, for permission to take alternative action to abate a fire hazard. If permission is not granted by the Council or its duly Authorised Officer, you shall comply with the requirements of this notice.

Penalty—
