Fertilizers Act 1977

Fertilizers Amendment Regulations 1998

Made by the deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Fertilizers Amendment Regulations* 1998.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which Part 5 of the *Agricultural Legislation Amendment and Repeal Act* 1998 comes into operation.

3. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Fertilizers Regulations 1978**.

4. Regulation 2 amended

After the definition of "section" in regulation 2, the following definition is inserted —

"test sieve" means a test sieve conforming to Australian Standard 1152 Grade B;

Regulation 7 is repealed and the following regulation is inserted instead —

7. Lime, standards

- (1) Fertilizer shall not be sold as "Agricultural Lime (First Grade)" unless it
 - (a) consists of at least 80% fine material capable of passing through a test sieve with an aperture size not exceeding 0.6 mm; and
 - (b) has a neutralizing value that is at least 75% of the neutralizing value of pure calcium carbonate.
- (2) Fertilizer shall not be sold as "Agricultural Lime (Second Grade)" unless it
 - (a) consists of at least 60% fine material capable of passing through a test sieve with an aperture size not exceeding 0.6 mm; and
 - (b) has a neutralizing value that is at least 50% of the neutralizing value of pure calcium carbonate.
- (3) Fertilizer shall not be sold as "Pelleting Lime" unless it
 - (a) consists of at least 99% fine material that is capable of passing through a test sieve with an aperture size not exceeding 0.053 mm;
 - (b) has a neutralizing value that is at least 90% of the neutralizing value of pure calcium carbonate; and
 - (c) has a ph value of not more than 9.8 using a limestone to water ratio of not less than 1:5.

8. Regulation 9 replaced

Regulation 9 is repealed and the following regulation is inserted instead —

9. Bone dust, bone meal, blood and bone, standards

(1) Fertilizer shall not be sold as "Bone Dust" or "Bone Meal" unless it contains at least 2% nitrogen and at least 5.5% phosphorus.

- (2) Fertilizer shall not be sold as "Blood and Bone" unless it contains at least 4% nitrogen and at least 3% phosphorus.
- (3) Fertilizer shall not be sold as "Bone Dust" or "Bone Meal" or "Blood and Bone" unless
 - (a) the whole bulk of a sample of the fertilizer is capable of passing through a test sieve with an aperture size not exceeding 4.75 mm;
 - (b) at least 55% of the sample is capable of passing through a test sieve with an aperture size not exceeding 0.6 mm; and
 - (c) the materials of which the fertilizer is composed are only of animal origin.

10. Regulation 12 amended

Regulation 12(1) is amended as follows:

- (a) in paragraphs (a) and (b), delete "registered";
- (b) delete paragraph (c) and "and" after it and insert instead

Retail Trading Hours Act 1987

Retail Trading Hours (Christmas) Exemption Order 1998

Made by the Minister for Fair Trading.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Retail Trading Hours (Christmas) Exemption Order 1998.*

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on the day on which it is published in the *Gazette*.

3. Interpretation

In this order —

"motor shop" means a general retail shop or portion of a general retail shop, as the case requires —

- (a) in, on or from which motor vehicles are sold by way of retail sale; or
- (b) in, on or from which spare parts for motor vehicles are sold by way of retail sale in conjunction with the sale of motor vehicles.

4. Application

- (1) Clauses 5, 6 and 7 apply to all general retail shops, other than motor shops, in the metropolitan area, including general retail shops in the Perth area and the Fremantle area as defined in the *Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts) Order 1996*, despite that order.
- (2) This order does not affect the operation of the *Retail Trading Hours Exemption Order (No. 12) 1994*.
- (3) In this clause
 - "motor shop" means a general retail shop or portion of a general retail shop, as the case requires
 - (a) in, on or from which motor vehicles are sold by way of retail sale; or
 - (b) in, on or from which spare parts for motor vehicles are sold by way of retail sale in conjunction with the sale of motor vehicles.

5. Sunday, 20 December 1998

Each general retail shop to which this clause applies is exempted from section 12(1)(d) of the Act on 20 December 1998 provided that the shop is closed on that day until 12.00 noon and from and after 6 p.m..

6. Monday, 21 December 1998 to Wednesday, 23 December 1998

Each general retail shop to which this clause applies is exempted from section 12(1)(a) of the Act on 21 December, 22 December and 23 December 1998 provided that the shop is closed —

- (a) on those days until 8 a.m. and from and after 9 p.m.; and
- (b) on 24 December 1998 until 8 a.m. and from and after 6 p.m..

7. Sunday, 27 December 1998

Each general retail shop to which this clause applies is exempted from section 12(1)(d) of the Act on 27 December 1998 provided that the shop is closed on that day until 12.00 noon and from and after 6 p.m..

8. Monday, 28 December 1998 — motor shops

Each motor shop in the metropolitan area is exempted from section 12(1)(e) of the Act on 28 December 1998 provided that the shop is closed on that day until 8 a.m. and from and after 6 p.m..

- (i) Registered seniors to receive 25% rates rebate and 50% rebate of the amount payable for water consumption up to 150 kl.

(j) A rebate of 1 kl to be allowed for 65 cents of rates paid on non-residential category properties and the excess water to be at the rate of 65 cents per kl.

Note: Above annual rate and supply fee charges to be adjusted to their nine (9) month financial year equivalents.
