LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

**DISTRICTS OF WANNEROO AND JOONDALUP
(CHANGE OF BOUNDARIES) ORDER 1999**

Made by the deputy of the Governor under the provisions of section 2.1 of the *Local Government Act 1995*.

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Districts of Wanneroo and Joondalup (Change of Boundaries) Order 1999.

Commencement

2. This Order shall come into effect on 1 July 1999.

Change of District Boundaries

3. The boundaries of the District of Wanneroo and Joondalup are changed so that the land described in the Schedule ceases to be in the District of Joondalup and is instead in the district of Wanneroo.

Redescription of Boundaries of the Districts of Wanneroo and Joondalup

4. The boundaries of the districts of Wanneroo and Joondalup are designated as described and shown delineated on the Department of Land Administration Statutory Services Plans 20262 and 20263, respectively.

SCHEDULE

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the northwestern corner of Lot 22, as shown on Office of Titles Diagram 54303, a point on a present eastern boundary of the City of Joondalup and extending southerly along the western boundary of that lot to its southwestern corner; thence southeasterly to the northwestern corner of Wanneroo Lot 139 (Reserve 33206); thence southwesterly to the northwestern corner of Wanneroo Estate Lot 7; thence southwesterly and southeasterly along boundaries of that lot and onwards to and along the southwestern boundary of Wanneroo Estate Lot 8 to its southwestern corner; thence southeasterly to the northwestern corner of Wanneroo Estate Lot 11; thence southeasterly along the southwestern boundary of that lot and southeasterly along the southwestern boundaries of Wanneroo Estate Lots 12 and 13 to the northwestern corner of Wanneroo Estate Lot 14; thence southwesterly along the northwestern boundary of that lot and southwesterly along the northwestern boundaries of Wanneroo Estate Lots 15 and 16 and onwards to a southwestern side of Ocean Reef Road; thence southeasterly along that side to the northwestern corner of the western severance of Perthshire Location 110; thence generally southerly along boundaries of that severance to the northeastern boundary of Lot 156, as shown on Office of Titles Plan 18555; thence southeasterly to the northeastern corner of Lot 101, as shown on Office of Titles Plan 21540; thence southeasterly along the northeastern boundary of that lot to the northwestern side of Woodvale Drive; thence northeasterly along that side to the prolongation northwesterly of the centreline of Drain Reserve, as shown on Office of Titles Plan 2832; thence southeasterly to and generally southeasterly along that centreline to a northwestern side of Whitfords Avenue; thence northeasterly along that side to a southwestern side of Wanneroo Road, a point on a present eastern boundary of the City of Joondalup and thence generally northwesterly along boundaries of that city to the starting point.

**Local Government (Financial Management)
Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1999**

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Local Government (Financial Management) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1999*.

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 1999.

3. Regulation 19A amended
