Health Act 1911

Health (Notification of Adverse Event After Immunization) Amendment Regulations 2000

Made by the Administrator in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Health (Notification of Adverse Event After Immunization) Amendment Regulations 2000*.

2. Regulation 2 amended

Regulation 2 of the *Health (Notification of Adverse Event After Immunization) Regulations 1995** is amended as follows:

- (a) in the definition of “adverse event after immunization” —
 - (i) by inserting after “means” —
 - “ an event that ”;
 - (ii) by deleting paragraphs (a) to (d), and “or” after paragraph (c), and inserting instead —
 - “
 - (a) is of a kind listed in Appendix 7 of the National Health and Medical Research Council publication “The Australian Immunisation Handbook 7th Edition”; and
 - (b) occurs following the administration of a vaccine to a person.
 - ”.
- (b) by deleting the definition of “immunization”.

LG301***LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995***CITY OF WANNEROO*

AMENDMENT TO PARKING LOCAL LAW

It is hereby notified that the City of Wanneroo's Parking Local Law adopted on the thirteenth day of October 1998, has been amended as follows—

Repeal Clause 38

Replace with a new Clause 38 as follows—

Clause 38. (1) A person shall not park—

- (a) a commercial vehicle as defined in this local law
- (b) a caravan
- (c) an omibus
- (d) a semi-trailer
- (e) a tow truck
- (f) a tractor; or
- (g) a trailer

on a road or verge between the hours of 6.00 pm one day and 7.00 am the following day and for more than 3 hours consecutively between the hours of 7.00 am and 6.00 pm.

- (2) The provisions of clauses 42(1) and (2) relating to verge parking apply.

LG302***LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995***Shire of Kalamunda*

AMENDMENT TO LOCAL LAWS RELATING TO PARKING FACILITIES

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the above mentioned Act, the Council of the Shire of Kalamunda hereby records having resolved on the 19th June 2000 to make the following amendment to its Local Law regarding Parking Facilities published in the *Government Gazette* on 25th September 1981.

1. By adding to Clause 27 of that Local Law a new paragraph—

- (12) Notwithstanding the provisions of Clause 27 Paragraphs (8), (9) and (10), a commercial vehicle is not permitted to be parked between the edge of the carriageway and the street alignment nearest that edge where the occupier of the land has approval to park that commercial vehicle on that property to which the verge abuts.

PERMIT FOR CONDUCT OF TRADE PROMOTION LOTTERIES

A Trade Promotion Lottery is a lottery conducted to promote the sale of goods or the use of services, in which every participant takes part—

- (a) without cost to him; or

- (b) by reason of the purchase of goods or the use of services, the cost of which is no more than the cost would be without the opportunity to take part in the lottery.

10. Records relating to the lottery shall be maintained for a period of twelve months and shall be made available to an authorised officer of the Gaming Commission upon request.
11. Where practicable, members of the public must be afforded the opportunity to witness the draw. Where not practicable, audit records confirming the prize draw must be made available to an authorised officer of the Gaming Commission upon request.
