Melville District (Representation) Order 2001

Made by the Governor in Executive Council on the recommendation of the Minister for Local Government.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Melville District (Representation) Order 2001*.

2. Number of councillors changed (Act s. 2.18)

As from and including the day of the ordinary elections required to be held in 2003 —

- (a) the number of offices of councillor on the council of the City of Melville is changed to 12 from 18; and
- (b) the number of offices of councillor for each of the 6 wards in the district of Melville is changed to 2 from 3.

3. Transitional directions (Act s. 9.62)

- (1) The directions in this clause are made in order to give effect to clause 2.

- (2) In respect of each of the 4 wards in the Table to this clause, the second councillor declared elected by the returning officer in the ordinary elections held in 2001 to represent the ward has a term that begins on the day after the day of those ordinary elections and ends on the day of the ordinary elections in 2003.
- (3) Of the 12 offices of councillor (2 for each of the 6 wards) that become vacant on the day of the ordinary elections held in 2003 due to the retirement of councillors (including the 4 mentioned in subclause (2)), 6 (one for each ward) cease to exist on so becoming vacant.
- (4) Any poll needed for an election to elect councillors to the other 6 of the 12 offices referred to in subclause (3) is to be held on the day of the ordinary elections in 2003.
- (5) The remaining 6 offices of councillor (one for each ward) continue in existence on and after the day of the ordinary elections held in 2003.
- (6) For the purpose of subclause (2), if both of the councillors that are declared to be elected are declared to be elected unopposed, the returning officer is to draw lots to determine to which one of the 2 subclause (2) applies.
- (7) Part 4 of the Act, with any necessary changes, applies to preparing for and conducting the ordinary elections in 2003 as if the changes effected by clause 2 had taken effect on the day this order commenced.

On the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order, the Indoon, Cooragabba, Yarra, Prauaka and Billeroo Wards in the district of Carnamah are abolished.

3. Change of ward boundaries (s. 2.2(1) of the Act)

(1) On and after the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order, the Indoon and Yarra Wards in the district of Carnamah consist of the land described in Schedule 1.

(2) On and after the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order, the Carnamah and Eneabba Wards in the district of Carnamah consist of the land described in Schedule 2.

4. Number of councillors changed (s. 2.18(3) of the Act)

On and after the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order—

- (a) the number of offices of councillor on the council of the Shire of Carnamah is 7 instead of 8; and
- (b) the number of offices of councillor for the Carnamah, Eneabba and Yarra Wards shall be 2 each, and for the Indoon Ward shall be 1.

5. Declaration of vacant offices (s. 2.35 and 9.62 of the Act)

The offices of member of the council of the Shire of Carnamah for the Indoon, Cooragabba, Yarra, Prauaka and Billeroo Wards become vacant immediately before the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order.

6. Election to fill vacancies (s. 4.11 and 9.62 of the Act)

- (1) An election is to be held to fill the vacant offices.
- (2) Any poll needed for an election to fill the offices is to be held on the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order.
- (3) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting the election as if the changes effected by clauses 2, 3, 4 and 5 had taken effect on the day on which this order commenced.
- (4) For the purposes of subclause (3)—
 - (a) Part 4 of the Act is modified to the extent necessary to give effect to subclauses (1), (2) and (3); and
 - (b) without limiting paragraph (a), a reference in Part 4 of the Act to a ward, in relation to the district of Carnamah, is to be read as a reference to the Carnamah Ward, Eneabba Ward, Indoon Ward and Yarra Ward of the district as the respective ward is or will be as a result of the operation of clauses 3, 4 and 5, on and after the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order.
