Road Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2001

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2001*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 5 February 2001.

 - (a) record at least 25 hours of driving under subregulation (2); and
 - (b) after recording that driving, and being at least 17 years of age, satisfy the Director General, by a test approved by the Director General, that the applicant has an ability to recognise hazards on roads.
- (2) Driving is to be recorded under this subregulation in a logbook in a form approved by the Director General and can only be recorded if —
 - (a) before the driving was performed the applicant had satisfied the Director General that the applicant had an ability to control the class of motor vehicle and had reached the age of 16 years and 6 months; and
 - (b) the driving was supervised by the holder of a licence issued under the *Motor Vehicle Drivers Instructors Act 1963* or a person prescribed in regulation 12C.
- (3) This regulation does not apply to an applicant who had reached the age of 16 years on 4 February 2001.

- (1) A person is prescribed under section 48C(1)(b) of the Act if —

 - (i) in the case of a moped, for at least 2 years; or
 - (ii) in any other case, for at least 4 years.
- (2) If the learner's permit is issued to someone who has an incapacity of the kind referred to in section 44(1)(a) of the Act, subregulation (1)(b) does not apply to a person unless the person is approved by the Director General.

All development in such precincts is to be in accordance with the adopted guidelines in addition to any other requirements of the Scheme, and where there is any inconsistency between the design guidelines and the Scheme, the Scheme shall prevail.
	4. No subdivision or development of incompatible use will be supported within the generic buffer area associated with the piggery on Pt Lot 15 Lyon Road until the use of the land ceases or the buffer area is scientifically determined and approved by the Department of Environmental Protection. Buffer areas are to be shown on the Structure Plan.
	5. Development of Shops (retail uses) within the Development Area shall be a maximum of 2700m ² NLA for the Village Centre and 200m ² NLA for the Local Centre.
	6. The Structure Plan for Pt 212 is to include a strong pedestrian connection between the proposed Success Railway Station and the Village Centre, in addition to Gibbs Road.
	7. The Structure Plan shall retain the existing remnant vegetation in the Reserve of Beenyup Road unless the local government agrees in particular circumstances that some of the vegetation may be removed.
