### **Potato Marketing Corporation of Western Australia (Crown agency) Authorisation (No. 2) 2001**

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

This authorisation may be cited as the *Potato Marketing Corporation of Western Australia (Crown agency) Authorisation (No. 2) 2001*.

**2. Corporation to act on behalf of Crown in certain matters**

The Potato Marketing Corporation of Western Australia is authorised to act on behalf of the Crown in relation to the performance of functions under the provisions of the *Marketing of Potatoes Act 1946* that are listed in the Table to this clause but only to the extent that the performance of those functions does not constitute carrying on business.

## Fertilizers Act 1977

**Fertilizers Amendment Regulations 2001**

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations may be cited as the *Fertilizers Amendment Regulations 2001*.

**2. The regulations amended**

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Fertilizers Regulations 1978*\*.

[\* Reprinted as at 30 July 1999.]

**3. Regulation 2 amended**

Regulation 2 is amended as follows:

- (a) in paragraph (a) of the definition of “prescribed fertilizer”, by deleting “0.008%” and inserting instead —  
“ 0.001% ”;
- (b) in the definition of “prescribed phosphatic fertilizer” —
  - (i) by deleting “phosphorus” in the first place where it occurs and inserting instead —  
“ at least 2% phosphorus by weight ”; and
  - (ii) in paragraph (a), by deleting “0.05%” and inserting instead —  
“ 0.03% ”;
- (c) after the definition of “prescribed phosphatic fertilizer” by inserting the following definition —

“

“**prescribed trace element fertilizer**” has the meaning given in regulation 2A;

”.

**4. Regulation 2A inserted**

After regulation 2 the following regulation is inserted —

“

**2A. Meaning of “prescribed trace element fertilizer”**

A “**prescribed trace element fertilizer**” is a fertilizer that —

- (a) contains more than 0.005% of cadmium or cadmium compounds by weight;
- (b) contains (in accordance with the table to regulation 3A) one or more of the specified ingredients iron, manganese, copper, zinc, boron, molybdenum, and cobalt; and
- (c) if it contains any of the specified ingredients nitrogen, phosphorus, potassium, calcium, magnesium or sulphur — contains less than the minimum amount of that ingredient specified in the table to regulation 3A.

”.

**5. Regulation 3A amended**

Regulation 3A is amended as follows:

- (a) before “Where” by inserting the subregulation designation “(1)”;
- (b) by deleting “Where” and inserting instead —  
“ Subject to subregulation (2), where ”;
- (c) at the end of the regulation by inserting the following subregulation —

“

- (2) Subregulation (1) does not apply to a prescribed trace element fertilizer in respect of the specified ingredients nitrogen, phosphorus, potassium, magnesium or sulphur.

”.

**6. Regulation 21 amended**

Regulation 21 is amended by deleting “or prescribed phosphatic fertilizer” and inserting instead —

“

, prescribed phosphatic fertilizer or prescribed trace element fertilizer

”.

**7. Miscellaneous amendments relating to “registered”**

(1) Regulation 15 is amended as follows:

- (a) by deleting “registered” in the first place where it occurs;
- (b) by deleting “if the substance is not registered as a fertilizer,”.

- (2) Regulation 16(1) is amended in the table, in the headings to column 2 and column 3, by deleting “registered”.
- (3) Regulation 16(2) is amended by deleting “registered” in both places where it occurs.
- (4) The Second Schedule Form 6 is amended by deleting “Registered concentration” and inserting instead —  
“ Concentration ”.

### SCHEDULE

#### AMENDING STATUTE No.1 OF 2001

#### 1. AMENDMENTS TO STATUTE No. 18—CONDITIONS OF AWARING HACKETT BURSARIES AND HACKETT STUDENTSHIPS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

The title of the Statute is changed to "HACKETT STUDENT FUND" and Clauses 1., 2., and 3. of the Statute are deleted and replaced by the following—

1. Sir John Winthrop Hackett, the first Chancellor and a generous benefactor of the University, having bequeathed to the University a sum of money to support students, and his Will having been interpreted and varied by Order of the Supreme Court on 20th December 1999 to provide that—

- (a) the income of part of the sum referred to as the Hackett Student Fund be used 'to provide financial assistance to deserving enrolled students of limited means by way of scholarships, bursaries, studentships, grants, loans or other financial assistance on such terms and conditions as the Senate may from time to time determine to enable such students to attend and commence, continue or complete their studies at The University of Western Australia or at any other university in Australia or elsewhere'; and

- (b) the income of the remainder of the sum be used 'for bursaries and research studentships for enrolled students of the University or graduates of the University of not more than three years' standing of limited means',

the Senate shall from time to time determine the most strategic application of the funds consistent with the provisions of the Order and shall approve regulations governing such application, provided that the regulations shall require that in any year a proportion of the income available shall be allocated to students who are Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia.

2. For the purposes of the regulations governing the use of the bequest funds, those funds shall collectively be known as the Hackett Student Fund.
3. The amount, period, and other terms and conditions applying to a loan, bursary, scholarship or other award made from the Hackett Student Fund shall be set out in the regulations approved by the Senate.

#### 2. AMENDMENTS TO STATUTE No. 22—GLEDDEN TRUST

The introduction and clauses 1 to 39 inclusive of the Statute are deleted and replaced by the following—

The late Robert John Gledden having bequeathed the residue of his estate to the University in trust so that the income would be used 'for the promotion and

encouragement of education at such University to provide for two or more scholarships in applied science, more particularly relating to surveying, engineering or mining or cognate subjects upon such terms and conditions as the University shall from time to time by Statute direct provided that such scholarships shall be known as the "Robert Gledden" and the "Maude Gledden" scholarships', and having expressed the hope that 'one at least of such scholarships will be a travelling scholarship', the Senate has determined for the time-being to use the income as follows—

1. (1) The income of the Gledden Trust shall be used to provide for—
  - (a) Robert and Maude Gledden Visiting Senior Fellowships;
  - (b) Robert and Maude Gledden Undergraduate Studentships;
  - (c) Robert and Maude Gledden Postgraduate Scholarships.
- (2) Awards in each category shall be made by the Scholarships Committee on the terms and conditions set out in the regulations approved by the Senate on the recommendation of the Scholarships Committee through the Academic Board.

3. inform the proponent, any person who referred the proposal and any relevant decision making authority that a proposal referred under section 38 of the Environmental Protection Act 1986 will be assessed under Part IV of the Act, as required under section 40(1)(b).
4. make available for public review under section 40(4)(b), a report made under section 40(2)(b), having determined when that report is of a standard suitable for release or remit the report to the Chairman if that standard has not been met.
5. inform the responsible authority that a scheme will not be assessed under section 48A(1)(a), give advice and make recommendations to the responsible authority.
6. inform the responsible authority that a scheme will be assessed under section 48A(1)(b).
7. make public an environmental review made under section 48C(1)(a), having determined that the review document is of a standard suitable for release or remit the review to the Chairman if that standard has not been met.

This delegation applies to the holder for the time being of the office of Director, Environmental Impact Assessment.

Pursuant to section 59(1)(e) of the Interpretation Act 1984, delegation No. 14 dated 29 August 1999 is hereby revoked.

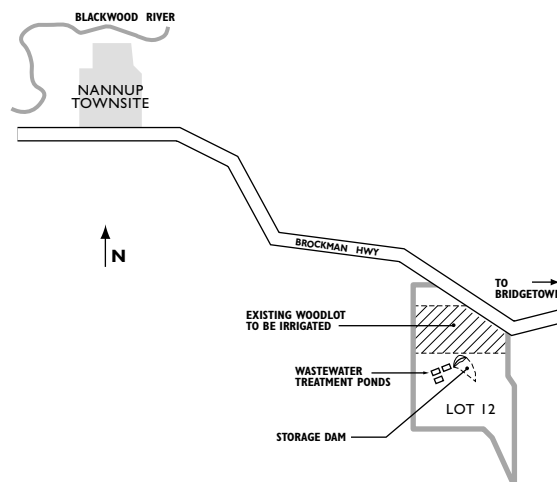
