LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES ON LAND LOCAL LAW 2001

The City of Perth has resolved to make a local law relating to Activities on Land. The purpose and effect of the law is to prevent the creation of nuisances on land.

The local law provides the rules and guidelines for activities on private and public land to prevent nuisances from sand, water, fences, vegetation and rubbish. The effect of a new law will be to ensure—

- Owners and Occupiers manage their land with the interest of the community foremost, particularly with regard to safety and efficiency and the prevention of nuisances;
- Where a nuisance is found to exist and the City has served a Notice, action can be taken to resolve the nuisance, and infringement notices issued;
- the provisions of the National Competition Policy are complied with by the City;
- prescribes measures to be taken in relation to land under the Local Government Act 1995.

The new Activities On Land Local Law will enhance the administration of current local laws and will complement the Local Government Act 1995.

A copy of the law may be inspected at or obtained from the City of Perth's Customer Service Centre located on the ground floor of Council House, 27 St George's Terrace, Perth between the hours of 8.30am and 5.00pm, Monday to Friday.

The New Activities On Land Local Law will come into operation on 23 February 2002.
