Purpose of The Planning Control Area

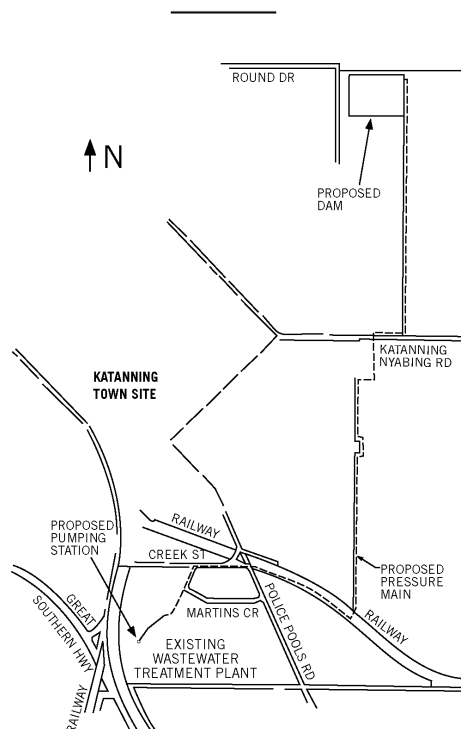
