LOCAL LAW 1998

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Local Government Act 1995 and all of the powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Belmont hereby records having resolved on 22nd day of June 2004 to modify the *City of Belmont (Standing Orders) Local Law 1998* originally appearing in the *Government Gazette* on 8 of December 1998, amended by amendment Local Law as published in the *Government Gazette* on 18 September 2001. The amendment is as follows—

Arrangement (Table of Contents)

Arrangement be amended to reflect all changes within the body of the Local Law in a logical sequential manner.

The definition for “standing committee” be deleted and the following text be inserted: “means the Community and Executive Services Committee, the Planning & Development Committee, the Resources & Policy Committee, the Works & Technical Services Committee and the Executive Committee.”.
