PETROLEUM (SUBMERGED LANDS) ACT 1967

Prohibition of Entry into a Safety Zone

I, William Lee Tinapple, the Director Petroleum and Royalties Division of the Department of Industry and Resources of the said State by instrument of delegation dated 26 March 2004, and pursuant to section 119 of the above Act, hereby prohibit all vessels other than vessels under control of the registered holders of Exploration Permits WA-286-P, WA-325-P and WA-327-P from entering or remaining in the area of the safety zone without the consent in writing of the Director, Petroleum and Royalties Division.

This safety zone extends to a distance of five hundred metres, measured from—

The centre of Cliff Head 5 well (latitude 29° 28' 11.3" South, longitude 114° 52' 41.7" East.*);

The centre of Cliff Head 6 well (latitude 29° 27' 0.58" South, longitude 114° 52' 11.86" East.*);

The centre of Hadda 1 well (latitude 28° 07' 11.4" South, longitude 113° 26' 26.9" East.*);

The centre of Flying Foam 1 well (latitude 27° 52' 18.7" South, longitude 113° 21' 18.0" East.*);

The centre of Blue Jacket 1 well (latitude 28° 36' 14.38" South, longitude 114° 16' 12.62" East.*);

and which on occasion may be reduced to a buoyed area of three hundred metres from the above points. Such reduction is at the discretion of the titleholder and is designed to lessen disruption to commercial fishing interests.

* note: the above are GDA94 coordinates

The Safety Zone remains in force for the duration that the jackup rig is fixed to the sea floor at that location.

Where an unauthorised vessel enters or remains in the safety zone specified in contravention of this instrument, the owner and the person in command or in charge of the vessel are each guilty of an offence against section 119 of the Act and are punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$100,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years, or both, pursuant to section 119(3) of the Act.
