EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO REGULATION 2.13

I, Nina Lyhne, WorkSafe Western Australia Commissioner, hereby grant the following exemptions to BJ Process and Pipeline Services (Australia) Pty Ltd. - 1. Before the pressure vessels are filled, ensure that the supplier of the liquid nitrogen, BOC Australia, as a competent person/organisation, inspects, tests and certifies the fifteen pressure vessels as safe for use.
- 2. Ensure that the fifteen pressure vessels are operated, inspected and maintained in accordance with regulation 4.43(1) of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996.

The exemptions expire on 30 July 2007.
