Jetties Act 1926

Jetties Amendment Regulations 2007

Made by the Lieutenant-Governor and deputy of the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the Jetties Amendment Regulations 2007.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows:

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of these regulations on the later of
 - (i) the day after that day; or
 - (ii) 1 July 2007.

3. The regulations amended

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Jetties Regulations* 1940*.

4. **Regulation 3 amended**

After regulation 3(2) the following subregulation is inserted —

- (3) For the purposes of calculating fees, charges or dues prescribed in a schedule
 - (a) an amount payable per day is payable for any part of a day;
 - (b) the length of a vessel is its overall length or, if it has a valid certificate of survey under the Western Australian Marine Act 1982, its measured length, measured to 2 decimal places.

5. **Regulation 11B amended**

Regulation 11B(2) is repealed and the following subregulation is inserted instead —
