I, the Governor, acting under the *Poisons Act 1964* section 22, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Poisons Advisory Committee constituted under Part II of the Act, vary the proclamation made under that section and published in the *Government Gazette* of 27 May 1988* in the following manner —

(a) at the end of paragraph (c) by deleting the full stop and inserting instead —

“

; and

(d) prohibit the sale or supply of the substance referred to in item 4 of the Schedule, except —

(i) with the consent in writing of the CEO, which consent shall not be given other than to the sale, supply or use of the substance for the purposes of medical or scientific research, including clinical trials, in such stated quantity as is required for that purpose; or

(ii) if special access to the substance has been authorised in accordance with the requirements of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* (Cth) sections 18 and 31A, and the *Therapeutic Goods Regulations 1990* (Cth) regulation 12A, and

permission for the importation of the substance (subject to special access authorisation) has been granted under the *Customs (Prohibited Imports) Regulations 1956* (Clth) regulation 5H and Schedule 8 item 12AA.

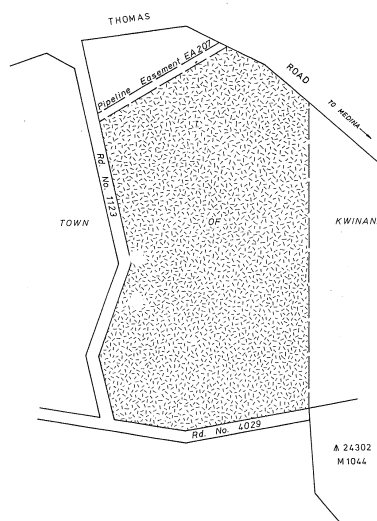
**CONTROL OF VEHICLES (OFF-ROAD AREAS) ACT 1978
