**EXOTIC DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1993**

**IMPORT RESTRICTION ORDER NO. 02/2008**

Made by the Minister for Agriculture and Food under section 24 of the *Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1993*.

This Order revokes and replaces Import Restriction Order No. 01/2008.

Unless amended or replaced by a further Order, this Order applies for 30 days from the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.

Equine Influenza has been confirmed in the States of New South Wales and Queensland.

Except as may be varied from time to time by the Chief Veterinary Officer by means of publication by the Department of Agriculture and Food Western Australia (DAFWA), the restrictions set out in the table below apply to movement to Western Australia from other parts of the Commonwealth of Australia.

<b>Item restricted</b>	<b>Place of origin</b>	<b>Restriction</b>
Horses, donkeys and mules	All states and territories	Prohibited except if moved in accordance with conditions published by DAFWA from time to time.
Equine products	All states and territories.	Prohibited except if moved in accordance with conditions published by DAFWA from time to time.
Equine reproductive material (including fresh, chilled and frozen semen)	All states and territories	Prohibited except if moved in accordance with conditions published by DAFWA from time to time.
Used horse equipment meaning tack, bridles brushes buckets and other equipment or articles that have come in contact with equines	All states and territories	Prohibited except if moved in accordance with conditions published by DAFWA from time to time.
