Conservation and Land Management Act 1984

### Conservation and Land Management (Removal of Water in Forest Management Plan Land) Notice 2007

Made under sections 97A and 101 of the Act by the Minister after consultation with the Conservation Commission and on the recommendation of the CEO.

**1. Citation**

This notice is the *Conservation and Land Management (Removal of Water in Forest Management Plan Land) Notice 2007*.

**2. Commencement**

This notice comes into operation as follows:

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 — on the day on which this notice is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the notice — on the day after that day.

**3. Meaning of “forest management plan land”**

In this notice —

“**forest management plan land**” means land covered by the Forest Management Plan 2004-2013 notified in the *Gazette* of 19 December 2003, other than land classified under Division 2 of Part V as a wilderness area.

#### **4. Permit required to remove water in forest management plan land**

A permit is required —

- (a) to pump or siphon water in or on forest management plan land; or
- (b) to stop, impede or divert the flow of water in or on forest management plan land; or
- (c) to dig a well in forest management plan land; or
- (d) to otherwise —
  - (i) take water from forest management plan land; or
  - (ii) store water in or on forest management plan land, whether or not that water was taken from forest management plan land,

except for occasional personal use in or on forest management plan land.

### **Building Amendment Regulations 2008**
