Retail Trading Hours Act 1987

### Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts) Order 2008

**1. Citation**

This order is the *Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts) Order 2008*.

**2. Commencement**

This order comes into operation as follows:

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 — on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order — on the day after that day.

**3. Retail trading hours — Fremantle tourism precinct**

General retail shops in the Fremantle tourism precinct are required to be closed —

- (a) on those days during the hours specified opposite and corresponding to those days in column 2 of the Table; and
- (b) on any day that is appointed or declared a public holiday for that precinct or throughout the State by or under the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972*.

### SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975 DETERMINATION VARIATION OF THE SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES TRIBUNAL PURSUANT TO SECTION 5A OF THE *SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975* (Remuneration of the Governor)

Section 5A (3) of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975* states that, "The Tribunal may, in complying with a request made under subsection (1), in its determination specify a method of altering from time to time the remuneration payable to the Governor during the subsistence of the appointment referred to in that subsection."

The Tribunal determined a method of altering from time to time the remuneration payable to the Governor in its determination of 24th of May 2005.

This variation to that determination clarifies that the adjustment to the remuneration payable to the Governor will be from the same date as recommended by the Tribunal for the judiciary, rather than at the time when the adjustment actually occurs in judicial salaries, if for some reason the payment of the adjustment were to be delayed.

#### Determination Variation

The determination of the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal made on 24th of May 2005 under section 5(A) of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a further determination, set out below.

Replace the sentence commencing, "This rate shall be adjusted ...", with—

This rate shall be adjusted at the same percentage and from the same date as recommended in the Tribunal's report on judicial salaries made pursuant to Section 7 of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*.
