**Northam District (Change of Ward Boundaries)  
Order 2008**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

This order is the *Northam District (Change of Ward Boundaries) Order 2008*.

**2. Change of ward boundaries (s. 2.2(1)(c) of the Act)**

- (1) The boundaries of the West Ward of Northam District are changed by excluding from the area of the Ward the portion of land described in the Schedule.
- (2) The boundaries of the Central Ward of Northam District are changed by including in the area of the Ward the portion of land described in the Schedule.

## **Schedule 1—Portion of land to be excluded from the West Ward and included in the Central Ward**

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the intersection the centreline of Berry Brow Road with the prolongation easterly of the easternmost southern boundary of Lot 10, as shown on Diagram 45207, a point on a present southwestern boundary of the Central Ward, and extending westerly, northerly and again westerly along southern and western boundaries of that lot to the easternmost southeastern corner of Lot 50, as shown on Diagram 67695; thence westerly and southerly along southern and eastern boundaries of that lot to the easternmost northeastern corner of Lot 100, as shown on Deposited Plan 300107; thence southerly, generally southwesterly and westerly along boundaries of that lot and onwards to the centreline of Cook Road; thence northerly, northwesterly and generally westerly along that centreline and onwards to the centreline of Oyston Road; thence northerly along that centreline and onwards to the centreline of Great Eastern Highway; thence generally northeasterly along that centreline to the prolongation southerly of the eastern boundary of Lot 100, as shown on Diagram 86031; thence northerly to and along the eastern boundary of that lot and northerly along the eastern boundary of Lot 28493 (Reserve 36916), as shown on Deposited Plan 181227, to the easternmost southeastern corner of Lot 29046 (Reserve 14275), as shown on Deposited Plan 190152; thence northerly along the easternmost eastern boundary of that lot to a southeastern boundary of Lot 16150, as shown on Deposited Plan 217818; thence generally northeasterly and northerly along southeastern and eastern boundaries of that lot to a southeastern corner of Lot 27520 (Reserve 23746); thence northerly, southwesterly, northwesterly, easterly and again northerly along boundaries of that lot to the easternmost southeastern corner of Lot 29702 (Reserve 14275), as shown on Deposited Plan 38695; thence northerly, westerly and again northerly along eastern and northern boundaries of that lot to its northernmost northeastern corner, a point on a present southeastern boundary of the Central Ward and thence northeasterly, southerly, generally southwesterly, generally southerly, generally easterly, again generally southerly, again generally easterly, again generally southerly, again generally southwesterly, generally southeasterly, again northeasterly, again generally southeasterly, generally northeasterly, again generally southerly and again generally southeasterly along that boundary to the starting point.
