- (2) For the purpose of assessing under regulation 9(3) if noise emitted from the Pemberton Sawmill when received at a reference location is to be taken to be free of the characteristics referred to in regulation 7(1)(b), the adjustment in regulation 9(3) Table 2 column 1 where tonality is present is varied to 0 dB.

4. Duration of approval

- (1) This approval has effect for 10 years from the start date or a longer period that applies under subclause (2).
- (2) If Auswest Timbers applies for a further approval under regulation 17 in relation to the Pemberton Sawmill within the first 9 years in which this approval has effect this approval continues to operate until the Minister grants, or refuses to grant, the further approval.

5. Condition of approval

It is a condition of the grant of the approval that the provisions in clauses 6 to 9 are complied with.

6. Noise management plan

- (1) Auswest Timbers must submit to the Director within 3 months of the start day a noise management plan.
- (2) The noise management plan must include details of the following —
- (a) a noise monitoring programme to monitor noise received at each reference location;

- (b) a programme to monitor the extent to which each item of equipment at the Pemberton Sawmill contributes to the level of noise emissions;
 - (c) a programme for provision of information to the community about noise emissions from the Pemberton Sawmill;
 - (d) procedures to be adopted by Auswest Timbers in responding to complaints about noise emissions from the Pemberton Sawmill;
 - (e) procedures to be adopted by Auswest Timbers to minimise noise emissions from the Pemberton Sawmill;
 - (f) procedures to be adopted by Auswest Timbers to minimise tonality in noise emissions from the Pemberton Sawmill;
 - (g) any other matter that the Director may require.
- (3) At any time after receiving a noise management plan from Auswest Timbers the Director may, by notice in writing, request Auswest Timbers to provide a revised noise management plan that addresses any matters specified in the notice.
- (4) A revised noise management plan requested under subclause (3) must be provided within 14 days of the request or by such other time as the Director specifies in the written notice.

7. Monitoring noise

- (1) Auswest Timbers must record levels of noise received at each reference location in accordance with the noise monitoring programme for that location referred to in clause 6(2)(a).
- (2) Auswest Timbers must monitor and record the extent to which each item of equipment at the Pemberton Sawmill contributes to noise emissions in accordance with the programme referred to in clause 6(2)(b).
- (3) Auswest Timbers must keep the records for at least 2 years.

8. Minimisation of noise impact

- (1) Auswest Timbers must adopt the procedures identified in the noise management plan referred to in clause 6(2)(e) and (f).
- (2) Auswest Timbers must make reasonable efforts to identify and adopt further opportunities to reduce the noise emitted from the Pemberton Sawmill.
- (3) Auswest Timbers must make reasonable efforts —
 - (a) to identify noise sources at the Pemberton Sawmill that exhibit tonality; and
 - (b) to identify and adopt further opportunities to reduce tonality present in noise emissions.

9. Annual reports

- (1) Auswest Timbers must prepare a written report for the following periods —
 - (a) for the period beginning on the start day and ending on 31 December 2011;
 - (b) for each calendar year after that period.
- (2) The report for a period must contain the following —
 - (a) a summary of the levels of noise recorded under clause 7(1) during the period;
 - (b) particulars of each complaint, if any, received by Auswest Timbers in respect of noise emissions from the Pemberton Sawmill and the action taken by Auswest Timbers in response to the complaint;
 - (c) particulars of each noise reduction measure implemented by Auswest Timbers during the period to reduce the noise emitted from the Pemberton Sawmill;
 - (d) particulars of each measure implemented by Auswest Timbers during the period to reduce tonality in the noise emitted from the Pemberton Sawmill.
- (3) Auswest Timbers must give the report referred to in subclause (1) to the Director by 31 January of the year following the period to which the report relates or by such other time as the Director approves in writing.
- (4) On the request of the Director, Auswest Timbers must give the Director any assistance or information necessary to enable the report to be understood by members of the public.
