I, the Governor, acting under the *Marine and Harbours Act 1981* section 9 and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council—

- (a) cancel the proclamation made under that Act and published in the *Gazette* on 13 March 2009 at p. 759; and
- (b) withdraw Lot 400 on Deposited Plan 72906, being a plan held by the Western Australian Land Information Authority established by the *Land Information Authority Act 2006*, from The Minister for Transport constituted under the *Marine and Harbours Act 1981* section 8(1) and re-vest it in the Crown; and
- (c) vest in The Minister for Transport the land and water comprising the lots listed in Schedule 1,

with effect on and from the day after the day on which the proclamation is published in the *Gazette*.

Shipping and Pilotage Act 1967

Shipping and Pilotage (Ports and Harbours) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2011

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Shipping and Pilotage (Ports and Harbours) Amendment Regulations (No. 4) 2011*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Shipping and Pilotage (Ports and Harbours) Regulations 1966*.

4. Schedule 1A amended

- (1) In Schedule 1A Division 1 delete the item relating to the Port of Onslow and insert:

Port of Onslow	The area of water and land described on Plan 1396 - 01 - 07 - D held by the Department, a copy of which is included for information purposes in Division 2.
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Port Authorities Act 1999

Port Authorities (Description of Port of Dampier) Order 2011

Made by the Governor in Executive Council under section 24(1) of the Act.

1. Citation

This order is the *Port Authorities (Description of Port of Dampier) Order 2011*.

2. Commencement

This order come into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 — on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order — on the day after that day.

3. Port of Dampier

- (1) In subclause (2) —

Deposited Plan 48590 means Deposited Plan 48590 held by the Western Australian Land Information Authority under the *Land Information Authority Act 2006*.

- (2) The Port of Dampier consists of —

- (a) the seabed in the shaded area shown on Deposited Plan 48590 Sheet 1; and

Port Authorities (Description of Port of Dampier) Order 2011**cl. 4**

- (b) the waters in the shaded area shown on Deposited Plan 48590 Sheet 2; and
- (c) the land in the shaded area shown on Deposited Plan 48590 Sheet 3; and
- (d) the area, called the Ashburton Port Area, described in words and shown hatched on Plan 1396 - 03 - 07 held by the department principally assisting the Minister in the administration of the *Port Authorities Act 1999*.

4. Order revoked

The *Port Authorities (Description of Port of Dampier) Port Area Order 2007* is revoked.
