PEST PLANT LOCAL LAW 2012

Under the powers conferred by the Agriculture and Related Resources Protection Act 1976 and the Local Government Act 1995 and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Joondalup resolved on 20 November 2012 to make the following local law.

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

1.1 Title

This local law may be referred to as the City of Joondalup Pest Plant Local Law 2012.

1.2 Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

1.3 Purpose

The purpose of this local law is to prescribe pest plants within the City of Joondalup district that, in the local government's opinion, are likely to adversely affect the value of property in the district or the health, comfort or convenience of the inhabitants of the district.

1.4 Effect

The effect of this local law is to require the owner or occupier of private land within the City of Joondalup district to destroy, eradicate or otherwise control pest plants on and in relation to that land in a manner and within a time specified in a notice given by the local government and served on the owner or occupier of the land.

1.5 Application

This local law applies throughout the district.

1.6 Definitions

In this local law unless the context requires otherwise—

"authorised person" means a person authorised in accordance with section 9.10 of the *Local Government Act 1995*;

"district" means the district of the local government;

"local government" means the City of Joondalup;

"occupier" is as defined by the *Local Government Act 1995*;

"owner" is as defined by the Local Government Act 1995;

"pest plant" means a plant prescribed as a pest plant under clause 2.1 of this local law.

PART 2—PRESCRIPTION OF PEST PLANTS

2.1 Prescription of Pest Plants

Every plant described in Schedule 1 to this local law is prescribed as a pest plant.

PART 3—SERVING OF NOTICES

3.1 Serving of Notices

- (a) The local government may serve on the owner or occupier of private land within the district a duly completed notice in the form of Schedule 2 to this local law requiring the destruction, eradication or otherwise control of any pest plant on that land.
- (b) A person served with a notice under sub clause (a) shall comply with that notice within the time and in the manner specified therein.

PART 4—COMPLIANCE WITH NOTICE

4.1 Failure to comply with notice

- (a) Where a person fails to comply with a notice served under clause 3.1 of this local law, the local government may—
 - (i) without payment of any compensation in respect thereof, destroy, eradicate
 or control, as the case may be, any pest plant the destruction, eradication or
 control of which was required by the notice; and
 - (ii) recover in a court of competent jurisdiction from the person to whom the notice is directed, the amount of the expense of such destruction, eradication or control.

General description

The Minister for Planning has granted approval to the declaration of a planning control area over land at Scarborough Beach Road (Main Street to King Edward Road) as shown on Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) plans numbered 1.7243, 1.7244, 1.7245 and 1.7246.

Purpose

The purpose of the planning control area is to allow the future reservation of the land as an Other Regional Road. The WAPC considers that the planning control area is required over the whole of the property to ensure that no development occurs on this land which might prejudice this purpose until it may be reserved as Other Regional Roads in the Metropolitan Region Scheme.

Duration and effects

The declaration remains in effect for a period of five years from the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette* or until revoked by the WAPC with approval by the Minister, whichever is the sooner

A person shall not commence and carry out development in a planning control area without the prior approval of the WAPC. The penalty for failure to comply with this requirement is \$200,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, a further fine of \$25,000 for each day during which the offence continues

Compensation is payable in respect of land injuriously affected by this declaration, and land so affected may be acquired by the WAPC in the same circumstances and in the same manner as if the land had been reserved in the Metropolitan Region Scheme for a public purpose.
