# Building (s. 67 Exemption) Order (No. 2) 2012

Made by the Minister under section 67(2A) of the Act.

### 1. Citation

This order is the Building (s. 67 Exemption) Order (No. 2) 2012.

#### 2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order on the day after that day.

### **3.** Exemption from operation of section 16(b) of the Act

Section 16(b) of the Act, to the extent that it requires an application for a building permit to be signed by each owner of the land on which the building or incidental structure is to be located, does not apply to an application for a building permit —

- (a) to do building work in respect of a Class 1 or Class 10 building or incidental structure; and
- (b) made to a permit authority in the period commencing on 19 December 2012 and ending on 30 June 2013.

## 1. Citation

These regulations are the *Local Government (Elections) Amendment Regulations 2012.* 

# 2. Commencement

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations on the day after that day.

# 3. **Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997.* 

# 4. **Regulation 10 amended**

In regulation 10(1) delete "4.31(1)(b)(i)" and insert:

4.31(1B)(a)

Note: The heading to amended regulation 10 is to read: Nomination of ward — s. 4.31

# 5. Regulation 11 amended

In regulation 11(1) delete "4.31(1)(e), (f) or (g)" and insert:

4.31(1E), (1F) or (1G)

#### 6. Regulation 82 amended

Delete regulation 82(4) and insert:

- (4) If, after the period mentioned in subregulation (3), the parcels are to be destroyed
  - (a) the destruction is to be carried out by or under the supervision of the CEO in the presence of at least 2 employees; or
  - (b) the parcels are to be conveyed securely to a secure paper destruction company, or placed in a locked bin provided by such a company, by or under the supervision of the CEO in the presence of at least 2 employees.

(Adopted TABCORP Betting Rules)

Notice 2012

Made by Racing and Wagering Western Australia under section 59(6)(c) of the Act.

#### 1. Citation

This notice is the Racing and Wagering Western Australia (Adopted TABCORP Betting Rules Notice 2012.

#### 2. Interpretation

In this notice—

"the Act" means the Racing and Wagering Western Australia Act 2003;

"the Rules" means the rules described in clause 3, adopted by Racing and Wagering Western Australia.

#### 3. Rules adopted under section 59(4) of the Act

(1) In a meeting held on 21 February 2005 and a further meeting held on 26 April 2005, Racing and Wagering Western Australia resolved to adopt and operate under rules relating to a combined totalisator scheme in accordance with section 59(4) of the Act.

(2) A copy of the rules adopted was published for public information in the Gazette of 7 July 2005 at pp. 3095-3156.

(3) Further amendments to those rules were adopted subsequently, and those further amendments were published for public information in the Gazette of—

- (i) 23 August 2005 at p. 3909-3915;

# 4. Changes to Rules published for public information (section 59(6)(c) of the Act

(1) Further amendments to the Rules were adopted by resolution of the Board dated 17 December 2012.

(2) Those further amendments to the Rules are published in the Schedule to this notice for public information, as required by section 59(6)(c) of the Act.

#### Schedule 1—Amendments to Adopted Rules

1.1 Interpretation—after the words definition of Flexi bet enabled insert the words Quinella, Exacta, Duet & Double.

3.5(b) Flexi Bets insert the words Quinella, Exacta, Duet & Double.

7.3 Flexi bet Enabled Pool Dividends Where Less Than a Unit of Investment on Correct Selections insert the words "winning Quinella combination", "winning Exacta combination", "winning Duet combination for each Dividend", "winning Double combination",

12.4 Double insert the words (d) each part allotted to an unbacked combination is transferred to the Double jackpot pool conducted on the Succeeding Double Event.

12.7 Exacta Subject to Rule 16 insert the words where as the result of a dead heat in any Event in an Exacta Investors on two or more combinations become entitled to a Dividend—

- (a) the Pool shall be divided into as many equal parts as there are combinations running the dead heat.
- (b) each part so determined shall be treated separately.
- (c) Dividends shall be calculated by dividing each part amongst the investors on each backed combination, and
- (d) each part allocated to an unbacked combination is transferred to the Exacta jackpot pool conducted on the Succeeding Exacta Event.

The remainder of Rule 12.7 is deleted in its entirety.

  - "Succeeding Quinella Event" means, in relation to a Quinella Event ("Initial Quinella Event")—
    - (i) the next Quinella Event (if any) conducted at the same Meeting as the Initial Quinella Event;
    - or if there is none—
      - (ii) the next Quinella Event at a meeting selected by the Betting Operator in accordance with rule 13.2(c)(ii).
  - "Succeeding Exacta Event" means, in relation to an Exacta Event ("Initial Exacta Event")—
    - (i) the next Exacta Event (if any) conducted at the same Meeting as the Initial Exacta Event;
    - or if there is none—
      - (ii) the next Exacta Event at a meeting selected by the Betting Operator in accordance with rule 13.2(c)(ii).
  - "Succeeding Duet Event" means, in relation to a Duet Event ("Initial Duet Event")—
    - (i) the next Duet Event (if any) conducted at the same Meeting as the Initial Duet Event;
    - or if there is none
      - (ii) the next Duet Event at a meeting selected by the Betting Operator in accordance with rule 13.2(c)(ii).

#### "Succeeding Double" means-

- (a) in relation to a Running Double ("Initial Running Double")—
  - (i) the next Running Double (if any) conducted at the same Meeting as the Initial Running Double;
  - or if there is none—
    - (ii) the next Running Double at a meeting selected by the Betting Operator in accordance with rule 13.2(c)(iv).
- (b) in relation to a Daily Double ("Initial Daily Double") the next Daily Double at a meeting selected by the Betting Operator in accordance with rule 13.2(c)(i).
- (c) in relation to a Feature Double ("Initial Feature Double") the next Feature Double selected by the Betting Operator in accordance with rule 13.2(c)(i).

13.9 insert the words For each Quinella Pool, there shall be: a Quinella jackpot pool into which must be paid any amounts which, under Rules 7.3(ii), 12.3, 13.2 or 14.1 are required to be transferred to the Quinella jackpot pool for that Event; a Quinella dividend pool into which must be paid: Quinella investments on that Event after the deduction of Commission and any refunds; and the amount (if any) transferred to the Quinella jackpot pool for that Event. Delete 13.9.2, 13.9.3, 13.9.4 and 13.9.5.

13.10 insert the words For each Exacta Pool, there shall be: an Exacta jackpot pool into which must be paid any amounts which, under Rules 7.3(ii), 12.7, 13.2 or 14.2 are required to be transferred to the Exacta jackpot pool for that Event; an Exacta dividend pool into which must be paid: Exacta investments on that Event after the deduction of Commission and any refunds; and the amount (if any) transferred to the Exacta jackpot pool for that Event.

13.11 insert the words For each Duet Pool, there shall be: a Duet jackpot pool into which must be paid any amounts which, under Rules 7.3(ii), 12.10, 13.2 or 14.4 are required to be transferred to the Duet jackpot pool for that Event; a Duet dividend pool into which must be paid: Duet investments on that Event after the deduction of Commission and any refunds; and the amount (if any) transferred to the Duet jackpot pool for that Event.

13.12 insert the words For each Double Pool, there shall be: a Double jackpot pool into which must be paid any amounts which, under Rules 7.3(ii), 12.4 or 13.2 are required to be transferred to the Double jackpot pool for that Event; a Double dividend pool into which must be paid: Double investments on that Event after the deduction of Commission and any refunds; and the amount (if any) transferred to the Double jackpot pool for that Event.

13.13 delete the words Double, Quinella, Exacta, Duet

14.1 delete the words AND EXACTA

14.1(b)(i) add the words the Quinella jackpot pool for that Event is transferred to the Quinella jackpot pool conducted on the Succeeding Quinella Event; and

14.1(b)(ii) add the words remainder of the Quinella dividend

14.2 add the following words **EXACTA** If: one winner only is declared; and no second or third placing is declared;

- (i) the Exacta jackpot pool for that Event is transferred to the Exacta jackpot pool conducted on the Succeeding Exacta Event; and
- (ii) the remainder of the Exacta dividend Pool shall be divided amongst the Investors on the combination of the winner and any other Selection in the Event irrespective of order.

14.4 (a) after the words if only two placings are declared delete the words *the Pool* shall be divided amongst the investors on that combination. and insert the words—

- (i) the Duet jackpot pool for that Event is transferred to the Duet jackpot pool conducted on the Succeeding Duet Event; and
- (ii) the remainder of the Duet dividend Pool shall be divided amongst the Investors on that combination.

14.4(b) after the words if only a winner is declared delete the words *the pool shall be divided amongst the investors or the combination of the winner and any other selection in the event irrespective of order and* insert the words—

- (i) the Duet jackpot pool for that Event is transferred to the Duet jackpot pool conducted on the Succeeding Duet Event; and
- (ii) the remainder of the Duet dividend Pool shall be divided amongst the Investors on the combination of the winner and any other Selection in the Event irrespective of order; after the words and the insert the words remainder of the Duet dividend after the words Pool shall delete the words be refunded to investors and insert the words transferred to the Duet jackpot pool conducted on the Succeeding Duet Event.
