Fire and Emergency Services (Superannuation Fund) Amendment Regulations 2014

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Fire and Emergency Services (Superannuation Fund) Amendment Regulations 2014*.

PROHIBITION ON FISHING FOR CRABS (COCKBURN SOUND) ORDER 2014

Order No. 11 of 2014

FD 4016/14 [1224]

Made by the Minister under section 43.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Prohibition on Fishing for Crabs (Cockburn Sound) Order 2014*.

2. Order revoked

The *Prohibition on Recreational Fishing for Crabs (Cockburn Sound) Order 2006* is hereby revoked.

3. Interpretation

In this order—

crabs means any crab of the species *Portunus armatus*, *Portunus pelagicus* or *Ovalipes Australiensis*.

4. Prohibition on fishing for crabs

- A person must not engage in commercial fishing for crabs at any time in the waters described in Schedule 1 of this order.
- A person must not engage in recreational fishing for crabs at any time in the waters described in Schedule 2 of this order.

Schedule 1

The waters of the Indian Ocean bounded by a line commencing at a point on the high water mark at the western extremity of the South Mole at the entrance to Fremantle Harbour and extending westerly to the southernmost rock of the Straggler Rocks; thence south easterly to the high water mark on the northernmost point of Mewstone; thence generally southerly along the high water mark on the eastern shore of Mewstone to its southernmost point; thence southerly to the high water mark on the northernmost point of Carnac Island; thence generally southerly along the high water mark on the eastern shore of that island to its southernmost point; thence southerly to the high water mark at Entrance Point on Garden Island; thence generally southerly along the high water mark on the eastern shore of that island to south west point; thence southerly to the high water mark at John Point on the mainland; thence along the high water mark to the commencing point.

Schedule 2

The waters of the Indian Ocean bounded by a line commencing at a point on the high water mark at the western extremity of Woodman Point and extending generally westerly to the high water mark on the south-eastern point of Carnac Island; thence generally southerly to the high water mark at Entrance Point on Garden Island; thence generally southerly along the high water mark on the

eastern shore of Garden Island until it intersects with the causeway extending from Garden Island to the mainland; thence along the causeway to the mainland; thence in a generally easterly and northerly direction along the high water mark to the commencing point.
