ISSUE OF WRITS LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

Notice of issue of writ for elections in all the electoral districts to elect members of the Legislative Assembly.

1. Under section 65 of the *Electoral Act 1907* I give notice that on Wednesday 1 February 2017 the Governor issued a writ under sections 64(2) and 69 of the Act directing me to proceed with elections in all the electoral districts to elect one member of the Legislative Assembly for each district.
2. For the purposes of those elections—
 - (a) the electoral rolls close at 6 p.m. on Thursday 9 February 2017;
 - (b) nominations of candidates must be received before 12 noon on Friday 10 February 2017;
 - (c) polling will occur between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday 11 March 2017;
 - (d) the last day for the return of the writ is Tuesday 2 May 2017.

ISSUE OF WRITS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

Notice of issue of writ for elections in all the electoral regions to elect members of the Legislative Council.

1. Under section 65 of the *Electoral Act 1907* I give notice that on Wednesday 1 February 2017 the Governor issued a writ under sections 64(3) and 69 of that Act directing me to proceed with elections in all the electoral regions to elect 6 members of the Legislative Council for each region.
2. For the purposes of those elections—
 - (a) the electoral rolls close at 6 p.m. on Thursday 9 February 2017;
 - (b) nominations of candidates must be received before 12 noon on Friday 10 February 2017;
 - (c) polling will occur between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday 11 March 2017;
 - (d) the last day for the return of the writ is Tuesday 2 May 2017.
