Building Services (Registration) Act 2011

### Building Services (Registration) Amendment Regulations 2017

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Building Services (Registration) Amendment Regulations 2017*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

**3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Building Services (Registration) Regulations 2011*.

**4. Regulation 3 amended**

In regulation 3 insert in alphabetical order:

*owner-builder*, in relation to building work, means a person who has an owner-builder approval granted under the *Building Services (Registration) Act 2011* section 45 to carry out the building work;

*principal builder*, in relation to builder work, means a person who carries out, or undertakes to carry out, the builder work for another person but does not include —

- (a) a person engaged as a subcontractor to carry out all or part of the builder work; or

- (b) a person who carries out, or undertakes to carry out, all or part of the builder work for an owner-builder;

**5. Regulation 4 amended**

Delete regulation 4(a) and insert:

- (a) builder work as a principal builder;

**6. Regulation 5 amended**

In regulation 5 delete “builder work as the person named as the builder on a building permit” and insert:

builder work as a principal builder

**7. Regulation 13 amended**

Delete regulation 13(2) and insert:

- (2) If a person carries out, or undertakes to carry out, building work for another person under more than 1 distinct contract or engagement and the building work is substantially a single undertaking in connection with a single building, the value of all the work must be added together for the purposes of calculating the value of the building work.

**8. Regulation 15 amended**

In regulation 15 delete “builder work as the person named as the builder on a building permit” and insert:

builder work as a principal builder

**9. Regulation 21 amended**

In regulation 21 delete “builder work as the person named as the builder on a building permit” and insert:

builder work as a principal builder

**ENERGY COORDINATION ACT 1994**  
**APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE WA GAS RETAIL MARKET SCHEME**

The Economic Regulation Authority, pursuant to Section 11ZOM of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*, hereby gives notice that the following amendments to the to the Western Australian gas retail market scheme (**scheme**) have been approved—IN001-16W, IN002-16W, IN034-16W and IN040-16W.

- IN001-16W—proposes adding a note to clause 78 to provide clarity to retailers as to when and when not to issue a move-in transfer request in the event of an erroneous transfer.
- IN002-16W—aims to add clarity to the procedures regarding the process of sending Special Circumstance notices described in clause 255, which is required when pipeline operators are prevented from injecting gas in accordance with shipper nominations.
- IN034-16W—proposes changes to the Connectivity Testing and Technical Certification document, Specification Pack Usage Guidelines and FRC Hub Participant User Guide to provide a new, optional, self-service participant certification process.
- IN040-16W—aims to add clarity to the FRC Hub Terms and Conditions regarding subscriber response times for service interruption during non-business hours if the next day is a Saturday, Sunday or Public holiday.

## Areas Closed to Fishing for Prawns in the Kimberley Prawn Managed Fishery for 2017

## Notice No. 1 of 2017

I, Heather Brayford, Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Fisheries, in accordance with clause 17 of the *Kimberley Prawn Managed Fishery Management Plan 1993* (the Plan) and being of the opinion that the prohibition is required in the better interests of the Kimberley Prawn Managed Fishery, do hereby—

1. Cancel Notice of Areas Closed to Fishing for Prawns: *Notice No. 2 of 2016*, dated 25 May 2016; and
2. Prohibit fishing for prawns in those parts of the Kimberley Prawn Managed Fishery (the Fishery), between the times and dates provided for in items (a) to (e) below—

- (a) Fishing for prawns is prohibited in the waters described in Schedule 1 of the Plan from the date of the gazettal of *Notice No. 1 of 2017*, until 0600 hours WST on 1 April 2017;
- (b) Fishing for prawns is prohibited in the waters described in Schedule 1 of the Plan during the period commencing at 0800 hours WST on 15 June 2017 and ending at 0600 hours WST on 1 August 2017;
- (c) Fishing for prawns is prohibited in the waters described in Schedule 1 of the Plan during the period commencing at 1630 hours WST on 30 November 2017 until 0600 hours WST on 1 June 2018;
- (d) Fishing for prawns is prohibited in the waters described in (i) to (ii) below from the date of gazettal of this Notice until 0800 hours on 15 June 2017—

- (i) **Collier Bay Prawn Size Management Fish Ground**

Waters inshore of a line commencing at the intersection of 16° 15.34' south latitude and 124° 00' east longitude; thence extending due north along the meridian to the intersection of 15° 50' south latitude and 124° 00' east longitude; thence extending due east along the parallel to the intersection of 15° 50' south latitude and 124° 24.50' east longitude; but excluding all waters described in (e)(i) Collier Bay Inshore Closure;

- (ii) **Napier Broome Bay Prawn Size Management Fish Ground**

Waters inshore of a line commencing at the intersection of 13° 56.84' south latitude and 126° 33.88' east longitude (on the mainland near Anjo Hill); thence extending easterly along the geodesic to the intersection of 13° 56.26' south latitude and 126° 41.12' east longitude (on West Governor Island); thence extending easterly along the geodesic to the intersection of 13° 55.75' south latitude and 126° 48.38' east longitude (on the mainland near Curran Point); but excluding all waters described in (e)(iv) Napier Broome Bay Inshore Closure;

- (e) Fishing for prawns is prohibited in the waters described in (i) to (iv) below at all times—

- (i) **Collier Bay Inshore Closure**

Waters inshore of a line commencing at the intersection of 15° 52.09' south latitude and 124° 26.20' east longitude; thence extending southerly along the geodesic to the intersection of 16° 04.20' south latitude and 124° 26.30' east longitude; thence extending south-westerly along the geodesic to the intersection of 16° 17' south latitude and 124° 18.10' east longitude; thence extending westerly along the geodesic to the intersection of 16° 17.195' south latitude and 124° 07.861' east longitude;

- (ii) **Brunswick Bay-York Sound Inshore Closure**
