1. Citation

This order is the *Alteration of Statutory Designations Order 2017*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on 1 July 2017.

 - (b) the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (4) Subclauses (1) and (2) do not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.
- 5. References to Department of Local Government and Communities altered**
- (1) A reference to the Department of Local Government and Communities contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, is to be read and construed as a reference to the relevant successor.
- (2) In subclause (1) —

- (a) the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function,

office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or

- (b) the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or
 - (c) the Department of Transport if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2009 became a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (3) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

7. References to Department of Regional Development and Lands altered

- (1) A reference to the Department of Regional Development and Lands contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, is to be read and construed as a reference to the relevant successor.
- (2) In subclause (1) —
relevant successor means —
- (a) the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department; or
 - (b) the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development if the reference to be read and construed relates to a function, office or other matter that on 1 July 2017 becomes a function of, office in or other matter relating to that department.
- (3) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.

8. References to various departments altered

- (1) A reference contained in any law, or in any instrument, contract, or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2017, to a department of the Public Service with a designation set out in the 2nd column of an item in the Table is to be read and construed as a reference to the department of the Public Service with the designation set out in the 3rd column of that item.
- (2) Subclause (1) does not apply to a reference if the context of the reference requires otherwise.
