METROPOLITAN WATER SUPPLY, SEWERAGE, AND DRAINAGE (PERTH COASTAL AND GWELUP UNDERGROUND WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AREA) PROCLAMATION 2018

**pollution area** means an Underground Water Pollution Control Area constituted under section 57A;

# 4. Gwelup Underground Water Pollution Control Area abolished

Gwelup Underground Water Pollution Control Area, constituted and defined by a proclamation published in the *Gazette* on 14 December 1973 at p. 4528, is abolished.

# 5. Perth Coastal Underground Water Pollution Control Area abolished


